DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

The department of commerce had an eventful academic year 2013-14. The faculty and students organized a series of events that offered a platform to share learning and showcase talent. The commerce Fest organized on February 11, 2014 was a huge success encompassing a variety of events like Business Quiz, Extempore Competitions, Power point presentations and E-poster talent hunts. Prizes were distributed to the award winning entries. The faculty also organized an interactive Meta Workshop for the FYUP students on Business Stats and Business Math's wherein the students had hands on experience at showcasing their use of the newly acquired laptops. Another event which was well received was a talk on banking as a career option for women. The faculty is constantly striving to find innovative techniques of dealing with the new FYUP syllabi. On February 21, 2014 Sh. Vijendra Sharma, Chairman of professional development, Institute of Cost Accountants of India delivered an extremely engaging lecture on Business Entrepreneurship and Management.

DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND CHILD WELFARE

The department started working in the academic season 2013-2014 with great zeal and enthusiasm. Various academic enrichment and awareness generation activities were organized for both students and teachers of Department of Family and Child Welfare. The department generated awareness about importance of breast feeding in association with Women's Development Cell of the college and Maharishi Valmiki Hospital, Pooth Khurd in the month of July 2013. Talks were organized. A poster competition was held on the above theme and three best posters were awarded with cash prize.

The resource persons from Non Governmental Organizations were invited to deliver talks on issues related to women for the students of Family and Child Welfare Semester III and IV.

Keeping in mind the interconnectedness of the issues, the department celebrated 'Beti Utsav' in the month of January 2014 in association with Women's Development Cell of the college and Maharishi Valmiki Hospital, Pooth Khurd. Slogan writing, poster making and poem recitation competition were held in the college. A talk on 'Importance of girl child in society' was delivered by the Medical Superintendent of Maharishi Valmiki Hospital in which students queries were answered. Three best slogans, poems and posters were awarded with cash prizes.

Students of IV semester visited various governmental and non governmental organizations working in the field of empowerment of women and children like SOS, Anganwadi and Maternal and Child Health Services. The students of VI semester were acquainted with skills required for organizing learning experiences for children in the age group of 3-6 years. Intensive training was given to them on developing educational aids for children in the age group of 3-6 years. They were also placed in schools for an internship of ten days.

The department is planning to organize annual Family and Child Welfare Day in the month of March, 2014.

DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY 2013-14

The Department of Geography presently has a total of nine faculty members and about two hundred students teaching B.A Honours, B.A Programme and Bachelor of Elementary Education. Like each year, this year also our students did well in academics. Other than this, our students did

equally well in extracurricular activities through their achievements at various intra and inter college competitions.

The new academic session of the Department started by celebrating the welcome of students of 'DC-I: Geography' course on July 21, 2013. Fifty seven students of B.A. (H) VI semester and B. El. ED. IInd year, with three faculty members went to Himachal Pradesh for the field Study from 5th October 2013 to 10th October 2013. The Honours students conducted a questionnaire based field survey in Kullu Market area and surrounding villages in order to find out the relationship among the occurrences of disaster, impact and response to disaster and perception of people to disaster. The B. El. ED. Students have studied the inter relationship among relief, climate and vegetation in Kullu valley.

All the activities of the Department in this session have been devoted to Family Farming keeping the location of college and significance of the year (2014:International Year of Family Farming) in view. In this direction, the beginning was made with a workshop on "Organic Farming" held on 17th January 2014 in Saidpur village near Auchandi Border. In this workshop Ms. Anita Rana from Janhit Foundation, Merrut delivered a lecture titled "Impact of Organic Farming on Our Health". The interactive session between the experts from Janhit Foundation and farmers of Saidpur village practicing chemical farming was a life time experience for our students. In due course of time the Geographical Society "Dharitri" has organized Geofest on January 30, 2014 with same theme mentioned. In this event Dr. M. Shakti Vell, Assistant Profeesor, Indraprastha University delivered a lecture on "Family Farming: An Indian Perspective". The lecture gave an insight on the development of family farming over the years and its importance in the present environmental condition. Following this, there was an interactive session with Mr. Madan Gopal Kohli winner of "Limca Book of Award" for growing longest vegetables. The Garden prepared by him has been awarded "Best Garden" by the All India Kitchen Garden Association, Young Women Christian Association, Rose Society of India and Indian Council of Agricultural Research. The students and teachers both were exposed rare variety of plant species shown by him live and through a documentary. The outcome of this interactive session was inspiration and encouragement to one and all present leading to culmination of creative thoughts. Various inter college competitions such as Skit on "the significance and challenges in Family" Farming", Photography exhibition on "farming at its best", on the spot T-shirt painting competition, Debate on Family farming is a bane or boon for rural development were held. Games like Treasure Hunt, Jumble Mumble etc also sensitized one and all on family farming.

HOME SCIENCE DEPARTMENT

The Home Science course was introduced this year as a major Discipline in FYUP. Introduction of this new course in the college led to the establishment of Home Science Department. The newly introduced home science department clubbed the existing NHE, FT and FCW departments. A total of 35 students were admitted in this course. Home Science Department started with great enthusiasm. Orientation Program for the first batch of FYUP was organized in its respective subjects where scope and significance of home science were explained. The students were familiarized with the dos and don'ts of the department and the pedagogy to be used with emphasis on development of scientific temper among students. They were familiarized with new methods like project work, survey, paper presentation, use of technology in paper presentations etc. The students were introduced to methods of research through the practicum works.

Films and other videos were shown by HDCS department to organize teaching-learning-experiences in relation to approaches and factors affecting human development with special emphasis on cultural milieu. A workshop was organized on 'Gender and Sexuality' for students through inviting an eminent personality from a Non-Governmental organization 'Vikasini'. Students shared their experiences in the workshop freely and gained insights to deal with issues like eve-teasing etc. They also participated in 'Beti Utsav' organized by the Department of Family and Child Welfare in association with Women Development Cell of the college and Maharishi Valmiki Hospital, Pooth Khurd and won prizes.

They also participated in 'Breast feeding Week' organized by the Department of Family and Child Welfare in association with Women Development Cell of the college and Maharishi Valmiki Hospital, Pooth Khurd and won prizes.

They also learnt the techniques of preparing and administering an interview schedule in HDCS, RMDA and DCE. Audio-visual sources were used by the teachers of Home Science department to teach various topics. The students conducted surveys and did project work on various topics in different disciplines.

At the end of the semester, the students also made oral presentations (paper presentations) using power point individually and in groups on the topics assigned to them. While making presentations, they learnt various academic and life skills like integration, synthesis, analysis etc. use of various modern and traditional sources of knowledge to showcase their work

The students also participated in Antardhwani. The students of Home Science department prepared jam, jelly, pickles, marmalade and other preserved foods which were prepared keeping in mind scientific facts and displayed their entrepreneurial skills. They also developed posters, pamphlets, notice boards to show the salient features of different departments of Home Science. One

of the students also participated in one of the Innovation Projects which are going on in the college in the present year.

MATHEMATICS DEPARTMENT

Mathematics Department organized the quiz "Maths Mania" and a poster-making competition on February 12, 2013. Around eighty students participated fighting keenly for prizes. JyotiRai (B.El.Ed.3rd yr), Vaishali (B.A.Prog 2nd Yr), Ruchika were the winners of the quiz. Winners of poster making competition were JyotiRai (Beled 3rd yr) and Tanu Gupta (B.El.Ed. 3rd yr).

DEPARTMENT OF NUTRITION AND HEALTH SCIENCE

The Department also organized an excursion for application course of B.A. Prog. III year students in March, 2013. The students visited various stadia and Akshardham temple.

DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WORK

The Department of Social Work commenced academic session 2013-2014 with a four day (24.07.13 to 27.07.13) orientation programme for the students of B. A. (H) Social Work. The objective behind organizing orientation programme was to provide an insight into the fields of social work practice. This programme endorses the idea of developing and understanding for the existing social phenomena along with an overview of social work, processing the skills of working with individuals, working with groups and working with communities. The sessions organized during the four days aimed to integrate theory with practice in the areas of health, education, community organization, research, social problems, social development, gender sensitization, women safety, HIV/AIDS, creative writing, movie screening, counseling skills, communication skill development. A street play and collage making were also done.

The course aims at providing interdisciplinary collaboration for better understanding of human needs, problems, services and issues of development. The students are provided direct exposure in the field in addition to theory classes. Field work is an integral part of social work curriculum. Students are placed in various setting such as schools, hospitals, de-addiction centers, NGOs, industry etc, where they are exposed to the field realities. In the academic year 2013-2014 concurrent field work began with the placement of 95 students of B.A. (H) Social Work at 46 Government and Non Government Organisations (NGOs).

With the purpose of dealing students' grievances, department runs a "Departmental Student Advisory Committee" consisting of three Faculty Members and Ekta Society's elected representatives.

Every year "Pearl Memorial Event" is organized by the Ekta Society, Social Work Department in the fond memory of our ex-student Pearl Gupta who died in an accident few years back. This year

Social Work Department organized "Pearl Memorial Just a Minute Contest" on 23rd January, 2014 in the college auditorium. Total 25 students participated in this contest. Students were asked to speak on some 'social issues' which were given on the spot, for a minute. All the students participated very actively and showed a great enthusiasm. Three students were awarded with prize money for their outstanding performance in the contest i.e. (1st prize: Rs.500, 2rd Prize: Rs.300, 3rd Prize: Rs.200). Holding such events helps in motivating students to let them brainstorm without prior research to gauge the level of knowledge and interest as well as develop their critical thinking and creativity.

A workshop for improving the research skills of social work students was organized on November 2, 2013. The resource persons were Mr. Bharat Bhusan (Founder and General Secretary of World Without Obstacles (WWO) organization) and Ms. Anna (CEO, WWO). Session began with the introduction of the organization WWO followed by the session on improving research skills in the area of Health and Hygiene. Resource persons also presented a brief account of the situation prevailing in India and also highlighted the work done by their organization like WASH awareness and promotion activities, household survey, promoting health and hygiene, educating teachers/trainers, educating children and parents. At the end of the session they took the feedback from the students and encouraged them to use the innovative methods in their field work.

A workshop on educating students about women rights was held on February 18, 2014. Ms. Bulbul Das, Lawyer at Delhi High Court and Supreme Court was pleased to conduct the workshop. As we know that abuse of violence and discrimination against women are fairly common. The issues of their rights are still being ignored and making this state that of a 'social epidemic'. Many students are placed in settings where they have to deal with abused women who are victim of abuse/ violence so there is a need to educate the students about the women rights. The ability to deal with this situation empowered students.

Rural Camp is a vital part of practice learning in B.A. (H) Social Work curriculum. Objectives of the Rural Camp are to give students a basic knowledge of rural community development programmes and functions of Panchayati Raj Institutions and to learn application of rapid survey of the village through Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA). The aim is to understand the socio- economic aspects of rural life and to identify the problems of social work interventions. Final year students are taken to an educational excursion every year. This year the educational trip is scheduled to be organized at Centre for Community Economics and Development Consultants Society (CECOEDECON), Jaipur from March 21-24, 2104.

INNOVATION PROJECTS

Innovation Project AM-201

Innovation Project AM 201 titled "A Journey from just a girl to an Individual: Adolescent life experiences" is a systematic empirical study to identify the biological, social and psychological needs and concerns of the adolescent girls. The passage of girls from childhood to adolescence is marked by changes in physical characteristics, emrgence of new needs and demands. It has also been observed that adolescence is a stage acquired not merely in terms of chronological years; it also involves transformation in mental horizon, social and psychological perceptions and reactions. This project attempts to identify those issues and provide awareness on those concerns in a systematic way with the help of experts. Study is conducted on the six colleges of University of Delhi. Different Sociocultural milieu was the prime criteria to decide the colleges. A few workshops and sessions have been conducted in colleges. Project intends to develop a self help manual (bilingual) for adolescent girls for awareness and better understanding of the issues.

Innovation Project AM- 202

Introduction: The title of the Innovation Project AM 202 is 'Nutritional and psychosocial wellbeing of rural elderly population of Delhi'. The proportion of elderly persons in total population is 8.2% as per 2011 census. Their number is increasing in the total population ever since the advancement in medical field. The proportion of elderly people in Delhi's population is 5.2%. Around 78.4% of the elderly male population lives in rural India. They have multidimensional needs and issues. The changing family structure has changed elderly status.

Innovation aspects: Following are the innovation aspects of the above project:

- 1. Sensitization of young people towards the needs of elderly people
- 2. A step towards reducing conflicts between young and old people
- 3. Exploring nutritional and psycho-social well-being of rural elderly people
- 4. Research experience for under graduate students
- 5. Direct learning from the research field
- 6. Presentation and publication opportunities for undergraduate students.

Objectives:

- 1. To investigate the profile of elderly male and female population living in rural Delhi
- 2. To assess the socio-economic status of elderly male and female population
- 3. To study household and occupational responsibilities of elderly males and females of rural families.
- 4. To assess the psycho-social status of elderly males and females living in rural families in
- 5. To assess the nutritional status of elderly males and females of rural families.

Preliminary salient findings: Education level varied from illiteracy to senior secondary level.

Hypertension, gastric trouble, joint pain were commonly found illnesses among elderly people.

They spend time with grand children daily, attend family functions.

"RANGMANCH KE MADHYAM SE GRAMIN KSHETRA KI KISHORVYAY CHHATRAON KA VYAKTITVA VIKAS"

This Innovation Project is based on the premise that theatre has the potential to positively influence the behaviour, personality and, in the long term, lives of adolescent girls. Girls from rural background live a conservative, inhibited and restricted life. But if given an opportunity to learn something new, these girls can overcome their hesitations, inhibitions and fears; and enhance their confidence and creativity.

Mr. Surender Sharma (renowned Theatre personality and Director of Theatre group Rangsaptak) is mentoring the project. Ten students of Aditi Mahavidyalaya are working as a team in this project under the guidance of Dr. Rashmi Sharma(Associate Professor), Dr. Neerja Deswal (Assistant Professor) and Dr. Asha (Assistant Professor). These students have already attended an eight day workshop in which they were given training in various aspects of theatre like concentration, focus, time management, creating still images, communication within a group, preparing a script, video and still photography etc through various theatre games. In coming months, these girls will visit schools and conduct workshops with girl students there. Separate Questionaires will be prepared for the school students and their teachers to gain insight into their workshop experiences and learnings. This will eventually help the innovation project team to draw its conclusions. Towards the end of the project, the team is also planning to organise a seminar and publish a book.
