

3.3.2 Extension Activities

The college is actively engaged in various extension activities with the neighboring rural and semi-rural community for holistic development of our students. The idea is to impart education along with nurturing social orientation. Since Extension is the essence of growth for any institution, many of our departments work with the neighborhood community through various engagement activities to inculcate skills, attitude, and knowledge amongst students. Consequently, they take the message of social service and good citizenship and spread it in the community. Examples of the activities of NSS, Placement Cell, various Committees and Departments will illustrate the point. The National Service Scheme (NSS) has carried out various social outreach programmes to sensitize students. In the year 2018-19, the NSS Committee of the college organized awareness programme on the consumption of Tobacco; Donation Camp for the Kerala Relief Fund and paid visit to Old Age Home as well. The NSS wing visited Nizamuddin Basti for reformation of the Slum Area in collaboration with the Hope Project NGO. In 2015-16, the NSS wing conducted Workshop on National Youth Forum on Drug Use Prevention. In the year 2014-15, the NSS worked to promote Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, Rally for Rivers and Digital India campaign. Our college has an active National Cadet Corps (NCC). It aims to develop character, discipline, and ideal of selfless service amongst the students of our college. Our cadets have won many accolades and felicitations for their social activities.

The Placement Cell of the college maintained its consanguinity **with CPC (Central Placement Cell)** for building future leadership. With the aim to promote multicultural identity, Aditi Mahavidyalaya, in collaboration with **Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan**, M.H.R.D., organized a Cultural Exchange Programme to Sikkim titled as 'Collaborative Learning from Shared Heritage: Road to Sikkim' in January 2018. The Department of Home Science organized visits to NGO-Ambedkar Sewa Bharti, Industrial visit to Mother Dairy etc. The department in collaboration with NGO Prayas conducted case Case Profile of Children in Conflict with Law in the year 2017-18. The department of Education (B. El. Ed) is actively working to spread the message of education through its different works such as by conducting workshops on Self – Development, visit to Bodh Shiksha Smiti, Jaipur, visit to Science Centre, Delhi, etc. Social work Department organizes Diwali Mela every year on different themes such as Girl Child, right to Education, Legal Awareness- Sharing Tomorrow, Bol Ke Lab Azaad Hain Tere and Roshanara- Deefon Ke Sang etc. The Extensive Lecture Series Committee organized series on various topics such as Interactive session on “Handling Interviews”, “Out of Office: Too stressed to work”, “Cybercrime and social media” and “Enhancing Communication Skills”. The Women Development Cell of the college is actively working on the issues of sensitizing girls and women regarding gender issues through its various programmes such as Workshop on Gender and Sexuality Sensitization in the year 2015-16.
