

PARAGRAPH WRITING

While writing a paragraph go chronologically, do not jump from one point to the next and back again. Ensure that there is a logical order in which you the points appear in the paragraph - one point leading to the next. The paragraph should be a coherent whole. In a descriptive paragraph give specific details about how something smells, feels, looks or tastes. Organize this information in a logical sequence. While writing on a process based topic explain each step in the sequence in which it takes place or should take place. Whenever giving examples connect them to the point you are trying to prove through that example. Convey the main idea or argument at the beginning of the paragraph, then validate that point by supporting data or examples. Elaborate on the point and explain the example and the relationship between them. Present the supporting ideas. In the end conclude with a broad summarization of the topic and collate all the points.

2. Write a paragraph in around hundred words on a cricket match that you have attended.

3. Write a paragraph in around hundred words about the problems faced due to unreliable internet connections in India.
