Interviewing a celebrity is always exciting for any TV reporter, their larger than life image brings a new kind of excitement in the interview and with the audience. Answer: Here, give the names of projects you are currently working along with a brief of your characters in the project.

Which celebrities you believe are the most influential?

Answer: Tell about the people who have influenced not just you, but the society at large. It is not necessary that you only name celebrities. You can also speak about people from other walks of life that have made an impact on you and whose work you admire.

On what do you spend the most: clothes, accessories, perfumes, underwear, or anything else?

Answer: You can answer this question honestly or joke as if you will tell the details, the income tax department might seize all your clothes, accessories, etc., because you spend a fortune on them every weekend.

Or may be you can also tell that you have been planning to launch your own brand of apparels and accessories and would rather make people spend on it.

Are you a bathroom singer?

Answer: Tell the interviewer that what happens behind the closed doors of bathroom, dies there itself.

Whom do you love more, your parents, friends, spouse, kids, siblings, your yourself?
