The majority of the women students at Aditi Mahavidyalaya are from semi-rural and rural areas since the college is located at the periphery of Delhi-NCR. Mobility is a difficult barrier to accessing education. Ensuring accessibility also ensures that the college premises are inclusive and equitable and promote life-long learning opportunities for all focusing on eliminating barriers in education and providing equal access at all levels of education and vocational training for the vulnerable, including persons with disabilities.
