








The new academic session of the Department was started on 10<sup>th</sup> **August 2020 with the Orientation** Programme. The programme was organized for the First Year BA (H) Geography students by the faculty of Department of Geography in which more than 60 students participated. The program provided an opportunity especially to the budding geographers, where the diverse and multiple dimensions of the subject were briefed to them.









### MAGAZINE RELEASE

As the pandemic hit India in January 2020, therefore, on 10th April 2021, Eighth issue of the Departmental Magazine 'Dharitri' was released by the Vice-Chancellor, University of Delhi.





The theme of the issue was inspired by the Goal 3 of the Sustainable Development Goals 2030, "Clean Water and Sanitation". The magazine covered vast range of articles ranging from significance of clean water and sanitation to various diseases and pandemic related with water and sanitation.

### FIELD SURVEY

Field survey is an integral part of geography. In this academic year, due to unprecedented conditions BA (H) II year, III year and B.El.Ed students conducted their surveys using secondary sources, telephonic interviews or by preparing Google forms. Their studies were largely focused on Covid-19 and its impact, disaster management and water pollution respectively.



BA (H) Geography II year students studied the impact of covid-19 and BA (H) III year students focused their study on disaster preparedness and management. On the other hand, B.El.Ed Students studies water pollution in Yamuna river: An analysis of domestic wastewater. The main objective was to know the impact of Delhi's wastewater on River Yamuna. It was concluded that the quality of Yamuna is continuously deteriorating not only due domestic wastewater but the main culprit is the Industrial wastewater which is not treating wastewater at the desired level. A technological advancement or upgradation is very much required to touch the benchmark prescribed by Central pollution control Board(CPCB).

# WEBINAR - GPS AND IT'S APPLICATIONS

The **Department** of Geography in collaboration with Swastik Edustart, Institute of GIS and Remote Sensing, New Delhi conducted Webinar in 29th June, 2021 with the theme -GPS and it's applications. 
