

In 1995, the college started Bachelor of Elementary Education (B. E. Ed.) course with thirty-five students and was the second college in the University of Delhi to launch it. It is a four-year integrated professional programme of elementary teacher education aimed at fulfilling the need for professionally qualified elementary school teachers. It aims at redefining the social function of the school teacher in the context of achieving universalization of Elementary Education besides focusing on developing a deep critical understanding of the curriculum and pedagogy in teachers, who are believed to perform a transformative role in school education.

Today, we have alumni of over 850 graduates. The Department has a curriculum laboratory with well-stocked reference books. The Department organizes various workshops on Theatre and Performing Art. Students also visit places of innovative teaching and learning practices in and outside Delhi. Students actively participate in other community extension and skill enhancement activities and workshops like Election Commission's awareness campaign on voting and performed street plays. A collection of activities and experiences of the students of the Department is brought out as Newsletter *Aarohi*. *Misaap*, is also the first alumni meet of the college which was organized in Jan 2013. Our graduates meaningfully contribute to many government and private schools, teacher education institutions / colleges and Non-government organizations like Vidya Bhavan Society and Bodh Shiksha Samiti, Nirantar, Google, Sard (Society for all round development), Katha Manch. Many of them are working as school principals, coordinators, curriculum developers, counsellors, remedial instructors, e-tutors. They have expanded their horizon by choosing some unconventional but upcoming areas like environment educators, story-tellers, entrepreneurs in education, You Tubers and Blog writers. Some students and faculty of the department have also been part of Innovation (research) projects of the University of Delhi. University of Delhi commemorated a scholarship in the memory of our student Vaishali Tomar to the toppers from the B. E. Ed. first, second and third years for the college fee and book grant.

Department of Commerce

The rapid growth of the Department of Commerce is reflected in its expansion as well as novelty in its academic programmes. The department comprises of distinguished faculties, expert in their domain, who are always willing to help students to develop their academic potential to the maximum. From time to time Department of Commerce has also conducted various conferences, workshops, seminars and industrial visits to motivate the students and teachers and help in their career development. To build up administrative and managerial skills, students are given responsibilities to organize various events. The much awaited annual Commerce festival "Vanijyam" gives a platform to students to show their talent and creativity. Upon graduation, many students find placements with renowned business organizations such as Tech Mahindra, A.B.P News, British Telecom, Tata Power Company, Genpact, Bank of America, State Bank of India and University of Delhi.

Department of Social Work

The Department of Social work at Aditi Mahavidyalaya was established in Aug. 1997 with a humble beginning. There were 12 students in the first batch and 2 teachers to begin this course. As a Bachelors in Social Work is not much heard of, in the initial years teachers had to do a lot of reaching out in the nearby areas to enrol the students to the course. The teachers would visit the villages and schools near the college to talk about the course and its scope. Within few years itself, slowly and steadily the Social work course started getting publicity in this area. Social work students and their families were our torch bearers as the students were full of praises about the course curriculum and the positive changes each of the students went through in these three year course at Aditi Mahavidyalaya. The Social work Department has played a dynamic role in women empowerment in and around the area of Bawana, through the students as most of them were the first women higher education seekers in their families and communities.

The Social work Department strives for academic excellence and is committed to the overall development of each of their students. The Department organises a number of activities to equip the students with knowledge, skills and training to face the competitive world. The activities are planned to give the students greater exposure to social welfare and social development organisations within our country and abroad. In 24 years the Social work department has expanded from 12 students to more than 115 students .

21 batches of students have passed out of the department, pursued their post-graduation from some of the best Social work institutes like Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Department of Social work, University of Delhi, Nirmana Niketan, Indore school of Social Work, and Institute of Population studies. Today many of the students are highly placed nationally and internationally in Government and Non-Government Organisations. The students are placed in grassroot, middle and higher levels in different organisations. To mention a few, we have students as Professors in Indian and International Universities, Superintendent in Delhi Government Welfare Homes, Probation and Welfare officers, Counsellors, and working in very reputed organisations.

The Department calendar for each year is packed with a number of activities organised by the teachers and students. Some of them are Orientation program, Fieldwork visits, educational trip, rural camp, Diwali mela, NGO Meet, special lectures, Pearl memorial and alumni meet.



Paving the road to professional excellence. . .



Department of Geography

The inception of the Department of Geography dates back to the inception of the college in 1994 with inclusion of the subject paper in B.A. Program.

Geography is a unique discipline in which spatial distribution and temporal changes of the phenomena on the earth surface is studied. The subject has a great impact on the local students who live in fringe areas of Delhi, towards understanding of their surrounding where spatial and temporal changes are very rapid. The increasing interest among students motivated the pioneer faculty to initiate B.A Hons Geography was started in 2007-08. Today the Department has an alumni base of over 2000 students in general and about 500 Hons students in particular. Many of them are well placed in government sectors as teachers, lecturers, researchers, cartographers, administrative officials, GIS experts; in national and multi-national companies as Remote Sensing and GIS consultant and in NGOs as environmentalists, hazard analysts etc. The Department is well equipped with both traditional and modern geographical equipment, maps, charts, #D models, ariel photographs, District Planning Maps of all districts of India. satellite imageries, computers with GIS software, GPS etc. The Department has also its own library with about 200 books.

The Department organizes orientation programs, Freshers Welcome, Farewell bids every year. In Geo Fest, the UN International Year theme is taken for lectures, debate, painting, acting competition to increase awareness among students. Besides, seminars/conferences/lecture series/workshops are conducted every year. The National workshop on Organic Agriculture: A blend of traditional wisdom and modern technology, funded by UGC, the state level seminar on Mega Cities Fringe Dynamism funded by ICSSR, Role of Women in Disaster Management, Youth Empowerment Skill workshops are worth mentioning. The Department takes social responsibilities by educating nearby slum children, by organizing cleanliness drive and Yamuna cleaning drive with Art of Living Organization. The Department also organizes educational trips to different parts of India every year as part of curriculum. In a span of 27 years, we have covered almost all states of India.

हिन्दी विभाग

अदिति महाविद्यालय के हिन्दी विभाग ने महाविद्यालय के स्थापना वर्ष(1994) से ही अपनी अध्यापन यात्रा में नए आयाम जोड़े हैं। 1996 में हिन्दी पत्रकारिता एवं जनसंचार पाठ्यक्रम के प्रारंभ के साथ ही विभाग में रोजगारपरक पाठ्यक्रम के रूप में नए अध्याय को जोड़ा गया। आज उन्नीस सदस्यीय संकाय वाला हिन्दी और हिन्दी पत्रकारिता एवं जनसंचार समेत विभाग बी.ए. (कार्यक्रम) के छात्राओं के शिक्षण का सफल सञ्चालन कर रहा है। विभाग द्वारा छात्राओं को परम्परागत विषयों के अध्यापन के साथ कौशल विकास हेतु प्रयोजनमूलक व्यवहारिक विषयों को भी पढ़ाया जाता है। जनसंचार, कंप्यूटर और हिन्दी भाषा, विज्ञापन और हिन्दी भाषा, रचनात्मक लेखन, रंगमंच जैसे रोजगारमूलक विषय पढ़ाए जाते हैं जिससे छात्राओं के लिए भविष्य में रोजगार की संभावनाओं के नए द्वार खुलें।

विभाग के प्रत्येक शैक्षणिक सत्र की शुरुआत 'ओरिएंटेशन प्रोग्राम' के तहत की जाती है जिसके अंतर्गत विषय विशेषज्ञों को बुलाया जाता है जो विभिन्न दृष्टिकोणों के आधार पर छात्राओं का मार्गदर्शन करते हैं। हिन्दी पत्रकारिता एवं जनसंचार पाठ्यक्रम के अंतर्गत छात्राओं की विभिन्न मीडिया संस्थानों में प्रशिक्षण (इंटरशिप) की व्यवस्था की जाती है। छात्राओं को सैद्धांतिक ज्ञान के साथ-साथ उनके व्यवहारिक ज्ञान में वृद्धि के लिए अकादमिक विजिट पर ले जाया जाता है जहाँ छात्राएँ डॉक्यूमेंट्री निर्माण, शॉर्ट फिल्म निर्माण, संपादन, रिपोर्टिंग आदि के गुर सीखती हैं।

इसके साथ-साथ विशेष व्याख्यान (स्पेशल लेक्चर) भी करवाए जाते हैं जिसमें प्रिंट मीडिया, इलेक्ट्रॉनिक मीडिया, विज्ञापन, साइबर मीडिया (सोशल मीडिया, डिजिटल मीडिया) जैसे सभी अद्यतन विषयों को सम्मिलित किया जाता है। मूलतः अपनी प्रकृति में संवादपरक विशेष व्याख्यानों के जरिये वरिष्ठ मीडियाकर्मियों के अनुभवों और मार्गदर्शन से छात्राओं को सीखने बहुत-कुछ प्राप्त होता है और वे पत्रकार के व्यवसाय की कार्यसंस्कृति और चुनौतियों से परिचित होती हैं।

प्रत्येक वर्ष विभाग द्वारा समसामयिक विषयों पर छात्रोपयोगी विभिन्न राष्ट्रीय और अंतर्राष्ट्रीय संगोष्ठियों का भी आयोजन किया जाता है तथा अन्य विभागों द्वारा विषय से सम्बंधित शोध पत्र वाचन भी किये जाते हैं। इन संगोष्ठियों का उद्देश्य एक ओर जहाँ छात्राओं के व्यक्तित्व चहुँमुखी विकास करना है वहीं दूसरी ओर विषय विशेष के बहुविध आयामों की जानकारी देकर उन्हें दिशा प्रदान करना भी है। प्रत्येक वर्ष छात्राओं को शैक्षणिक भ्रमण पर भी ले जाया जाता है और छात्राओं पर्यटन स्थलों में अपने अनुभवों की रिपोर्ट बनाती हैं।

इन शैक्षणिक भ्रमण पर छात्राओं को ले जाने का उद्देश्य देश की सामासिक संस्कृति और ऐतिहासिक धरोहरों से परिचित कराना है। हिन्दी पत्रकारिता पाठ्यक्रम की सबसे बड़ी सफलता इस बात से आंकी जा सकती है कि अदिति महाविद्यालय की अधिकांश छात्राएँ विभिन्न मीडिया संस्थानों में कार्यरत हैं। जनसंचार पाठ्यक्रम के अंतर्गत 'अदिति समाचार' के नाम से एक समाचार पत्र का भी प्रकाशन किया जाता है। इस समाचार पत्र के प्रकाशन में छात्राओं को रिपोर्टिंग, संपादन, स्क्रिप्ट लेखन आदि सिखाया जाता है।




