Department of Social Work

The Social work department had a packed session 2022-2023, with a variety of academic and community-related activities for the student's professional and overall personality development.

Department of Social Work conducted a **cleanliness drive and say no to single-use plastic campaign in association with Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan** on 11th July 2022. Volunteers from the Department of Social Work, Aditi Mahavidyalaya, and Unnat Bharat Abhiyan under the supervision of Dr. Manju Goel conducted a cleanliness drive and say no to the single-use plastic campaign at Harewali Village. A rally was organized and the students performed street play.



The orientation programme for third-year students of Social Work was held on 20th July 2022. The teacher in charge (TIC) Prof. (Dr.) Beena Antony Reji formally welcomed students and enlightened them on the significance of the final year in shaping a great career, as well as providing guidance and instructions on how to achieve the highest competencies and professional growth. Further the TIC introduced all the faculty members of the department which allowed students to interact with the faculties and they all emphasized fieldwork supervision of final-year students. Dr. Aneesh T. V. coordinator of the orientation programme announced the schedule for the programme and described the importance of each session in the final year of the BSW course. Dr. Seema Rani led the first session of the orientation programme on 'leadership skills' which helped the students to identify their leadership abilities. She also focused on how to shape leadership within the community, especially in fieldwork. Dr. Sunita Bahmani, the fieldwork coordinator, led the second session of the orientation programme, and introduced students to fieldwork guidelines and the importance of fieldwork practice in social work education. Teachers currently teaching in the fifth semester Dr. Rakesh and Dr. Gyanvati introduced their respective papers as well. The afternoon session was conducted by Mr. Baldev Gulati who spoke on 'Disability and Poverty.' In this presentation, Mr. Gulati educated students on the interconnection and vicious circle of poverty and disability. Dr. Mali Devi Sawariya joined the final session of the orientation programme. The topic was "Critical Reflections in Field Work Practice: Importance of Ambedkar's Thought," which aidedstudents in critically reflecting on themselves in fieldwork practice and delivered an introduction to Ambedkar's thought.



On August 26, 2022, an **orientation program was organized for the second-year students** of the B.A. Social Work (H) course in room No. 19. Prof. Beena Antony Reji, the teacher in charge (TIC), welcomed the students and persuaded them to maintain regular attendance in their class, as classroom teaching have its importance in opening up the minds of the students and helps in knowledge gain and personality development. The TIC further encouraged meaningful interaction between faculty members and students, so that the students can benefit to the maximum. Teachers who were teaching in the thirdsemester introduced their papers.



The orientation program for first-year B.A. Social Work (H) students began on 2nd November, 2022, with the common college orientation. Dr. Manju Goel provided an overview of the course. Prof. (Dr.) Beena Antony Reji, the teacher in charge (TIC), introduced the course and other faculty members to the first-year students on the second day (3rd November 2022). Dr. Seema Rani conducted a session on various areas of social work, educating students on both traditional and emerging areas of social work. Fieldwork is a required component of the social work curriculum. Ms. Manisha Pal led a fieldwork practicum session in social work education. Dr. Gyanwati conducted a fieldwork session on November 4th and taught students how to fill out log sheets and report, presenting the report writing skills. Dr. Mali Devi Sawaria took the second session on "Understanding Civil Societies and Social Work" to introduce the concept of civil societies and their role in the field of social work. On the fourth day of the orientation program, November 5th (Saturday), 2022, started with a session to brief guidelines for visiting NGOs that included how to behave professionally in the community and agency were given. Dr. Mali Devi Sawariya and Dr. Aneesh T. V., the orientation program's convenors, accompanied students to SOS Children's Village, Bawana. Mr. Keshav, who works as a "brother" at SOS Children's Village, described the organization's history and nature, its organizational structure, and his personal and professional experience as a social worker at SOS Village agency. The students were able to observe the agency's facilities and functioning. Following the visit, first-year students interacted with members of the Ekta Society, the student association for social work students.



An interaction session on available career opportunities with Dr. Chandrashekhar Singh, Associate Professor, Department of Social Work, Mahatma Gandhi Kashi Vidyapeeth University, Varanasi was organized by Dr. Manju Goel in the college on 15th November 2022. Students discussed and clarified their doubts related to various options related to specializations in Social Work education.





Third-year students of B. A. Social Work (H) visited GMR Varalakshmi Foundation as part of their fieldwork curriculum on 24th March 2023. During the visit, 20 students were accompanied by two professors, Dr. Aneesh T. V. and Mr. Baldev Gulati. Students attended a session on Corporative Social Responsibility (CSR), during which Mr. Nitin Gupta, Program Manager of GMRV Center For Empowerment & Livelihoods – VTI explained the meaning and nature of Public-Private Partnerships (PPP) in India. He also described various CSR activities initiated by the GMR Varalakshmi foundation and explained the importance of the company's passion, attitude, and ethics for successful and very effective CSR activities rather than simply a process of building goodwill.
