## <u>EVENTS IN 2K19-20</u>



Placement cell organized its first lecture on "Discover an Entrepreneur in you" on 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2019. The resource person was Mr. Ravinder Bhatia (Assistant Professor, Banking and Finance, Asia Pacific Institute of Management, Delhi). It was an effort to guide final year students of the college to gain knowledge and expertise in the area of entrepreneurship. The session ended with imparting with great value in the budding entrepreneurs who require the guidance and path breaking ideas to lead their way through tough competitions in the global market.

On 24<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 Placement cell of the college organized a program on "Financial Literacy" by Mr. Vijay Kaushik having working experience in financial markets of more than 15 years. It was an effort to develop interesting course plans to meet academic and intellectual need of participants. Various types of financial markets such as equity market, derivatives, bonds, foreign exchange and commodities were discussed. The session focused on skills, knowledge and confidence required to make responsible financial decisions in one's life. It was an effort to educate final year students of the college about areas of financial markets.





A workshop on "How to do Well in Group discussions" was organized on 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 by the placement committee. The resource person was Mr. Ananda Mohan De, faculty from T.I.M.E. Education. The speaker enhanced the knowledge of students about the Group Discussions, Group debates and Group Decisions, etc. The session was made interactive by organizing a mock group discussion amongst the students on the topic "Contribution of doctors, teachers and soldiers" and each of the participant were given detailed feedback in order to improve their skills.

A Special Lecture was organized on "Career after Graduation" on 5<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 in association with Department of Commerce of the college. The resource person was Mr. Nihar, faculty from T.I.M.E. Education with experience of over 14 years in training students for various aptitude based exams. Apart from teaching, he also has three years of experience in sales and brand management. It was an effort to guide students about career opportunities' in different fields after graduation. The speaker talked in detail about available career options such as MBA, SSC, CGL, UPSC, Bank PO, etc.





On 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 2020, Placement Cell of college organized a preliminary round for written quiz under the Young Talent Hunt conducted by Institute of Technology and Sciences, Ghaziabad. Dr. Nitin Saxena, Coordinator with his team of ITS supervised the exam. Around 12 students of our college qualified the quiz and were selected for the final round.

TATA Power Ltd. Conducted campus recruitment for the post of Asst. Officer Trainees on 24<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 in TATA Power - Delhi Distribution Ltd. Online exam was held for final year students at Dr. B.P. Singh Charitable Trust, Pitampura.

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The Placement Cell of the college organized campus placement and training on 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 conducted by TRAKINVEST group (in association with Policy Bazaar). The training program provided knowledge and skills to become Subject Matter Expert (SME) in Insurtech industry. The program was a mix of online and offline module that guides the students about practical and theoretical aspects of insurance and various technologies involved in driving insurtech sector growth.
