

Programme Structure

The B.A. Programme in Political Science consists of Core Courses and Elective Courses. The Core Courses are all compulsory courses, and are of two categories: (1) Discipline-Specific Core Course (DSC) and (2) Foundation (English/MIL) Course.

The Elective Courses are of three categories: (1) Discipline-Specific Elective (DSE) ; (2) Generic Elective (GE) which is interdisciplinary in nature ; and (3) Skill Enhancement Course (SEC). In addition, there are two compulsory Ability Enhancement Courses (AECC).
