



Ms. Vibha established her Montessori school in Chennai more than a decade before. The idea behind it was to work on the lingual and phonetics part with the young children. Other alumni Ms. Ruchika's school is located at the outskirts of Delhi which comes under the rural belt. Through her experiences, she shared that only an aware teacher can provide positive guidance and mentoring to her students. 


