<u> HDFE Actívítíes 2020-21</u>

The department has been actively engaged in different events throughout the academic year. The schedule of various activities conducted has been enlisted.

- The faculty and students participated in a short-term course by CEQUIN in collaboration with JDM College on "Understanding Gender" in August-October 2020. Several other workshops were also attended through digital mode.
- A webinar on "Empower your Subconscious Mind to Unfold your Infinite Potentials" was held on 9 th Sept 2020 by Sh Ram Verma, a Wellness Coach.
- The fresher's were welcomed through Online Student orientation programme on 20th Nov 2020, briefing them of department activities, syllabi, events and other important information. It facilitated to know them better through digital mode only.
- An Online orientation session for students of semester III and V was held on 4th Dec 2020 to brief them about OBE pattern and guidelines.
- On Sept 2020, HDFE dept Organised interactive session on 'Child Abuse and POCSO Act, 2012.
- An Online orientation session for Semester IV and VI students was held on 4th Jan 2021 to brief them about the online classes and syllabi.
- Dr Reema Lamba (Department of HDFE,AMV) and Ms. Nirmala Muralidhar(Dept of HDFE, JDM) collaboratively conducted a certificate course on "Decoding Disability in Children" during February-March 2021. The objective was to sensitize students and faculty involved in their colleges and other colleges offering similar UG programmes on this issues. An MOU for the same was signed between Prof Mamta Sharma (AMV) and Prof Swati Pal(JDM) for this collaborative conduct of certificate course.

The forte of this course was that there was no course fees, keeping in mind the financial constraints during the Co-vid period. An effort was to keep the students engaged and compensate for their field work exposure in the area of disability which was difficult to be completed during restrictive or lockdown period prevailing due to the pandemic. Fifteen sessions for more than thirty hours were held by resource persons from varied backgrounds such as rehabilitation professionals, medical experts, academicians, parents, research scholars and all those actively involved with these concerns. The different lectures covered topics ranging from understanding the diverse needs of children with disabilities, reimagining disability, educational provisions, capacity building, understanding lived experiences and role of family and community in bringing about a change. The resource persons brought to the sessions their varied and in depth experience and expertise. The popularity of the course could be judged by student attendance that reached 100 in most sessions on the virtual platform of google meet. The deliberations benefitted the students; improving their knowledge base besides sensitizing them on the deep seeded issues as could be interpreted from the feedback forms generated for each session. The course was culminated by an objective test of all the participants and valedictory. The results were shared with the participants and a short video based on the various sessions was previewed. The faculty from other colleges and students provided feedback on the course and a vote of thanks was extended. E certificates were provided to participants with stipulated attendance and test performance. An e-newsletter was prepared for the same.

Dr. Sadhna Jain organized the UGC funded National Conference on 'Unfolding the Potentials of Women and Girls Including Children: Enhancing the Benefits Exponentially for One and All -

SabkaSaath Sabka Vikas Perspective. Eminent people like Prof AnupaSiddhu, Director and Head of Home Science, Lady Irwin College, Prof AnilAneja, Head Dept of English and Convenor, Equal Opportunity Cell, University of Delhi, Prof Geeta Singh, Director, CPDHE shared their views on the above theme.

A pre-conference workshop was held for undergraduate students to develop research aptitude. Prof Rajni Dhingra Dean (Research) from Jammu University delivered the talk on the 'Developing Research Aptitude' Poster making competition, Research Paper reading activity, and quiz were held for undergraduate students on the theme.

A panel discussion was held on 'Unfolding the Potentials of Women and Children through National Education Policy, 2020.

More than 70 abstracts were selected for paper presentation on different themes ranging from the role of technology in empowerment to LGBTQ+ and Article 377. The presentations were made in three different parallel sessions.

The selected papers were published in an Edited Book. An audiobook and the book was also converted into braille to make it accessible to all with an inclusive approach



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
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
