3. Education

The curriculum of Education discipline in BA (program) offers students an opportunity to engage with significant issues, policies, practices and their own lived experiences in Education. The spectrum of coverage is from early childhood to young adulthood. The attempt is thus to build understanding about Education from the pre-primary to higher education stage. Each of the **six core courses** provide engagement with important theories, use focussed readings to build perspective and include suggested assignments for better practice theory interface.

The **skill-based courses** (offered from Sem 3 onwards) deal with the applications of Educational theory and provide opportunities for rich practicum exposure from which new theories can be built and existing theories can be appreciated. The idea is to make every student engage in reflection, analysis and mini research and develop a zest to pursue further studies in Education.

बी ए प्रोग्राम में शिक्षा (विषय) का पाठ्यक्रम छात्राओं को शिक्षा से जुड़े महत्वपूर्ण मुद्दों, नीतियों प्रथाओं (प्रचलन)और जीवंत स्वअनुभवों के साथ जुड़ने का अवसर प्रदान करता है। इसके विषय विस्तार का क्रम बाल्यकाल से युवावस्था तक है। इस प्रकार यह पूर्व प्राथमिक स्तर से उच्च शिक्षा के स्तर तक शिक्षा के विषय में समझ निर्माण करने का एक प्रयास है। सभी 6 कोर (मुख्य)कोर्स महत्वपूर्ण संकल्पनाओं और विचारधाराओं से संपर्क स्थापित करने में सहायक हैं, व फोकस्ड रीडिंग(गूढ़ अध्ययन)द्वारा दृष्टिकोण निर्माण और साथ ही असाइनमेंट बेहतर प्रैक्टिस-ध्योरी इंटरफेस (अभ्यास-सिद्धांत सामंजस्य) की समझ देते हैं।

कौशल आधारित कोर्स (सेमेस्टर 3 से उपलब्ध)शैक्षिक सिद्धांतों के अनुप्रयोगों से जुड़े हुए हैं और ऐसे समृद्ध व्यवहारिक मौके देते हैं जिससे नए सिद्धांतों का निर्माण किया जा सके और विद्यमान सिद्धांतों की सराहना कर पुनर्बलित किया जा सके। विचार यह है कि प्रत्येक छात्रा को चिंतन- मनन,विश्लेषण और लघु अनुसंधान (शोध) में सम्मिलित किया जाए और शिक्षा शास्त्र में आगे की पढ़ाई के लिए उत्साह विकसित किया जाए।

4. English

The department of English has been functional ever since the inception of the college in 1994. The aim of Department is to trigger learner enthusiasm and nurture students' interest and passion in the study and practice of English language, as part of the curriculum.

The faculty is hard working and well qualified with over 95% members having completed their PhD. Faculty members are highly qualified. They continue to attend Refresher Courses and Orientation Programmes to keep themselves abreast of the latest trends in English literature and language. Various articles have been published by the faculty members in national as well as international journals which enhances their professional efficiency. The team also makes special efforts to update its knowledge bank through regular participation in seminars and workshops. The performance of students in university examination is highly admirable. The Department also conducts Seminars, Workshops, Conferences, and other events to enrich the competence level of thestudents.

English is compulsory for B.A./B. Com.(Programme) students and is taught in alternate semesters namely, I, II or III, IV. The streaming A,B

and C is based on Class XII marks in English. There will

be three streams:

- 1. 80% and above: ENGLISH LANGUAGE THROUGH LITERATURE
- 2. 60% and above, up to 80%: ENGLISH FLUENCY
- 3. Less than 60%: ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

AECC(English) is offered across all courses. There will be three streams in AECC(English) also.

The streaming A, B

and C is based on Class XII marks in English.

- 1. 80% and above: AECC (English-A)
- 2. 60% and above up to 80%: AECC (English-B)
- 3. Less than 60%: AECC (English-C)

For Generic English, the following options may be taken in Semester I, II and III IV respectively,

- 1. Academic Writing and Composition
- 2. Language, Literature and Culture
- 3. Contemporary India: Women and Empowerment
- 4. Readings on Indian Diversities and Literary Movements

5. Food Technology (F.T.)

The new multidisciplinary curriculum of B.A. (Programme) with Food Technology (major/minor) offers flexibility of programme structure while ensuring that the students get a strong foundation in the subject and gain in depth knowledge of various aspects of the field. It attempts to approach new areas of learning, develop competencies of the students for food science and technology and thereby open avenues for academic understanding, skill development, entrepreneurship and employment in food sector. The University of Delhi hopes the multidisciplinary approach of the B.A. (Programme) with Food Technology will help students in making an informed decision regarding the goals that they wish to pursue in further education and life, at large.

The framework has been developed to allow flexibility, creativity and innovation in multidisciplinary design teaching-learning process at all levels. A student pursuing BA programme would be required to choose DSC from two streams or disciplines of study. The student can do either a Major or a Minor in Food Technology. While Discipline A would be of Food Technology (Major or Minor); Discipline B can be of any other discipline (stream of study) such as economics or geographyoffered in BA programme in college. The contents have been drawn keeping the advancements in the discipline of Food Technology in mind. The course offers interesting Skill Enhancement courses too. They reflect the Indian knowledge system together with current changing needs of students and the demands of evolving food industry.

The course B.A. (Prog.) with Food Technology has been developed keeping the following objectives in mind.

- To enable students to demonstrate systematic, extensive and coherent knowledge as well as

skills, attitude and values in the areas of food science and processing as a discipline.

- To enhance their capacities and ensure competitiveness and excellence in academics, research and extension.
- To prepare the students for suitable career progression in the field of food processing, entrepreneurship and for employment in food business organizations.
- Train the students to take the applications of various areas of food processing from the lab to the community/industry to improve the quality of life of people using effective communication skills and techniques.
- To develop requisite skills for undertaking research in the areas of food science and technology.
- To empower the students with knowledge base and functional skills to start their own enterprises.

*In addition to above, students upon successful completion of BA Programme with major in Food Technology shall be more equipped to take higher education such as PhD. They would also be able to take up higher-middle and higher-level positions in leading companies and organizations of the food and allied sectors.

खाद्य प्रौद्योगिकी

खाद्य प्रौद्योगिकी गृह-विज्ञान का एक अनुशासन पाठ्यक्रम है। इस पाठ्यक्रम का उद्देश्य छात्राओं को बेकिंग और फल-सब्जी संरक्षण की तकनीक सिखाना, खाद्य-विज्ञान और खाद्य-संरक्षण के व्यापक सन्दर्भों में कुशल बनाना है। छात्राओं में खाद्य प्रौद्योगिकी के विविध विषयों की बहुआयामी तथा सम्पूर्ण समझ विकसित करना, एक प्रतिस्पर्धात्मक रूचि जागृत कर ज्ञान के नए-नए क्षेत्रों की ओर अग्रसर करना इस पाठ्यक्रम का उद्देश्य है, जिससे छात्र स्वालंबन एवं स्वरोजगार की दिशा में एक अकादिमक समझदारी और कुशलता के साथ आगे बढ़ सकें। यह पाठ्यक्रम खाद्य-विज्ञान के नए आयामों को सीखने की प्रवृति को विकसित कर छात्राओं की कार्य दक्षता को बढ़ता है। इस प्रकार कौशल-विकास, अकादिमक समझ, उद्यमिता और खाद्य-उद्योग में रोजगार के लिए विविध मार्ग खोलना इस पाठ्यक्रम की सामग्री रही है जो खाद्य संरक्षण उद्योग के विस्तृत फलक को समायोजित करने के लिए तैयार किया गया है। यह पाठ्यक्रम खाद्य उत्पाद-विकास तथा खाद्य पदार्थों सिहत खाद्य-उद्योग की बदलती जरूरतों को दर्शाता है। तथा छात्रों में संरक्षण, बेकरी-प्रौद्योगिकी, उद्यमिता और खाद्य-गुणवत्ता के प्रबंधन की समझ भी विकसित करता है।

6. Geography B.A. (P)

The Department of Geography began in 1994 with the inclusion of the subject paper in B.A. (Programme). While studying Geography as a Discipline, students will have a sound understanding of basic theory in Geography and of emerging concerns, which have a spatial bearing at the global and national level. This would prepare them to pursue advanced courses in Geography and related disciplines, or branch off to other related fields.

7. Human Development and Family Empowerment (H.D.F.E.)

The undergraduate program in Bachelors with Human Development and Family Empowerment (HDFE) has been contextualized and embedded in the broader perspective of life span development. The increasing thrust on development programs and legislations for women and children generates awareness in preparing the students on 'quality intervention programs'. The course emphasizes the integration and application of knowledge on Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE), to provide stimulating environment to young children, and also to provide practical experiences of working with children. This is to enable students to develop necessary skills to work effectively with infants and preschoolers in various settings.

The course offers an interesting assortment of skill based courses and generic courses for students of other disciplines to allow for effective transmission of relevant experiences of daily living. In a nutshell, the course offers a rich combination of developmental psychology, early childhood education and disability studies to the undergraduate students.

As per the NEP 2020, 'education must move towards less content, and more towards learning about how to think critically and solve problems, how to be creative and multidisciplinary, and how to innovate, adapt, and absorb new material in novel and changing fields. Pedagogy must evolve to make education more experiential, holistic, integrated, inquiry-driven, discovery-oriented, learner-centred, discussion-based, flexible, and, of course, enjoyable'. To implement and abide by the instructions in NEP 2020, all the papers in the discipline of Human Development and Family Empowerment (HDFE) have been designed in a manner that these include a practical component. The inclusion of practical ensures learning experience to be experimental, discovery-oriented and discussion-based, as clearly instructed in NEP 2020.

8. History

The History curriculum under NEP is designed in a way to give students holistic view about the different aspects of historical past involving societal, cultural, political, geographical and economic changes based on the available sources.

The course involves students to trace the course of time from past to present and establish the skill of drawing parallels and looking out for differences in the course of the study.

The core course covers the history of India from ancient to modern period.

The optional courses include World history and European History. To make the subject more interactive and to include practical aspects to the course, skill enhancement and generic courses like Historical heritage and tourism, Museums and archives, popular culture and other similar courses are included as a part of the curriculum.

इतिहास विभाग

बी ए प्रोग्राम में पढ़ाए जाने वाले इतिहास के विषय का प्रारूप इस तरह बनाया गया है कि छात्राओं को स्रोतों पर आधारित विश्व के सभी समाज, संस्कृतियों ,आर्थिक एवं राजनैतिक परिवर्तन, विभिन्न व्यक्तित्वों और स्थानों का ज्ञान प्राप्त हो सके। यह छात्राओं के अतीत और वर्तमान में निरंतरता और परिवर्तन के जटिल मूल्यांकन के कौशल में वृद्धि करता है। बी ए प्रोग्राम के इतिहास विषय के कोर कोर्स में प्राचीन भारत के इतिहास से लेकर आधुनिक भारत के इतिहास से संबंधित पेपर्स पढ़ाए जाते हैं। वैकल्पिक पेपरों में युरोप अथवा विश्व का इतिहास पढ़ाया जाता है। कौशल वृद्धि विषय के अंतर्गत एतिहासिक धरोहर एवं पर्यटन, पुरातात्विक विज्ञान, संग्रहालय एवं अभिलेखागार और जन संस्कृति जैसे पेपर पढ़ाए जाते हैं।

9. Mathematics

Mathematics has always been attractive to students with diverse career aspirations. After completing B.A.(Programme), students can pursue Masters in Mathematics, MCA, MBA, B.Ed. They can also explore the areas like actuarial sciences, banking and civil services etc. Moreover, Mathematics is an integral part of various competitions and job-seeking examinations. B.A.(Programme) with Mathematics has a combination of core courses, skill enhancement and discipline specific elective courses. In skill enhancement courses Latex, Computer algebra system, Statistical software:R and Transportation and network flow problems will be taught. Preference will be given to students who have studied Mathematics upto class 12.

गणित विभाग

विविध कैरियर आकांक्षाओं वाले छात्रों के लिए गणित हमेशा आकर्षक रहा है। बीए (कार्यक्रम) पूरा करने के बाद, छात्र गणित, एमसीए, एमबीए, बी.एड. में परास्नातक कर सकते हैं। वे बीमांकिक विज्ञान, बैंकिंग और सिविल सेवाओं आदि जैसे क्षेत्रों का भी पता लगा सकते हैं। इसके अलावा, गणित विभिन्न प्रतियोगिताओं और नौकरी तलाशने वाली परीक्षाओं का एक अभिन्न अंग है। गणित के साथ बीए (कार्यक्रम) में मुख्य पाठ्यक्रम, कौशल वृद्धि और अनुशासन विशिष्ट वैकल्पिक पाठ्यक्रम का संयोजन है। स्किल एन्हांसमेंट कोर्स में लेटेक्स, कंप्यूटर अलजेब्रा सिस्टम, स्टैटिस्टिकल सॉफ्टवेयर:आर और ट्रांसपोर्टेशन और नेटवर्क फ्लो प्रॉब्लम्स पढ़ाया जाएगा। कक्षा 12 तक गणित पढ़ने वाले छात्रों को वरीयता दी जाएगी।

10. Music

The Music Department was established in 1997 and since then its dedicated faculty has been working for academic and cultural growth of the college. It is offered as a part of the B.A. PROGRAMME. The department teaches classical Music (Vocal) covering different areas of HINDUSTANI MUSIC. The Department also registers students for three year music course. The course familiarizes the students with the fundamentals of various ragas, history of music, and life sketches of great musicians and musicologists. It helps them to develop their potential in music and opens up channels for entry into Post Graduation, M.Phil. Ph.D.in music, and teaching career later on. Music helps develop a holistic understanding of the subject, promoting skill development and employability.

Music is the study of behaviour and mind as well as all aspects of human consciousness and unconsciousness. The department has been consistently producing good result since 1997. Along with contribution in high score, music is making student self reliant and help them in understanding and developing their personality. The subject is in high demand in the market in various fields such as teacher, singer, music therapist, etc. Numerous fields open for students

to pursue their career.

The Department of Music organizes various workshops. Students also participate in various other activities like intra college competition or duet competition. Students are encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities in other colleges.

<u>संगीत-विभाग</u>

संगीत विभाग की स्थापना 1997 में हुई, तब से आज तक संगीत विभाग महाविद्यालय के शैक्षणिक-सांस्कृतिक क्रियाकलापों में उल्लेखनीय योगदान दे रहा है। बी. ए. प्रोग्राम.- संगीत के तीन वर्षीय पाठ्यक्रम के अंतर्गत शास्त्रीय-हिंदुस्तानी संगीत के विविध रूपों, प्रमुख राग-रागनियों का शिक्षण दिया जाता है साथ ही संगीत के इतिहास और महान संगीतज्ञों के व्यक्तित्व व उनके योगदान से अवगत कराया जाता है। यह पाठ्यक्रम संगीत में एम. ए., एम. फिल., पी.एच. डी. एवं अध्यापन की दृष्टि से महत्वपूर्ण पाठ्यक्रम है। इसकी रोजगारपरक संभावनाएँ अनंत हैं।

11. Nutrition and Health Education (N.H.E.)

Nutrition plays a key role in the development of a country. The novel curriculum particularly holds importance in the light of Integrated Nutrition Support Programme – Mission Poshan 2.0, which is India's flagship programme to improve nutritional outcomes of the populations by leveraging technology, a targeted approach and convergence. Further, the need for better nutrition has been duly recognized in Sustainable Development Goal 2, which aims to end hunger, achieve food security and improved nutrition. The UGCF framework brings out the multidisciplinary approach, adherence to innovative ways to allow the student maximum flexibility to the extent of having the liberty to eventually design the degree with multiple exit options. It also ensures that the student gets a strong foundation in the subject and gains in-

depth knowledge of diverse aspects of the field which is intended to suit the present day needs of the student in terms of securing their path towards higher studies or employment.

Nutrition and Health education discipline equips the students to develop an inclusive and multidimensional understanding of the fundamentals of nutrition, food science, nutritional concerns in various stages of life cycle, food safety, food hygiene and sanitation, food and nutrition security as well as the vast spectrum of malnutrition. This discipline furnishes the students for appropriate skill development, academic understanding, entrepreneurship, community engagement and employment across diverse fields such as community nutrition, health clinics, NGOs, etc. The students can fetch jobs in numerous nutrition-based programs of the country and can get involved in nutrition counselling, programme planning, implementation as well as monitoring and surveillance. They can be initiators of a cascade effect by being trainer of the trainers for spreading nutrition related awareness among the masses as well as in promoting capacity building of individuals and communities across the segments of the society for social/ economic empowerment. In addition, the students are also equipped to set up a small scale food enterprise or can also engage in writing food blogs etc.

पोषण और स्वास्थ्य शिक्षा

किसी भी देश के विकास में पोषण की अहम भूमिका होती है। नया पाठ्यक्रम विशेष रूप से एकीकृत पोषण सहायता कार्यक्रम – मिशन पोषण 2.0 के आलोक में महत्व रखता है, जो कि प्रौद्योगिकी, एक लिक्षित दृष्टिकोण और अभिसरण द्वारा आबादी के पोषण संबंधी परिणामों में सुधार करने के लिए भारत का प्रमुख कार्यक्रम है। इसके अलावा, सतत विकास लक्ष्य 2 में बेहतर पोषण की आवश्यकता को विधिवत मान्यता दी गई है, जिसका उद्देश्य भूख को समाप्त करना, खाद्य सुरक्षा प्राप्त करना और पोषण में सुधार करना है। यूजीसीएफ ढांचा बहु-विषयक दृष्टिकोण को सामने लाता है, छात्र को अधिकतम लचीलेपन की अनुमित देने के लिए नवीन तरीकों का पालन करता है तािक अंततः कई निकास विकल्पों के साथ डिग्री को डिजाइन करने की स्वतंत्रता हो। यह भी सुनिश्चित करता है कि छात्र को विषय में एक मजबूत आधार मिले और क्षेत्र के विविध पहलुओं का गहन ज्ञान प्राप्त हो, जिसका उद्देश्य उच्च अध्ययन या रोजगार की दिशा में अपना रास्ता सुरिक्षित करने के मामले में छात्र की वर्तमान जरूरतों के अनुरूप है।

पोषण और स्वास्थ्य शिक्षा छात्रों को पोषण, खाद्य विज्ञान, जीवन चक्र के विभिन्न चरणों में पोषण संबंधी चिंताओं, खाद्य सुरक्षा, खाद्य स्वच्छता और स्वच्छता, खाद्य और पोषण सुरक्षा का एक समावेशी और बहुआयामी समझ विकसित करने के लिए तैयार करता है। यह छात्रों को उपयुक्त कौशल विकास, अकादिमिक समझ, सामुदायिक जुड़ाव और सामुदायिक पोषण, स्वास्थ्य क्लीनिक, गैर सरकारी संगठनों आदि जैसे विविध क्षेत्रों में रोजगार के लिए प्रस्तुत करता है। छात्र देश के कई पोषण-आधारित कार्यक्रमों में नौकरी प्राप्त कर सकते हैं और पोषण परामर्श, कार्यक्रम योजना, कार्यान्वयन के साथ-साथ निगरानीमें शामिल सकते हैंहों। वे लोगों के बीच पोषण संबंधी जागरूकता फैलाने के साथ-साथ आर्थिक सशक्तिकरण के लिए समाज के सभी वर्गों में व्यक्तियों और समुदायों की क्षमता निर्माण को बढ़ावा देने के लिए प्रशिक्षकों के प्रशिक्षक बनकर एक के आरंभकर्ता हो सकते हैं। इसके अलावा, छात्र एक छोटे पैमाने पर खाद्य उद्यम स्थापित करने के लिए भी सुसज्जित हैं या खाद्य ब्लॉग आदि लिखने में भी संलग्न हो सकते हैं।

12. Office Management and Secretarial Practice (O.M.S.P.)

Office Management and Secretarial Practice is a practical based job oriented commercial course for learning better management of modern office through improved knowledge of front office and back office as well as communication and office management with theoretical and practical knowledge of stenography (English) and wide use of computer applications and internet are par

of the cturriculum, which are the basic need of today's changing methods of working in modern offices. The main purpose of this course is to familiarize the students with different activities, the facilities, the working environment, tools and equipments provided to the staff of modern office. Smooth functioning of any organization depends upon the way various activities are organized. This course is a need for today's job market in any field as government as well as private and corporate sector. Students get jobs very soon by doing this course. This course will make students proficient in terms of managing general office activities.

O.M.S.P offers a wide spectrum of papers like Business Communication, Office Management and Secretarial Practice, Computer Applications (Theory), Stenography (English), Advance Stenography, Computer Applications and Stenography (practical). There are two special practical papers for elective optional in CBCS course such as practical stenography and e-typewriting and the other is advance stenography and computer applications.

Preference would be given to students having O.M.S.P. subject at 10+2 level and having basic knowledge of computer.

Having English subject at 10+2 level is compulsory.

ऑफिस मैनेजमेंट एवं सेक्रेटेरीय प्रैक्टिस

ऑफिस मैनेजमेंट एवं सेक्रेटेरीय प्रैक्टिस, आधुनिक कार्यालय के बेहतर प्रबंधन को सीखने के लिए व्यावहारिक और नौकरी उन्मुख वाणिज्यिक पाठ्यक्रम है जो फ्रंट ऑफिस और बैक ऑफिस के साथ-साथ संचार और कार्यालय प्रबंधन के माध्यम से स्टेनोग्राफी (अंग्रेजी) के सैद्धांतिक और व्यावहारिक ज्ञान के साथ संचार और कार्यालय प्रबंधन के व्यापक उपयोग के माध्यम से है। यह विषय कंप्यूटर अनुप्रयोग और इंटरनेट पाठ्यक्रम का हिस्सा है, जो आधुनिक कार्यालयों में काम करने के आज के बदलते तरीकों की मूलभूत आवश्यकता है। इस कोर्स का मुख्य उद्देश्य आधुनिक कार्यालय के कर्मचारियों को प्रदान की गई विभिन्न गतिविधियों, सुविधाओं, कामकाजी माहौल और उपकरणों के साथ छात्रों को परिचित कराना है। किसी भी संगठन की निर्बाध कार्यप्रणाली विभिन्न गतिविधियों के आयोजन के तरीके पर निर्भर करती है। इस कोर्स की सरकार के साथ-साथ निजी कॉरपोरेट स्रोत के रूप में किसी भी क्षेत्र में जॉब मार्केट की आवश्यकता है। इस कोर्स को करने के बाद छात्राओं को शीघ्र नौकरी के अवसर प्रदान होते हैं।

13. Physical Education

The Department of Physical Education of Aditi Mahavidyalaya caters the need of physical activity, sports and fitness related fervor of every student of the college. The aim of the department is to develop the life skills in the students and to fill their life with purposeful, meaningful and enjoyable physical activity. Department also provide guidance and counseling to the students keeping in view their individual needs. The Department offer generic elective in Physical Education for the students of the college. We are also planning to start the discipline subject of Physical Education for B.A. Programme students.

Department provides the facilities throughout the year in multifarious games such as Archery, Athletics , Aerobics, Boxing , Badminton, Chess, Judo, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Taekwondo, Volleyball, Power-Lifting & Weight Lifting, Wrestling, Yoga etc. The college has also opened meditation center for the students and the staff. We are going to develop the indoor facilities like Table-Tennis for all the students.

The Department offers international standard coaching for different sports events to excel the performance of college teams at various levels. Our college students have participated in Inter College, North Zone Inter University, All India University, National and International events etc. Department organizes Interclass competitions in various games for talent identification. Games and sports are also organized for faculty of the college on regular basis. Annual Sports Day is the platform to compete and won prizes. Department provides opportunities to all students of the college to bring out their hidden talent and develop the knowledge, skills and attitude necessary to incorporate physical activity in their regular routines to live an active, healthy lifestyle.

Sports admissions will be done as per Delhi University Guidelines. Candidates desirous of taking admission under the supernumerary quota for Sports must appear in CUET 2022. For admissions to Sports supernumerary seats a weightage of 25% will be given to CUET score and 75% to certificates/trials/performances.

15. Psychology

This course aims at enriching the minds of those students who have not been able to or intend to join the Honours Courses. It aims to develop a holistic and multidimensional understanding of the topics. It attempts to approach new areas of learning, develop competencies in the students, thereby opening various avenues for self-discovery, academic understanding and employment.

Pedagogy for teaching the B.A. (Prog.) Course

The teaching-learning of the programme would be organized through lectures, group discussions, experiential exercises, projects, presentations, workshops, seminars and hands on experiences. Students would be encouraged to develop an understanding of real life issues and participate in the programs and practices in the social context. To this end, practicum is incorporated as an important component in most of the papers. Use of ICT and mass media and web-based sources are highly recommended to make the teaching-learning process interactive and interesting.

Details of Papers

As Core papers, foundation of Psychology, Introduction to Social Psychology, Understanding Psychological Distress and well-being, Statistical Methods and Psychological Research will be taught in each semester with practical. Along with this there are AEEC (2nd and 3rd Sem), DSE (5th and 6th Sem) and GE (5th and 6th Sem) papers. AEEC students study Counseling

Psychology/ Industrial or Organizational Psychology/ Project / Dissertation. However, in AEEC s kill-based paper in III, IV, V, AND VI Semester students are going to study Managing Stress, Making Decision and Managing human resources, Developing emotional competence or Applications of social psychology. Generic (GE) is an elective paper Psychology for living/ Psychology of Gender/ Self and Personal Growth which will be taught in III and IV semester.

मनोविज्ञान (बी. ए. प्रोग्राम)

इस कोर्स का लक्ष्य उन छात्राओं को बौद्धिक रूप से समृद्ध बनाना है जो आनर्स कोर्स से जुड़ने के योग्य नहीं हैं या फिर आनर्स कोर्स में प्रवेश नहीं ले पाए हैं। यह पाठ्यक्रम न केवल मनोविज्ञान विषय की सामग्री और बहुआयामी समझ विकसित करता है, अपितु विद्यार्थी में नए-नए क्षेत्रों में ज्ञान की जिज्ञासा पैदा कर उनमें आत्मिक-खोज की प्रवृति को विकसित करता है। यह पाठ्यक्रम विद्यार्थी की अकादिमक समझ को बढ़ाकर उसमें रोज़गारोन्मुख दक्षताओं को भी विकसित करता है।

पाठ्यक्रम की शिक्षण पद्धति:

विद्यार्थी को इस पाठ्यक्रम की शिक्षा-व्याख्यान, समूह-चर्चा, अभ्यास, परियोजना, प्रस्तुति, कार्यशाला, संगोष्ठी आदि के माध्यम से दी जाएगी। विद्यार्थी को सामाजिक कार्यक्रमों तथा प्रथाओं में भाग लेने के लिए प्रोत्साहित करने के साथ-साथ वास्तविक जीवन के मुद्दों के प्रति समझदार भी बनाया जाएगा। अधिकांश पपेरों में व्यावहारिक-शिक्षा और अनुभव को ही प्रमुखता दी जाएगी। इसके लिए आई-सी-टी, मास-मीडिया तथा वेब-मीडिया तथा वेब-आधारित श्रोतों का प्रयोग बड़े पैमाने पर किया जाएगा।

पाठ्यक्रम का विवरण:-

विद्यार्थी को प्रत्येक समेस्टर में मनोविज्ञान के आधार विषय- सामाजिक मनोविज्ञान का परिचय, मनोविज्ञानिक समस्याएँ तथा उनका निराकरण, संख्यिकीय पद्धतियाँ और मनोवैज्ञानिक अनुसंधान, प्रैक्टिकल सिहत पढ़ाया जाएगा। इसके साथ ही ए ई सी सी (II और III समेस्टर) डी एस ई (V और VI समेस्टर) और जी ई (V और VI समेस्टर) पेपर भी पढ़ाए जाएँगे। ए ई सी सी के विद्यार्थी - परामर्श मनोविज्ञान/औद्योगिक और संगठनात्मक मनोविज्ञान/प्रोजेक्ट/निबंध का भी अध्ययन करते हैं। ए ई सी सी कौशल आधारित पेपर (III, IV, V, VI समेस्टर) में विद्यार्थी, तत्व प्रबंधन, निर्णय क्षमता, मानव-संसाधनों का

प्रबंधन, भावनात्मक क्षमता का विकास तथा सामाजिक मनोविज्ञान के अनुप्रयोग का अध्ययन करेंगे। जेनेरिक (जी ई) एक एक्व्छिक पाठ्यक्रम है में विद्यार्थी- जीवन सम्बंधी मनोविज्ञान और जेंडर सम्बंधी मनोविज्ञान तथा व्यक्तिगत-विकास सम्बंधी मनोविज्ञान के विषयों को III और IV समेस्टर में पढ़ेंगे।

B. A. (Hons.) GEOGRAPHY

Geography is a unique discipline which studies the most intricate relationship between human and environment from both physical and social perspective. Geography studies the spatial distribution of any phenomenon on the earth's surface and its change spatially and temporally. Therefore the learning of this subject helps us in providing solutions to various environmental

and societal problems.

The B.A.(Hons.) in Geography was introduced in Aditi Mahavidyalaya during the session 2007-08. The course aims to enhancing the learning experience to the students by providing them the real world information and a practical and sound understanding of the various geographical phenomena occurring every now and then. Apart from ample openings in academics, geography opens up an arena of opportunities to students who look for other options after their degree course in business, administration, law and planning etc. The course would also prepare them to pursue advanced courses in Geography and related discipline or branch off to other related fields. The faculties with specialization in different fields of Geography teach the syllabus of through lectures, tutorials, field studies, seminars and workshops etc. The department is proud of having produced young geographers as P.G. students in nearby universities, school teachers, G.I.S. technicians and government officials.

Eligibility criteria: As per university rules

- 1. An aggregate of 45% marks in the qualifying examination.
- 2. The merit shall be determined on the basis of one language and three best elective subjects.

Note: Preference would be given to the applicant who has studied Geography in 12th class

बी॰ए॰ (ऑनर्स): भूगोल

भूगोल एक अद्वितीय विषय है जो कि भौतिक और सामाजिक दोनों परिप्रेक्ष्य से मानव और पर्यावरण के मध्य सबसे जटिल संबंधों का अध्ययन करता है। भूगोल पृथ्वी की सतह पर किसी भी घटना के स्थानिक वितरण का अध्ययन करता है और इसका परिवर्तन स्थानिक और अस्थायी रूप से बदलता है। इसलिए इस विषय की शिक्षा हमें विभिन्न पर्यावरणीय और सामाजिक समस्याओं के समाधान प्रदान करने में मदद करती है।

भूगोल में बी॰ए॰ (ऑनर्स) का विषय सत्र 2007-08 के समय अदिति महाविद्यालय में प्रस्तावित किया गया। पाठ्यक्रम का उद्देश्य छात्रों को वास्तविक दुनिया की जानकारी प्रदान कराने और विभिन्न भौगोलिक घटनाओं की व्यावहारिक और ठोस समझ प्रदान कराके छात्रों को सीखने का अनुभव बढ़ाने से रहा है।

शैक्षणिक क्षेत्र के अतिरिक्त, भूगोल छात्रों के लिए एक ऐसा विषय है जो डिग्री कोर्स के बाद अन्य विकल्पों जैसे व्यवसाय, प्रशासन, कानून और योजना आदि में अवसर तलाश करते हैं। यह पाठ्यक्रम उन्हें भूगोल ही नहीं अपितु भूगोल से संबन्धित और अन्य क्षेत्रों की शाखा से संबंधित विषयों में उन्नत पाठ्यक्रमों को आगे बढ़ाने के लिए भी उन्हें तैयार करेगा।

B. A. (Hons.)- SOCIAL WORK

Social Work is a professional discipline that attempts to deal with socio-psychological and emotional issuesof an individual, groups and community at large for the better functioning of our society. It helps individuals to realize their potential and become useful member of the society.

Social Work deals with various social issues and problems. Students who have genuine concern for the welfare of the society should opt for this course. Social Work equips the student with relevant skills to work under challenging situations and transmits the knowledge required for social reconstruction and regenerations.

Vision: Promoting an egalitarian and just society that enables students to realize the value of strengthening interpersonal relationships and social justice through advanced curriculum and research.

Mission: To ensure that students have the necessary knowledge, skills, techniques and attitude for taking up the responsibilities both at the grass-root and junior level engagement of social welfare and developmental services. The objectives of the course are to:

Impart education and training in professional social work in order to develop qualifiedpersonnel in social welfare and development sector.

Develop knowledge, skills, attitude and values appropriate to the profession of social Work.

Develop understanding of social needs and problems at individual, family, group and community levels respectively.

Learn the application of professional social work.

This course aims at providing interdisciplinary collaboration for better understanding of human needs, problems, services and issues of development. It promotes integration of theory and practice in the fields of social work. The students are provided direct exposure in the field in addition to theory classes. The students will be required to attend four days of theory classes and two days of field work in a week. Medium of instruction is both Hindi and English.

Field work is an integral part of social work curriculum. Students are placed in various settings such as schools, hospitals, de-addiction centres, N.G.O.s', community and industry etc., where they are exposed to the field realities. Once the fieldwork placement is done, no changes will be encouraged.

Apart from field work, the students are taken on a study tour/rural camp to N.G.O.s'and Development Organizations within and outside Delhi.Orientation is an integral part of Social Work curriculum. Attendance in Orientation Programme is compulsory.

The department has 'EKTA' a society, which actively participates in the Departmental functions. The objective is to foster personality development of students through organizational and planning skills, cultural activities, etc. The society provides a platform for the social work students to participate and contribute in different activities like N.G.O. meet, Diwali Mela, Effulgence, etc. The department organizes various workshops, interactive session, career guidance session, exposure visits to different organizations and so on.

This Six Semester course will enable the students to get practical training in the field of social work. Later on they can engage themselves as professional social workers. In addition, students would have job opportunities in various organizations working for welfare of the children, women, youth, scheduled castes and tribes, differently abled, etc., and can further go for higher studies in social work.

Eligibility(as per LOCF B.A. (H) Social Work course curriculum 2019)

The eligibility criteria are as follows:

Any person with minimum 45% marks in the aggregate of best four subjects including at least one language in XII standard examination or its equivalent examination recognized by University of Delhi in any discipline shall be eligible to apply for this course.

Candidates belonging to S.C./S.T. categories shall be allowed 5% relaxation in the eligibility requirement.

Admission Procedure

Admission procedure will take place as per Delhi University Norms.

बी.ए. (ऑनर्स) समाज-कार्य

समाज-कार्य एक व्यावसायिक अनुशासन है जो हमारे समाज के बेहतर कामकाज के लिए बड़े पैमाने पर एक व्यक्ति, समूहों और समुदाय के सामाजिक-मनोवैज्ञानिक और भावनात्मक मुद्दे से निपटने का प्रयास करता है। यह व्यक्तियों को उनकी क्षमता का एहसास करने और समाज के उपयोगी सदस्य बनने में मदद करता है।

समाज-कार्य विभिन्न सामाजिक मुद्दों और समस्याओं से संबंधित है। युवा जो समाज के कल्याण के लिए वास्तविक चिंता रखते हैं, उन्हें इस कोर्स का चयन करना चाहिए। सामाजिक कार्य छात्र चुनौतीपूर्ण स्थितियों के तहत काम करने के लिए प्रासंगिक कौशल की प्राप्ति करता है और सामाजिक पुनर्निर्माण और पुनर्जन्म के लिए आवश्यक ज्ञान को प्रसारित करता है।

<u>दृष्टि</u> : एक समतावादी समाज को बढ़ावा देना जो छात्रों को उन्नत पाठ्यक्रम और अनुसंधान के माध्यम से पारस्परिक संबंधों और सामाजिक न्याय को मजबूत करने के मूल्य को समझने में सक्षम बनाता है।

लक्ष्य : यह सुनिश्चित करना कि छात्रों के पास सामाजिक कल्याण और विकास सेवाओं के जमीनी और जूनियर स्तर की भागीदारी दोनों में जिम्मेदारियों को लेने के लिए आवश्यक ज्ञान, कौशल, तकनीक और दृष्टिकोण है। पाठ्यक्रम के उद्देश्य हैं:

- 1. सामाजिक कल्याण और विकास क्षेत्र में योग्य कर्मी को विकसित करने के लिए पेशेवर सामाजिक कार्य में शिक्षा और प्रशिक्षण प्रदान करना।
- 2. सामाजिक कार्य के पेशे के लिए उपयुक्त ज्ञान, कौशल, रवैया और मूल्य विकसित करना।
- 3. व्यक्तिगत, परिवार, समूह और सामुदायिक स्तर पर सामाजिक जरूरतों और समस्याओं की समझ विकसित करना।
- 4. व्यावसायिक सामाजिक कार्य के आवेदन को जानना

पाठ्यक्रम का उद्देश्य मानव जरूरतों, समस्याओं, सेवाओं और विकास के मुद्दों की बेहतर समझ के लिए अंतःविषय सहयोग प्रदान करना है। यह सामाजिक कार्य के क्षेत्र में सिद्धांत और अभ्यास के एकीकरण को बढ़ावा देता है। छात्रों को सिद्धांत के अलावा क्षेत्र में प्रत्यक्ष अनावरण प्रदान किया जाता है। छात्रों को एक सप्ताह में चार दिनों के सिद्धांत कक्षाओं और दो दिनों के क्षेत्र के काम में भाग लेने की आवश्यकता होगी। शिक्षा का माध्यम हिंदी और अंग्रेजी दोनों है।

कार्य क्षेत्र सामाजिक कार्य पाठ्यक्रम का एक अभिन्न हिस्सा है। छात्रों को स्कूलों, अस्पतालों, व्यसन मुक्ति केंद्र, गैर सरकारी संगठन, समुदाय और उद्योग इत्यादि जैसी विभिन्न क्षेत्रों में रखा जाता है, जहां वे क्षेत्र की वास्तविकताओं के संपर्क में आते हैं। एक बार फील्डवर्क प्लेसमेंट पूरा हो जाने के बाद, कोई भी बदलाव प्रोत्साहित नहीं किया जाएगा।

क्षेत्र के काम के अलावा, छात्रों को दिल्ली के भीतर और बाहर विकास अध्ययन संगठन / ग्रामीण शिविर, गैर सरकारी और विकास संगठनों पर ले जाया जाता है। अभिविन्यास सामाजिक कार्य पाठ्यक्रम का एक अभिन्न हिस्सा है। अभिविन्यास कार्यक्रम में उपस्थिति अनिवार्य है।

विभाग में 'एकता सोसायटी' है, जो सक्रिय रूप से विभागीय कार्यों में भाग लेती है। इसका उद्देश्य संगठनात्मक और नियोजन कौशल, सांस्कृतिक गतिविधियों आदि के माध्यम से छात्रों के व्यक्तित्व विकास को बढ़ावा देना है। एकता सोसायटी सामाजिक कार्य छात्रों के लिए विभिन्न गतिविधियों में भाग लेने और योगदान करने के लिए एक मंच प्रदान करता है जैसे कि दिवाली मेला, गैर सरकारी संगठन संगोष्ठी इत्यादि। विभाग विभिन्न कार्यशालाओं, इंटरैक्टिव सत्र, कैरियर मार्गदर्शन सत्र, विभिन्न संगठनों के संपर्क में आने और अन्य आयोजनों का आयोजन करती है।

यह छह सेमेस्टर कोर्स छात्रों को सामाजिक कार्य के क्षेत्र में व्यावहारिक प्रशिक्षण प्राप्त करने में सक्षम करेगा। बाद में वे खुद को व्यावसायिक सामाजिक कार्यकर्ताओं के रूप में कार्य कर सकते हैं। इसके अलावा, छात्रों को बच्चों, महिलाओं, युवाओं, अनुसूचित जातियों और जनजातियों, आदि के कल्याण के लिए काम कर रहे विभिन्न संगठनों में नौकरी के अवसर होंगे, और सामाजिक कार्य में उच्च अध्ययन के लिए आगे जा सकते हैं।

ए) किसी भी अनुशासन में दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा मान्यता प्राप्त 12 वीं कक्षा परीक्षा में कम से कम एक भाषा सिहत सर्वोत्तम चार विषयों के कुल 45% अंकों वाले न्यूनतम व्यक्ति इस पाठ्यक्रम के लिए आवेदन करने के लिए पात्र होंगे।

बी) अनुसूचित जाति और जनजाति से संबंधित उम्मीदवार को योग्यता आवश्यकता में श्रेणियों को 5% छूट की अनुमति दी जाएगी।

COMMERCE

The course brings together all relevant business disciplines and prepares graduates for realities of job market. Studies in accounting, finance, marketing, management, commercial laws and economics are combined with business communication, introduction to business mathematics and computers. Recognizing the spectacular growth in electronic commerce, specific courses in e-commerce have been included in the curriculum. The modern methods of analysis and data presentation involving computer technology are an integral part of the course content. Specifically, with the introduction of information technology (I.T.) model of examination in commerce, basic I.T. inputs have included in many of the compulsory papers like accountancy, statistics, income tax, financial management etc. Our commerce graduates are supervisory managers in different functional areas of business-like sales, marketing, accounting and finance. The course provides a solid foundation to pursue higher professional courses such as chartered accountancy; cost accountancy, company secretaryship and M.B.A. etc. Eminent speakers from different organizations are invited for discussion on contemporary business-related issues. Every year department organizes 'Commerce Fest' which showcases the students' talent, their organizational and leadership skills.

Short Term Course - Cyber Security Essentials

The Department of Commerce will introduce a 30 hour short term course "Cyber Security Essentials" for students in January 2023 in online mode in collaboration with our training partners "N.I.I.T. Foundation". The course is indispensible for all in today's internet dominated world, where all personal and profession information is available easily in e –space.It will equip the student with various laws and measures to understand, identify and tackle threats related to cyber use.

The Undergraduate Curriculum Framework- 2022 (UGCF) is meant to bring about systemic change in the higher education system in the University and align itself with the New Education Policy 2020. The following objectives of NEP are kept in perspective while framing UGCF:

- to promote each student's holistic development in both academic and non-academic spheres;
- to provide flexibility to students so that learners have the ability to choose their learning trajectories and programmes, and thereby choose their paths in life according to their talents and interests;
- to eliminate harmful hierarchies among disciplines/fields of study and silos between different areas of learning;
- multidisciplinary and holistic education to ensure the unity and integrity of all knowledge;
- to promote creativity and critical thinking and to encourage logical decision-making and innovation;
- to promote ethics and human & Constitutional values;
- to promote multilingualism and the power of language in learning and teaching;
- to impart life skills such as communication, cooperation, teamwork, and resilience;
- to promote outstanding research as a corequisite for outstanding education and development

B.Com. (Hons.)

The Undergraduate Curriculum Framework- 2022 (UGCF) based syllabus for B.Com.(Hons.) provides an opportunity for the students to choose papers from the prescribed courses comprising Core, Discipline Specific Elective and skill based Generic courses.

B.El.Ed (Bachelor of Elementary Education programme)

B.El.Ed (Bachelor of Elementary Education programme) is a four-year integrated professional degree programme for teacher education offered after the senior secondary stage. This programme is an attempt towards fulfilling the need for professionally qualified elementary school teachers. It is designed to integrate the study of subject knowledge, human development with pedagogy and communication skills. It offers compulsory as well as optional theory courses, compulsory practicum courses and a comprehensive school internship experience. Students are expected to cover 19 theory courses and 7 practicum courses during the four-year programme of study. Total weightage of the theory course over four years is 1250 marks and 950 marks for the practicum (total 2200 marks). These courses are designed in such a manner that they offer an opportunity to the students to study in detail the process of child development and learning, concepts and perspectives in education, processes and techniques of school organization and management, various issues related to elementary education and development of skills to relate and communicate with children. In 1995, the college started B.El.Ed. course with thirty-five students and became the second college in the University of Delhi to offer this course. Today, we have alumni of over 800 graduates.

A separate wing in the college building is exclusively dedicated to the department of BEIEd for the smooth conduction of the practicums, workshops and other course related curricular and co-

curricular activities. The Department has a curriculum laboratory in which a well-stacked library, computer (equipped with Internet facility) and Audio - Visual facilities are available for students and teachers. In addition to the basic reference materials, curricular resources and books including children's literature and school textbooks and audio - visual materials are also available in the library. The department has its own laboratories of Biology and Chemistry, along with a laboratory of the cooperating department of Geography, equipped with modern equipments. The Department organizes various workshops - Theatre, Art &Craft, Self-Development and Storytelling (Qissa-Goi) workshops as integral component of the course. Students also visit places of innovative teaching and learning practices in and outside Delhi. Other than these compulsory workshops, students also participate in various other activities such as heritage walk to the area of Chandni Chowk, visit to the National Museum, Science Centre, Bal Bhawan, Craft and Doll Museum, attend inter and intra college events such as TERI Earth Leadership Programme, Youth Development Programme, cultural events and competition in various Fests. BEIEd students participated (first official entry of the college in 25 years) in the University Flower show in the academic year 2019-20. Their hand made and crafted garden accessories, planters were appreciated by one and all. Students actively participated in Election Commission's awareness campaign on voting and did street plays to make people aware and sensitise. Students are encouraged to participate in curricular and co-curricular activities in other colleges and in the University. Students have been participating in various forums and showcasing their talents in poetry writing and recitation, debates and extempore, essay, drawing, poster, collage making and slogan writing, dance, drama and singing events and also present their academic research papers in other teacher training institutes. A collection of activities and experiences of the students of the Department is brought out as Newsletter 'AAROHI'. The eversions of 'AAROHI' for the sessions 2014-15 and 2015-16 are available at college website http://www.aditi.du.ac.in. Department's Alumni Meet 'MILAAP', is also the first alumni meet of the college which was organized in Jan 2013. In past years, our graduates meaningfully contribute to many government and private schools, teacher education institutions / colleges and Non-government organizations like Vidya Bhavan Society and Bodh Shiksha Samiti, Nirantar, Google, SARD (Society for all round development), Katha Manch. Many of them are working as school principals, coordinators, curriculum developers, counsellors, remedial instructors, etutors. They have expanded their horizon by choosing some unconventional but upcoming areas like environment educator, Story tellers, entrepreneurs in education, You Tubers and Blog writers. Some students and faculty of the department have also been part of Innovation (research) projects of the University of Delhi. University of Delhi commemorated a scholarship in the memory of our student Vaishali Tomar to the toppers from the B.El.Ed. first, second and third years for the college fee and book grant.

बैचलर ऑफ एलीमेंट्री एजुकेशन

बैचलर ऑफ एलीमेंट्री एजुकेशन प्रोग्राम विरष्ठ माध्यमिक शिक्षा के बाद शिक्षक शिक्षा का 4 वर्षीय एकीकृत प्रोफेशनल टीचर एजुकेशन डिग्री प्रोग्राम है। यह प्रोग्राम पेशेवर प्रारंभिक विद्यालय शिक्षकों की आवश्यकता की पूर्ति करने की दिशा में एक प्रयास है। इसे विषय ज्ञान, मानव विकास के साथ शिक्षा शास्त्र और संचार कौशल के एकीकृत अध्ययन के रूप में प्रस्तुत किया गया है। यह अनिवार्य और वैकल्पिक विषय ,अनिवार्य प्रयोगात्मक पाठ्यक्रम और विस्तृत विद्यालय प्रशिक्षण (स्कूल इंटर्निशप) का अनुभव प्रदान करता है। 4 साल के अध्ययन कार्यक्रम में 19 सैद्धांतिक कोर्स और 7 प्रयोगात्मक (व्यावहारिक) कोर्स पूरा करना अपेक्षित है। 4 वर्षों में सैद्धांतिक कोर्स के कुल अंक 1250 और प्रयोगात्मक (व्यवहारिक) के 950 अंक (कुल 2200 अंक)हैं। पाठ्यक्रम को इस प्रकार से बनाया गया है कि वह छात्राओं को बाल विकास एवं अधिगम,शिक्षा की अवधारणा एवं दृष्टिकोण,विद्यालय संचालन एवं प्रबंधन की प्रक्रिया एवं तकनीक, प्रारंभिक शिक्षा से जुड़े विभिन्न मुद्दों , बच्चों के साथ संबंध एवं संचार स्थापित करने के कौशलों को विस्तृत रूप में अध्ययन करने के अवसर प्रदान करता है।

1995 में 35 छात्राओं के साथ यह कोर्स शुरू कर अदिति, दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय मे दूसरा ऐसा कॉलेज बन गया जो बीएलएड कोर्स कराता है। आज लगभग 800 छात्राएं यहां से स्नातक हो चुकी हैं।महाविद्यालय

गया जो बीएलएड कोर्स कराता है। आज लगभग 800 छात्राएं यहां से स्नातक हो चुकी हैं।महाविद्यालय द्वारा बीएलएड विभाग को अलग से इमारत दी गई है तािक प्रयोगात्मक (व्यावहारिक)कार्यशाला और पाठ्य संबंधी गतिविधियों का सुचारू रूप से संचालन किया जा सके। विभाग में एक पाठ्यक्रम प्रयोगशाला (करिकुलम लैबोरेट्री) है जिसमें संदर्भों से सुसज्जित पुस्तकालय, कंप्यूटर (इंटरनेट सुविधा के साथ),दृश्य-श्रव्य सामग्री छात्राओं और अध्यापिकाओं के लिए उपलब्ध हैं। विभाग की अपनी जीव विज्ञान एवं रसायन विज्ञा

न की प्रयोगशालाएं हैं।साथ ही भूगोल के सहायक विभाग की आधुनिक उपकरणों से सुसज्जित प्रयोगशाला भी है। विभाग विभिन्न कार्यशालायें आयोजित करता है जैसे अभिनय, कला एवं शिल्प .स्व-विकास और कथा वाचन जो कि पाठ्यक्रम का अभिन्न अंग हैं। छात्राएं दिल्ली में और दिल्ली के बाहर शिक्षण- अधिगम में नवाचार अभ्यास के संस्थानों का भी अवलोकन करने जाती हैं।इन अनिवार्य कार्य शालाओं के अलावा छात्राएं अन्य गतिविधियों में भी हिस्सा लेती हैं, जैसे चांदनी चौक क्षेत्र में हेरिटेज वॉक (विरासत यात्रा),राष्ट्रीय संग्रहालय,विज्ञान केंद्र, बाल भवन,शिल्प एवं डॉल (गुड़िया)संग्रहालय का भ्रमण,अंतर एवं अंत: महाविद्यालय कार्यक्रम जैसे टेरी पृथ्वी नेतृत्व कार्यक्रम,युवा विकास कार्यक्रम, सांस्कृतिक कार्यक्रम और महाविद्यालय उत्सवों की प्रतियोगिता में प्रतिभागिता। बीएलएड छात्राओं ने 2019 - 20 में दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय की पुष्प प्रदर्शनी में हिस्सा लिया (25 वर्षों में यह महाविद्यालय का पहला आधिकारिक प्रवेश था) उनके हाथ से बने उद्यान उप साधकों वह गमलों को सभी लोगों से भरपूर सराहना मिली। छात्राओं ने भारत निर्वाचन आयोग के मताधिकार जागरूकता अभियान में हिस्सा लिया और लोगों में जागरूकता और संवेदनशीलता बढ़ाने के लिए नुक्कड़ नाटक का मंचन किया।छात्राओं को अन्य महाविद्यालयों और विश्वविद्यालय की पाठ्यक्रम संबंधी तथा पाठ्येतर गतिविधियों में भाग लेने के लिए प्रोत्साहित किया जाता है। छात्राएं कई स्थानों पर भाग ले रही हैं और अपनी प्रतिभा का बखूबी प्रदर्शन कर रही है , जैसे कविता लेखन एवं पठन , वाद -विवाद,निबंध, कला ,पोस्टर ,कोलाज और नारा लेखन, नृत्य ,अभिनय और गायन के साथ साथ अन्य शिक्षण प्रशिक्षण संस्थानों में अकादिमक शोध पत्रों का पठन एवं प्रदर्शन भी किया है। विभाग द्वारा ऐसे सभी अनुभवों एवं गतिविधियों का संग्रह 'आरोही' नामक संवाद-पत्र में प्रकाशित किया जाता है। 2014 - 15 एवं 15- 16 के ई-संस्करण कॉलेज की वेबसाइट पर उपलब्ध हैं।2013 में भूतपूर्व छात्राओं का मिलन समारोह 'मिलाप' कॉलेज में इस प्रकार का पहला आयोजित सम्मेलन था।

General Information

Attendance

- 1. Every student is expected to be regular and punctual in college.
- 2. The Student is required to attend at least two-third of the total number of lectures in all the subjects taken together for being eligible to appear in the University examination.
- 3. University Ordinance VII clause 2A, part (ii) states that "the college shall have power to strike off the name of a student who is irregular in attendance or when the absence of the student is for such a long period that he/she cannot put in the requisite % of attendance."
- 4. Attendance in NCC/NSS and Sports would carry special weightage.
- 5. The attendance rules are strictly followed in the college and Principal's decision in this regard shall be final and binding.
- 6. It is the responsibility of the student or her Guardian to know the state of attendance from the college office periodically.
- 7. Application for medical leave will be entertained only if it reaches the college within three days from the 1st day of absence.

Discipline

The saying goes that "self discipline is the best discipline". The following code of conduct is expected from the students:

- 1. To carry identity and library card to the college every day.
- 2. To maintain silence in the "SILENCE ZONE" i.e corridors, inside and outside the classroom.
- **3.** To attend all lectures, tutorials and co-curricular activities regularly.
- **4.** To read students' notice boards every day.
- 5. To use library, common room or canteen during free time and not miss classes.
- **6.** To desist from tearing-off pages from library books.
- 7. To assist college authorities in maintaining the campus greenery and garden.
- **8.** To switch-off light and fans on vacating the classrooms.
- **9.** To respect others' independence in order to maintain your own.

College Infrastructure & Facilities

Library and Reading Room

The college has a well-stocked library having nearly twenty-five thousand books along with a regular subscription of magazines, daily newspapers, and a significant number of books that are added every year. It caters to the needs of around two thousand under graduate level students. The Library has a well-furnished reading room on the first floor with three separate sections for newspapers, magazines, and reference books. The reference section has encyclopedias, dictionaries, directories, annual reports, and other recognized documents and periodicals. The fully air-conditioned reading room can accommodate sitting of about one hundred students and provides a motivating environment for reading and writing. Library provides access to electronic journals, Databases, Federated search, e-books, and subject portals provided by Delhi University Library System (DULS). Apart from the above services, the library has already started subscribing to N-LIST (National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Contents) program of INFLIBNET (Information and Library Network). All the bonafide students of Aditi Mahavidyalaya, teaching, non-teaching staff members have the right to access the College Library. Biology Laboratory

The Biology Laboratory of the college is well-equipped with all modern scientific apparatus to

aid and support the curriculum of Biology (optional paper) in B.El.Ed. The equipments are made available to the students to facilitate practical knowledge of the course.

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Chemistry Laboratory

It is spacious, well-ventilated and equipped with modern equipments and apparatus like pH. meter and conductometer, etc. which facilitate students in conducting experiments and research.

Curriculum and Resource Centre

B.El.Ed. has a curriculum laboratory and Resource Centre. It has an exclusive library and reading space for B.El.Ed. Students and faculty members. It has more than two thousand books, magazines, and other reading material for various theory papers and practicum of the B.El.Ed. Course. It also has various teaching learning material in the form of teaching aids, charts, activities, models, flash cards, science and mathematics kit etc. Other than books, students have access to different encyclopaedias, glossaries and dictionaries. These books and material can be issued to students. The laboratory is also equipped with audio-visual aids like O.H.P., Television, Music System and Computer with internet facility.

College Hall

The College has a spacious hall where curricular, co- curricular and cultural activities are conducted throughout the year. Seminars, workshops, orientation programmes and trainings are organized here. The college hall is constantly engaged in various activities organized by the departments.

Canteen

The canteen is a popular stop-over for students and staff to grab a bite between classes. It

provides an informal space, where students gather informally. It is run under the supervision of the college canteen committee, provides refreshment and hygienic eatables at reasonable prices

Computer Centre

College has three computer labs. The software and hardware is constantly upgraded to keep abreast with latest technology. There are 160 computers and latest special purpose software packages to meet the requirements of the curriculum. Though the students from any discipline may use the lab., the students of B. Com. (Hons.) and B. Com. need to study computer papers as their main papers, the college provides them with the latest special purpose software packages.

Counselling Unit

Counselling Unit opens for three days a week. An experienced professional counsellor who is associated with many governmental and non-governmental organizations is appointed for counselling. A separate cabin is made to maintain the privacy and confidentiality. Feedback is taken from the counsellor intermittently. Students receive counselling sessions as per their needs.

Family and Child Welfare Laboratory

The laboratory is equipped with audio-visual aids to support curriculum delivery. Different psychological tests as per the curriculum are also available.

Food Technology Laboratory

This laboratory is equipped with state-of-the-art facilities to produce bakery items like bread, buns, cakes, pastries, biscuits etc. and preserved food items like jams, jellies, pickles, preserves etc. The laboratory is well-equipped with modern gadgets and equipments for baking, preservation and quality analysis.

Geography Laboratory

A practical knowledge of the subject, through the use of various laboratory equipments such as computers, maps, charts, diagrams, models, barometers, thermometers, compasses etc. is imparted to the students here.

Global fund Conference room

The College has a conference room which is equipped with all the modern equipments and facilities like overhead projector, audio visual system, etc.

Hindi Journalism Laboratory

For the students of Hindi Patrakarita Evam Jansanchar, the College maintains a repository of audio-visual equipments such as overhead projectors, slide projectors, television, computers, web camera etc. to support curriculum delivery. Students are encouraged to use them in their presentations.

Music Room

The Music Room is a great help in enabling the students to acquire the divine art of music. The Music Room is a space to perform various curricular and co-curricular activities, train themselves and participate in various competitions apart from regular rehearsals. It houses instruments like the tanpura, harmonium, tabla, music system and guitar etc.

Nutrition and Health Education Laboratory

The laboratory has facilities of modern cooking gadgets and equipments such as refrigerators, food processors, oven, non-stick cookware, idli cooker etc. Students are provided with the ingredients as well as utensils so that they can work efficiently in a hygienic environment. Students are encouraged to use energy-saving techniques and gadgets that help to preserve nutritional content of food.

Psychology Laboratory

The college has a well-equipped Psychology Laboratory. It stocks latest psychological tests and apparatuses. The equipment is made available to the students to facilitate the practical work of the discipline.

Social Work Unit Room

The Social Work unit is a multipurpose room, where the social work students, teaching staff and

non-teaching staff get-together for various activities like Ekta Associations meetings, faculty interaction with experts, etc. The unit also has a small collection of social-work related books for reference work. This also serves as a reading room for Social Work students.

Sports Room

The college arranges for various items required for games such as Kho- Kho, Kabaddi, Volleyball, Judo, Athletics etc, in sports zone. It also has a mini gymnasium. The Department of Physical Education and sports sciences functions with a view to build a balance between mind and body. The Department provides opportunities and exposure for the personality development of sports girls.

Photocopy

The college allows a private agency to run a photocopy shop in its premises. The services are efficient, economical and student-friendly.

The role of the Dramatic Society is to generate awareness among the students through entertainment and drama, thereby educating them about social and gender related issues. The goal is to make the students realize, internalize and respond to the core problems of the society. The Dramatic Society provides the students with an insight to cope with the day to day challenges. The Dramatic Society organizes a one-month long theatre workshop in collaboration with the National School of Drama for the students who are interested in dramatics and theatre. During the workshops students prepare a full-length play which is presented in the college and Mandi House.

The college has showcased nine plays till date which were highly appreciated by the audience. "Last year the team performed the play titled "কল্মণুন Dreams." It was an adaptation of Munshi Premchand's short story "Bade Bhai Sahab.

Environment Committee

The Environment Committee of the college was constituted to expand awareness among all in the college regarding issues related to the environment. The most important objective is to sensitize the students about the role of clean and green environment.

Equal Opportunity Cell

Aditi Mahavidyalaya is strongly committed to the principle of providing equal opportunities to the differently abled. In order to translate its vision to reality, Equal Opportunity Cell *Samvedana* has been set up. Ramps and tactile surfaces have been built to provide barrier free access to the differently-abled staff, students and visitors. *Samvedana* organises sensitization programmes.

Film Society

Film Society of college holds screening of important films of Hindi and World Cinema. In addition, the society introduces the technique of film and documentary making along with film appreciation methods. Society organises workshop and seminars related to cinema. Last year 'Off-beat cinema' theme seminar was held. The films were shot and recorded by our own students. The purpose of the society is to create awareness about the role of cinema in the development of society and its prominent issues and concerns.

Gandhi Study Circle

This provides a forum for discussion, lectures and activities on the life, work and philosophy of Mahatma Gandhi. The aim is to create an understanding of Gandhian thoughts of truth and non-violence and their perpetual relevance.

Innovations in Teaching Practices Committee

The college runs the Innovations in Teaching Practices Cell where an attempt is made to use more of technology in the teaching – learning process. Automation, optimal use of internet and harvesting of authentic and productive websites, programmes and/ tools etc. are explored. The cell also thinks about interactive teaching, well-researched pedagogies and enhanced learning whether gadgets or technologies are used sparingly or extensively.

Medical Committee

The college maintains a Medical Committee which coordinates primary health care facilities to the staff members and students. The college has a well —equipped medical room with a full-time nurse. The medical room remains operational from Monday to Saturday between 9:00am to 5:30pm. The free health checks up and diagnostic camps in association with renowned Hospitals are organised periodically for all the students, teaching and non teaching staff members.

Medical Committee convener Prof. Bhawna Rajput coordinates series of webinars, seminars, health talks and doctors' consultations to create awareness on the physical health and mental wellbeing of the students. During Covid-19 pandemic, special sessions on the promotion of healthy diet, importance of physical activity and stress management were organised to provide a platform for discussion of combating fear and anxiety in the period of crisis. Medical Committee in association with Committee Swachh Bharat Mission organises cleanliness drive in the college so as to sensitise students of benefits of hygiene in general.

Music Society

The Society helps to identify and nurture skills among students in various forms of dance and music and conducts inter-college and intra-college competitions. Eminent personalities are also invited for live performances.

National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.)

Aditi Mahavidyalaya has a strong and vibrant NCC programme. Aditi Mahavidyalaya, NCC unit is highly maintained. The NCC unit aim to install a sense of comradeship, patriotism and discipline in our cadets.

Aditi Mahavidyalaya, NCC company has a total of 120 cadets all enrolled in the army wing. The college is associated with 2 Delhi Girls Battalion, Rohini which directs the college in the training and selection of cadets at differed competitions at State and National level.

The cadets selected participate in various activities and amongst them are the Independence Day Parade, Republic Day Camp, the Prime Minister's Rally, Annual summer training camps, mountaineering courses, firing/shooting competitions, etc. The cadets show their contribution in various social activities like awareness programmes, blood donation, community education, plantation drives and many more along with annual NCC festival 'SHAKTI' every year.

B and C Certificate Examinations are conducted at the end of the second and third year of NCC training, respectively. The best cadet on an All India basis qualifies for award of NCC scholarship of Rs. 5000 for a year. 'B' and 'C' certificate-holder has many advantages when it comes to the selection process in the armed forces, cadets can directly apply for the officer's entry in the defence. The aspirants applying for Government Jobs can get relaxation in all the exams like Bank PO exam, Civil Service Exam, and many more. The students can apply for the police service, Indian Army, Government Home-guards services, Short Service Commissioned Officer, Soldier Tradesman, Securities Services Operations, Back Office Assistant, Supervisor, Assistant Statistical Officer, Soldier Clerk etc.

NCC Enrolment requirement

Qualifications for enrolment in the Senior Wing-

Student offering himself for enrolment in the Senior Wing should bear good moral character; citizen of India or a subject of Nepal; under the age of 24 years; he is on the roll of the College which is providing the unit or part thereof; he should meets the prescribed medical standards.

NCC Admission Procedure- A student desirous of being enrolled in the Aditi Mahavidyalaya, NCC Company should be a student of the college and shall apply through a common online/offline form provided by the college. The admission procedure of NCC includes a medical examination and a physical examination, written test and interview. The students are required to pass these exams to get admission as an NCC cadet.

If the Commanding Officer or the Headmaster is satisfied that the applicant, he shall sign a certificate to that effect on the said form, and the applicant shall thereupon be deemed to have been enrolled. Enrolment period in senior wing (Girls) is of 3 years.

National Service Scheme (N.S.S.)

College has an active N.S.S. unit. The overall objective of N.S.S. is to develop a sense of social commitment among the students and sensitize them to various social issues. Members of N.S.S. unit are involved in awareness programmes about A.I.D.S., drug abuse, child rights and primary education among slum dwellers. N.S.S. unit regularly organizes blood donation camps in the college.

Placement Cell

The placement cell aims at providing employment opportunities to students while in college, and arranges for internship programmes so that they can gain exposure to practical work environment. The Cell endeavors to increase employment potential of students by instilling confidence and developing leadership qualities in them. The cell reaches out to students of all

departments in the college and informs them of job and internship opportunities offered by the C.P.C. (D.U.) and other institutions.

Rashtriya Ucchatar Shiksha Abhiyaan (R.U.S.A.)

The college is in the process of receiving financial assistance under Rashtriya Ucchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (R.U.S.A.). The scheme will ensure the improvement of overall quality of faculty and infrastructure and facilitate research and innovation in the college. The college campus may soon have air-cooled lecture theatres with modern audio and video presentation system. Each class room is likely to be equipped with audio-visual aids and internet connectivity. The Labs may have state-of-the-art equipments that may help students to truly harness their creativity without having to worry about technical difficulties. R.U.S.A. grant might enable the college to launch value added courses for the students of different streams to improve employability of the students.

Research Advisory Committee

The role of research in the academic institutions is of fundamental importance for its sustainability and development in the modern world. It simplifies concept building and transforms new ideas into innovations in pursuance of a new era of passion for researches. Each finding gives immense pleasure and multiplies enthusiasm towards achieving target.

Aditi Mahavidyalaya is committed to promote research and innovation amongst undergraduate students as per National Education Policy through the Research cell which is coordinated by Prof. Bhawna Rajput. The Research cell of the college aims to nurture research culture in the student and faculties by encouraging research in newly emerging and challenging areas of Education and multidisciplinary fields. This enhances the general research capabilities of the students by way of participating in conferences, seminars, workshops, project competition etc. The Research cell is responsible for the promotion of research activities in the college in the emerging areas of Humanities & Social Sciences by nurturing the culture of the research and supporting interdisciplinary research projects of the faculty and the students.

To fulfill broad vision, the Research Centre aims to:

- Provide a forum of exchanging ideas or establishing a linkage among researchers and experts of leading institutions.
- To organize various workshops/ seminars/ training sessions related to research issues.
- To enhance the research output of the college by encouraging research paper publication in reputed Journals and making available such published information to the end-users.
- To Provide Financial support to faculty members for attending conferences, workshops, faculty development programmes and student research projects etc. and
- To create basic infrastructure and provide funding for Research Projects with students as team members.

Science Society 'Vigyaan Sanjivani'

Science Society 'Vigyaan Sanjivani'was set up in the academic session 2017 -2018 with the objective to empower girls for making informed decision related to science and technology. For instance,making a choice to buy a mobile phone, choosing a sun screen/ soap or any other cosmetics or use of air purifiers. To elaborate further students are made to think why are air purifiers required? Are there any alternatives to air purifiers? Can air purifiers replace functioning of plants? An insight into questions like these helps in developing scientific and critical thinking thus, leading to development of scientific temper.

Every year the society organises lectures, panel discussions, workshops, debate, poster making, quizzes and other intra-college competition on different themes like science interface in everyday life; Women, Science and Teacher Education. In the academic session 2019 – 2020 a number of experts in the filed were invited for interaction with students. Some of the prominent ones were - Prof Anita Rampal (Former Head and Dean, Faculty of Education, University of Delhi, Delhi), Prof Gurjeet Kaur (Jamia Millia Islamia) and Dr Kalyani Akalamkam (Lady Shri Ram College for Women, University of Delhi), Prof Vandana Saxena (Department of Education, CIE, University of Delhi, Delhi), Ms Nisha Sharma, (an Alumna of the college; TGT Science with Directorate of Education, Delhi), Ms Anshumala Gupta, Mr Vikas Saini and Mr Hitesh (Joy of Learning Foundation) and Dr Subhash Chander (Department of Education (CIE), University of Delhi, Delhi)

Skill Development Cell

The Skill Development Cell has been established in college to develop competence and skills among students, which would increase their employment potential. Since its inception, the cell has been instrumental in bridging the gap between education and employment of girls (especially in suburban Delhi) where even sending them to college is a distant dream for many. It aids in training students for commercial and industrial set up.

Sports Committee

Sports Committee works to support the functioning of the Department of Physical Education. It functions in collaboration with the Sports Department and plays an important role in the organization and conduction of various sports events especially annual sports day along with other sports events such as self- defence training programmes, cross country race, adventure sports, health-related seminars and workshops. Committee also plays a major role in taking approvals concerning important purchases of the department and taking grants from the government for conduction of events and workshops.

Students Aid & Fee-Concession

Students are also given financial aid and fee concession on the basis of need-cum-merit basis. Students are required to submit duly filled forms (obtainable from the college office) supported by the required documents by the specified dates in the college office. Eligible S.C./S.T./O.B.C./P.W.D. students etc. students should submit their scholarship form for the academic year by February for processing scholarship to S.C./S.T./O.B.C./P.W.D. students each year (as per U.G.C. guidelines).

Swachh Bharat Abhiyan

In pursuit of 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan', Aditi Mahavidyalaya had launched a special cleanliness drive and formally constituted a committee to monitor and coordinate cleanliness activities in the college. It generates mass awareness on cleanliness and hygiene among students and staff

members by holding regular sensitization programmes so as to motivate and associate them with the campaign in a proactive manner. Rallies on themes connected with 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' are conducted in and around the college campus.

Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan (U.B.A.) Cell Report

U.B.A. is a central government funded programme and is based on Gandhian concept of 'Gram Swaraj' i.e. making villages self-sufficient in their basic needs like food, livelihood, health care, education etc.

U.B.A. Cell of Aditi Mahavidyalaya has adopted Bawana and its adjacent villages to make them self-reliant and hence 'Adarsh Grams'. The college has initiated a baseline survey for the demographic profiling of Bawana and adjacent villages. The N.S.S. team of the college is an integral part of this cell. The U.B.A. Cell of the college has tried to take at least one member from each department so that each department can contribute towards the all-round development of the villages in their own unique way. At present the Cell is working on its funding part. Later, each department will be requested to make action plans for sustainable development of 'Bawana' village in particular and other villages in general. Certain social issues have also been identified by the Cell on which it intends to work in coming months. Exploration and development of necessary linkages with other stakeholders, programmes and units/N.G.O.s in action are also under process. The college has also initiated the process of opening up of 'Entrepreneur Cell' to help villagers and college students in attaining self-sufficiency and self- reliance. In this way, it will also help in developing linkages of the college with the community. The college would no longer be considered as an isolated unit concerned only with academics but a unit which is dedicated to unfold the tremendous hidden potential of people of Bawana and adjacent villages and to transform them into model villages.

VOICES: The Society for Integrated Dialogues & Perspectives

We are glad to start our work under dynamic guidance and mentorship of our Principal Prof. (Dr.) Mamta Sharma and we extend our gratitude for support by IQAC, our department representatives and volunteers, our partner organisations and people associated with the cause and people from

communities from Bawana for being the pillars of motivation. Under the co-ordination of Dr Sunita Bahmani (Faculty, Department of Social Work) & Dr Mali Devi Sawariya, (Faculty, Department of Social Work) on 24th April 2021 we initiated the society - 'Voices: The Society for Integrated Dialogues & Concerns' with the following objectives:

- 1. To develop a holistic understanding of contemporary scenario with the help of expert panellists, stakeholders and professionals in the field.
- 2. To construct and re-synthesize the academic ideas and dialogues for development of critical thinking skills of students.
- 3. To incorporate diverse disciplines and practices for responding to the needs and concerns of all the college students innovatively.

Under VOICES, Jeevan Rakshika – Anti-Covid Helpline was launched to reach thevulnerable sections affected by Pandemic during second wave with the team of 42 dedicated student volunteers.

Women Development Cell (W.D.C.)

'U.R.J.A.', the college W.D.C., is a forum to address various women-related issues and to create an understanding of gender-equality. The cell conducts various activities such as self-defence workshops, experts' panel discussions, seminars and presentations on relevant issues. Maintenance of discipline among Students of the University: Ordinance XV-B

- 1. All powers relating to discipline and disciplinary action are vested in the Vice Chancellor.
- 2. The Vice-Chancellor may delegate all or such powers as he / she deems proper to the Proctor and to such other persons as he/she may specify in this behalf.
- 3. Without prejudice to the generality of power to enforce discipline under the Ordinance the following shall amount to acts of gross indiscipline:
 - a. Physical assault, or threat to use physical force, against any member of the teaching and non-teaching staff of any Institution / Department and against any student within the University of Delhi.
 - b. Carrying of, use of or threat to use of any weapons.
 - c. Any violation of the provisions of the Civil Rights Protection Act, 1976.
 - d. Violation of the status, dignity and honour of students belonging to the scheduled castes and tribes.
 - e. Any practice-whether verbal or otherwise-derogatory of women.
 - f. Any attempt at bribing or corruption in any manner
 - g. Willful destruction of institutional property
 - h. Creating ill-will or intolerance on religious or communal grounds
 - i. Causing disruption in any manner of the academic functioning of the University system;
 - j. Prohibition of Ragging as per Ordinance XV-C.
- 4. Without prejudice to the generality of his / her powers relating to the maintenance of discipline and taking such action in the interest of maintaining discipline as may seem to him/her appropriate, the Vice-Chancellor, may in the exercise of his / her powers aforesaid order or direct that any student or students
 - a. be expelled; or
 - b. be, for a stated period rusticated; or
 - c. be not for a stated period, admitted to a course or courses of study in a College,
 Department or Institution of the University; or

- d. be fined with a sum of rupees that may be specified; or
- e. be debarred from taking a University or College or Departmental Examination or Examinations for one or more years; or that the result of the student or students concerned in the Examination or Examinations in which he /she or they have appeared be cancelled.
- 5. Institutions, Halls and teaching in the concerned Departments. They may exercise their authority through, or delegate authority to such of the teachers in their Colleges, Institutions or Departments as they may specify for these purposes.
- 6. Without prejudice to the powers of the Vice-Chancellor and the Proctor as aforesaid, detailed rules of discipline and proper conduct shall be framed. These rules may be supplemented, where necessary, by the Principals of Colleges, Heads of Halls, Deans of Faculties and Heads of Teaching Departments in this University. Each student shall be expected to provide himself / herself with a copy of these rules. At the time of admission, every student shall be required to

sign a declaration that on admission he /she submits himself / herself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Vice-Chancellor and several authorities of the University who may be vested with the authority to exercise discipline under the Acts, the Statutes, the Ordinances and the rules that have been framed therein by the University

- 1. अनुशासन तथा अनुशासनात्मक कार्यवाई से सम्बन्धित शक्तियाँ कुलपति में निहित हैं।
- कुलपित ऐसी सभी अथवा कुछ शिक्तियाँ अपने किसी प्रितिनिधि/प्रॉक्टर या किसी अन्य व्यक्ति को (जिसको वह उचित समझे) दे सकता है।
- 3. इस अध्यादेश के तहत अनुशासन लागू करने की शक्ति की व्यापकता पर प्रतिकूल प्रभाव डाले बिना, निम्नलिखित कृत्यों को अनुशासनहीनता के अन्नतगत गिना जाएगा -
- किसी भी संस्था/ विभाग के अध्यापन और गैर-शिक्षण स्टाफ के किसी सदस्य के खिलाफ, दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के भीतर किसी भी छात्र के खिलाफ शारीरिक बल, हमला या धमकी।
- किसी भी हथियार को साथ रखना, उपयोग करना या उपयोग की धमकी।
- नागरिक सुरक्षा अधिनियम, 1976 के प्रावधानों का उल्लंघन।

- अनुसूचित जाति/जनजाति के छात्रों के सम्मान, स्थिति तथा गरिमा का उल्लंघन।
- महिलाओं के प्रति अपमानजनक मौखिक टिप्पणी अथवा अन्य कोई प्रयास।
- किसी भी तरीके से भष्ट्राचार तथा रिश्वत का कोई प्रयास ।
- संस्थागत सम्पत्ति का विनाश।
- धार्मिक या साम्प्रदायिक आधार पर असिहष्णुता बनाना।
- किसी भी तरीके से विश्वविद्यालय की शैक्षिक प्रणाली का विघटन।
- अध्यादेश 15-सी के अनुसार रैगिंग।
- अनुशासन संबंधी शक्तियों पर प्रतिकूल प्रभाव डाले बिना कुलपित 'यिद उन्हें उपयुक्त लगे" तथा अनुशासन के हित में उसकी पूर्वीक्त शक्तियों के आधार पर आदेश दे सकता है -
- किसी भी छात्रा को निष्कासित किया जा सकता है।
- किसी भी छात्रा को एक निश्चित अविध के लिए निष्कासित करना।
- विश्वविद्यालय की किसी संस्था/कॉलेज, विभाग के अध्ययन–पाठ्यक्रम में एक निश्चित अवधि के लिए प्रवेश न देना।
- राशि के साथ जुर्माना ।
- एक या अधिक वर्षों के लिए विश्वविद्यालय या कॉलेज या किसी विभागीय परीक्षा देने पर मनाही।
- सम्बन्धित छात्र/छात्राओं के परिणाम को रद्द किया जाए जिसमें वह / वे परीक्षार्थी थे।
- 5. कॉलेज के प्राधनाचार्य, डीन, विश्वविद्यालय में विभागीय प्राचार्यों, पत्राचार पाठ्यक्रम तथा सतत् शिक्षा, पुस्तकालय प्रमुख अपने सम्बन्धित कॉलेज, संस्थाओं, संकायों, अध्यापन विभाग, हॉल आदि में सभी अनुशासनात्मक शक्तियों के प्रयोग का अधिकार रखते हैं। उचित वातावरण को बनाये रखने के लिए वे अपने अधिकारों का प्रयोग कर सकते हैं अथवा अपने संस्थाओं/कॉलेजों में शिक्षकों के रूप में प्रतिनिधि नियुक्त कर सकते हैं।
- 6. कुलपित तथा प्रॉक्टर की शक्ति पर प्रतिकूल प्रभाव डाले बिना अनुशासन और उचित आचरण हेतू विस्तृत नियम तैयार किये जाए। कॉलेज प्राचार्य, संकायों के डीन तथा विश्वविद्यालय के शिक्षण विभागों के प्रमुख इन नियमों के पूरक हो सकते हैं।

GUIDELINES REGARDING DISCIPLINE AND ANTI-RAGGING

- All matters relating to maintenance of discipline among students in the University/affiliated Colleges and Institutions/Departments/Faculties/Halls/Hostels will be governed by Ordinance XV (B) and XV (C). Kindly refer Clause 3 - Ordinance XV (B) which defines categorically the acts of gross indiscipline on the part of student.
- Detailed rules of discipline and proper conduct of students shall be framed at local level by the Deans of Faculties/Heads of Departments/Principals/Provosts of Halls/Hostels of Residence/ Wardens of College Hostels. These rules are to supplement rather than substitute guidelines available from the University.
- 3. Full publicity should be given to the existing Ordinances XV (B), XV(C) of the University & The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (14 of 2013) website http://wcd.nic.in/act/sexual-harassment-women-workplace-preventionprohibition-and-redressal-act-2013 along with the local level rules and regulations to render a safe and secure environment to the students especially new comers.
- 4. As identified in Clause 5, Ordinance XV(B) the Heads of Institutions "shall have the authority to exercise all such disciplinary powers" over students in their respective institutions. Further, they may identify a Disciplinary Resource Person (DRP) in each College/Hostel/Hall/Department/Faculty. The name, address and telephone number of the DRP should be immediately intimated to the Proctor's Office for record and reference. The DRP may directly liaison with the Proctor's Office of the University.
- 5. The Institutions may erect suitable hoardings/bill boards/banners in prominent places within the respective Campus to exhort the students to prevent or not to indulge in ragging. The names of the officials to be contacted and their telephone numbers to report any incidence of ragging should be clearly displayed on the notice board.
- 6. Along with the Disciplinary Committee Person, senior teachers, NCC/NSS officers, if any, and senior students may be involved to form a Disciplinary Committee (DC) at the college/faculty/ department level.
- 7. The DC shall be expected to maintain law and order inside the college/department. The Committee shall facilitate the Process of induction of new entrants, election of new office bearers of union/association/society, organisation of functions and all related activities of the student community in their respective premises.
- 8. Vigilance squads may be constituted (in addition to the DC) taking help of NCC/NSS student volunteers wherever possible to keep constant vigil to avoid cases of indiscipline amongst students and any kind of untoward incident. Such squads may be specifically instructed to take timely action to prevent incidents of hooliganism, ragging, eveteasing and any other undesirable event. The Vigilance squads should also be directed to take care of activities in and around the institutional premises including the cafeteria/canteen/dhaba/student common rooms/visitors' room/play-grounds and other places where students are likely to organise any group activity. Special attention should be given and vigilance exercised day and night over hostels and mess associated to it.
- 9. Sealed complaint boxes be placed in front of the Principal's Office, especially in those undergraduate colleges which have hostels, for the benefit of the potential victims of ragging to enable them to put their complaints/suggestions to College authorities. Officials in each college on whom the responsibility has been entrusted will look into those complaints and take prompt necessary action, as per University norms.
- 10. The Vigilance squads and the DC must act in complete coordination because ultimately action with regard to any incident of indiscipline involving any student or group of students will be recommended by the DC and thereupon respective Head of Institution will initiate the disciplinary action.
- 11. Each student is expected to carry his/her own identity card. Entry to the institution should be strictly governed on the verification of the identity cards carried by students. To enforce such regulated entry, Security Guards and other associated staff may be engaged. Such security staff along with the Vigilance squads may organise, from time to time, some surprise raids on the premises of cafeteria/canteen/hostels/student union rooms/general common rooms/ parking lots etc.
- 12. The use of institutional premises beyond office hours and for specific purposes such as extra-mural activities should be allowed only with the prior approval of the institutional head. The use of institutional premises for any illegal/immoral/ undesirable purposes and activities will be strictly dealt with as per the disciplinary rules and guidelines in force. The caretaker of the building must be instructed to be alert and vigilant so as to prevent unauthorised and illegal use of institutional premises.

- Extra-curricular activities, e.g. drama, debates, quizzes, etc. should be planned in such a way that the student community is kept engaged in constructive activities.
- 14. The system of personal consultant / mentor may be introduced in colleges and departments. All new entrants may be attached both individually and collectively in a group to specific faculty member who should devote a little time and energy for helping the students individually or collectively to overcome any emotional problems resulting from adjustment to new environment, staying away from home. Ideally speaking, a student of science discipline should be given a mentor belonging to other disciplines such as humanities or commerce and vice-versa. Such a system can be a very effective step towards development of confidence and personality in young students.
- 15. The institutional head is authorised to negotiate directly with external agencies like Police, DTC/Metro etc. The University will render help and support towards maintenance of atmosphere of peace and harmony among students. For example, the matters like instituting a police picket, getting a PCR van for patrolling around the institution, arranging U-specials etc. can be directly taken up with appropriate authorities by the College Principal/Head of the Institution.
- 16. Special care must be taken to avoid harassment of any student on the basis of caste, sex, religion etc. In this regard preventive actions are more important than punitive actions.
- 17. The Proctorial system in the University intends to maintain a federal character of the University. It is, therefore, as per our Ordinance that local level decision and actions with regard to matters of discipline may be taken with intimation to the University Proctor's Office. Any kind of help and support that is required from the Office of the University Proctor will be made available on request and on availability of timely information. Any "distress call" to take care of any emergency situation may be made directly to the Office of the Proctor and/or Joint Control Rooms located on both North and South Campus.
- 18. The telephone numbers of the Principal (Head of the Institution), the Teacher designate (Disciplinary Committee Person), Warden of the Hostel/Halls, University Proctor should be prominently displayed on the Notice-Boards of the College/Institute so that students can contact them freely in case of emergency.
- 19. The UGC has recently formulated very strict guidelines to curb the menace of ragging which is available on their web site www.ugc.ac.in
- 20. As per "UGC regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational Institutes, 2009", the Principal/Head/Provost/Warden shall during the first three months of an academic year, submit weekly report on the status of compliances with Anti-Ragging measures under these regulations and monthly report on such status thereafter. The report can be sent by email to proctor@du.ac.in
- 21. The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India has also launched a 24x7 toll free anti-ragging helpline No. 1800-180-5522 and an e-mail facility at helpline@antiragging.in This information may please be given wide publicity.
- 22. A Control Room, jointly manned by Delhi Police and the University Officials at Room No. 13, 1st Floor, Proctor's Office, Conference Centre Opposite Department of Botany, University of Delhi, Delhi-7, would function to deal with any untoward incident. Telephone Number of Joint Control Room in North Campus is 27667221. The Joint Control Room Telephone Number in South Delhi Campus is 24119832. It is, therefore, requested that Principals, Heads of the Departments and Provosts of Halls/Hostels, disseminate information to students and Hostel/Hall residents about the location and functioning of the Joint Control Rooms.
- 23. An Undertaking must be taken from all the students / hostel residents as well as his / her parents / guardian. In order to make the process easy, UGC has launched a web portal for online facility for undertakings. These undertakings can be filled-in from any of the below mentioned two websites:

The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (Ministry Of Law and Justice)

An Act to provide protection against sexual harassment of women at work place and for the prevention and redressal of complaints of sexual harassment and for matters connected there with incidental thereto.

WHEREAS sexual harassment results in violation of the fundamental rights of a woman to equality under articles 14 and 15 of the Constitution of India and her right to life and to live with dignity under article 21 of the Constitution and right to practice any profession or to carry on any occupation, trade or business which includes a right to a safe environment free from sexual harassment;

AND WHEREAS the protection against sexual harassment and the right to work with dignity are universally recognized human rights by international conventions and instruments such as Convention on the Elimination of all forms of discrimination against Women, which has been ratified on the 25th June, 1993 by the Government of India.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to make provisions for giving effect to the said Convention for protection of women against sexual harassment at workplace.
