
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#### **Alumni Interactive Session 2022**

## FIELD SURVEY



The department moving ahead with its philosophy of 'Seeing is Believing' organized a field tour to Uttarakhand and surroundings for the students of BA (H) Geography 2nd year and 3rd year. The importance of educational trips with its enormous contribution to the intellectual as well as social liabilities of the learners was witnessed when a group of about 35 students (12 student from 2nd year and 23 from 3rd year) assisted by three teachers were taken to Uttarakhand and surroundings from 21 March 2022 to 27 March 2022 for the field work concerning Tourism and Disaster Management in the area. The students investigated the study area on the theme Tourism and Landslides in the major tourist spots followed by concerning objective to assess the impacts, benefits and prospects of tourism in study area. Using questionnaire, interview and observation technique students have explored the objectives in the area for report purpose. These studies forms a part of the students' curriculum, it gave a better insight into the topic for research.

Department of Geography, AditiMahavidyalayain association with National Institute of Disaster Management has organized three days online training programme on the pertinent theme "Man-made disasters and women as responders since Independence" on 23rd February to 25th February 2022. 
