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A number of students gathered in the college ground on 21/8/2017 at 11:45 A.M.

They were informed about environmental degradation due to climate change. Human activity is responsible for the change in climate. This results in the spoiling of the environment. The destruction of eco-system is the result of bad quality of air, water and soil. The habitat of wild animals is also destroyed and this is the reason for the extinction of many wild life species. The loss of bio-diversity is due to over-population. Natural resources are consumed at a faster rate without being replenished. The earth's surface has been constantly changed. A lot of agricultural land has been used for construction.

Degradation of water and soil have resulted in poor health of people, who are becoming more disease prone.

Strict steps need to be followed to arrest environmental destruction.

- 1) Disposable items like plastic should be replaced by reusable materials.



- 2) Less paper should be used as it would help in the cutting of less trees.
- 3) Water and electricity should be conserved for future.
- 4) Environmentally friendly programmes should be supported.
- 5) All items like plastic, glass, paper, etc. should be recycled properly to avoid the increase of landfills.

More than 150 students were present. All of them pledged to follow eco-friendly methods to save the environment for the future. They agreed to use less plastic; carry their own water bottles; switch off lights and fans when not in use; close the taps in the sinks while brushing their teeth and after the bucket was filled; and to spread awareness among others regarding the saving of the environment.

## ACTION TAKEN REPORT

Minutes of the meeting of Environment Committee/Eco-club of Aditi Mahavidyalaya

Agenda: Summary-report of the Activities successfully completed in 2019-20

1. On August 19, 2019, student volunteers and committee members of the Environment Committee launched an awareness drive amongst the students, teachers and non-teaching staff in the college campus for minimizing plastic use in our daily life. Students, teaching and non-teaching staff were motivated to make our college a 'plastic free zone'. Approximately 100 students and 5 teachers participated.
2. On the same day (August 19, 2019), student volunteers discussed and noted the opinion of the students on the impact of the immersion of idols on festive occasions. Most of the students suggested to make organic and natural idols of Lord Ganesha and Mother Goddess which are immersed after the

grand celebration of Ganapati Mahotsav and Durga Puja. Approximately 85 students and 7 teachers participated.

3. Dr. Indu Nashier gave a talk on the topic entitled 'Pollution and Water Resources' on 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 in the College Hall. Approximately 150 students participated in the talk and interacted with their intelligent queries. Around 10 teachers also participated in the event.

4. Committee successfully organized Anti-Cracker Campaign on 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2019 in the College Campus. Committee members and the student volunteers visited all the classes, labs, library and Administrative office for making everyone aware about the threatening impact of the firing of crackers during the Divali. Approximately 150 students participated.

5. A students Group discussion on the Air-Pollution after Divali has been successfully organized by the committee on 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2019. The major issues students highlighted from their personal observations about the pollution



they observed after Divali in their own residential area were:

Approximately 95 students participated along with 10 teachers

(i) Students from all the directions of Delhi complained about heavy smog in their area. They felt itching in the eyes and throat.

(ii) Some students did not prefer to go outside their houses for few days after Divali due to dense fog.

(iii) Senior-citizens were more affected by the Air Pollution.

(iv) Students observed poor visibility in their areas throughout the day.

6. An educational Bio-diversity walk was organized for around 50 students of the college on 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 at 11:00 AM in and around college campus in Bawana. Students enthusiastically mapped bio-diversity level in the Bawana region during



the walk. Students observations and activities were as follows:

(i) Due to rapid urbanization, butterflies, <sup>some</sup> small insects and certain birds etc. were rarely seen.

(ii) Water sources like 'Jodh' have either shrunk or almost vanished.

(iii) Limited varieties of trees and plants were found.

(iv) Students noted what they observed about flora, fauna, and ecological setting in the region.

(v) Students interviewed some local people to understand their knowledge about the local trees, plants, water resources and agriculture.

7. Environment Committee successfully organized Intra-College Environment Awareness Activities and Competitions on 6th March, 2020.

Following competitions and activities were organized:

(i) Notice board display on the theme 'Alternative Natural Source for Plastic in Daily Life'.

Students displayed innovative ideas and materials which can be used in the place of plastic.

(ii) Model making competition on the theme 'Reuse of waste for Sustainable Human Development'.

Students made beautiful and attractive decorative items, pen stand, toys and pots etc. from the waste material.

(iii) Debate Competition on the topic 'Is Urbanization a Stage of Development or Degradation'.

Students convincingly highlighted the benefits and negative aspects of Urban life.

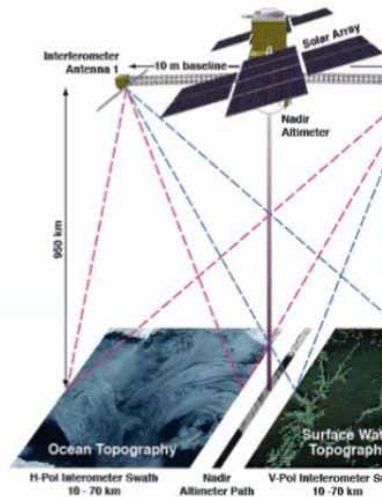

### Environment Awareness Activities



#### 1.A Virtual Visit to Yamuna Biodiversity Park\* (14 Feb 2022)

A virtual visit to Yumuna Biodiversity park was organised by the ECO-CLUB with Vigyaansanjivani science Society of AditiMahavidyalaya. Biodiversity starts in the distant past and it points toward the future. Eco- fest started with a virtual tour to biodiversity park on 14th February 2022. We had Dr. Faiyaz Ahmad Khudsar( ScientistIncharge) and Ms. PreetiVohra ( Nature Education Officer) as resource person . This was held through a Google meet for about 2 hours . This visit was organised to let the students know about bio- diversity park , how they are working , what they are doing to reserve our region from ecologically dead. It was quite productive and knowledge full session . It made students to show their interest towards our comfortably green earth.







## 2. "Delhi Sultanate webinar" (15 Feb 2022)

Delhi sultanate webinar was held on 15 Feb, 2022 at 3:00 pm. The webinar was organized by Eco Club of AditiMahavidyalaya under the Eco Fest celebrated from 14th to 19th February, 2022. The topic for discussion in webinar was " Delhi Sultanate and Water Problems in Delhi" And the speaker for the same was Prof. Nirmalkumar, Professor in the Department of History from ShriVenkateshwara College. It was our honour to take a lot of knowledge from him. He focused on the past and current situation of water in Delhi . He also stated that during the Sultanate period ( 1206-1526 CE ), rainfall and groundwater were stored in huge tanks called Hauz, and baoli, or step wells, were built to provide a constant supply of water in Delhi citizens. But nowadays, Delhi has been facing a supply shortage of water as water levels in Yamuna reduced to a critical low. He also stated many problem related to water in Delhi as well as threw the light on the appropriate steps that we all can take to reduce the water problems in Delhi. The main objective was to spread awareness about the importance of Water by comparing the situation from the past (the phase of Delhi Sultanate) and the present, not even in Delhi but in the whole world.

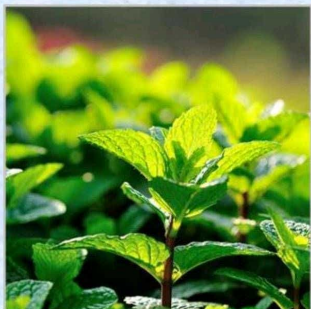
## 4."Crash the Trash" Competition (17 Feb 2022)

the participants to realise we need to reuse the past and recycle the present in order to save our future.

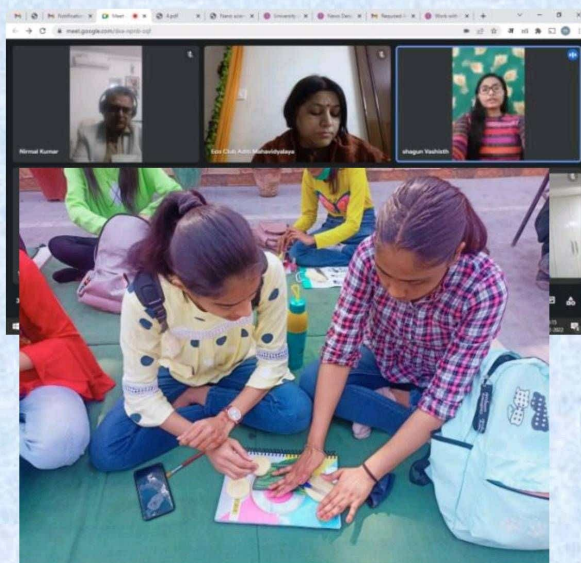


**5. \*Herbal Vatika Competition\* (18 Feb 2022)**

It’s about changing the way the world perceives that strength”.With this thought in mind, Eco-club and VigyanSanjeevani Science Society of AditiMahavidyalayaorganised a jewel clay moulding competition — मणिमुक्ताon the precious occasion of Women's day,on 9th of March, 2022, in offline mode .Students were asked to register themselves for the competition through a google form and a good strength of participants were keen to participate in the competition .The clay that was used in the competition was all home-made and eco friendly and was prepared by the conducting team themselves. 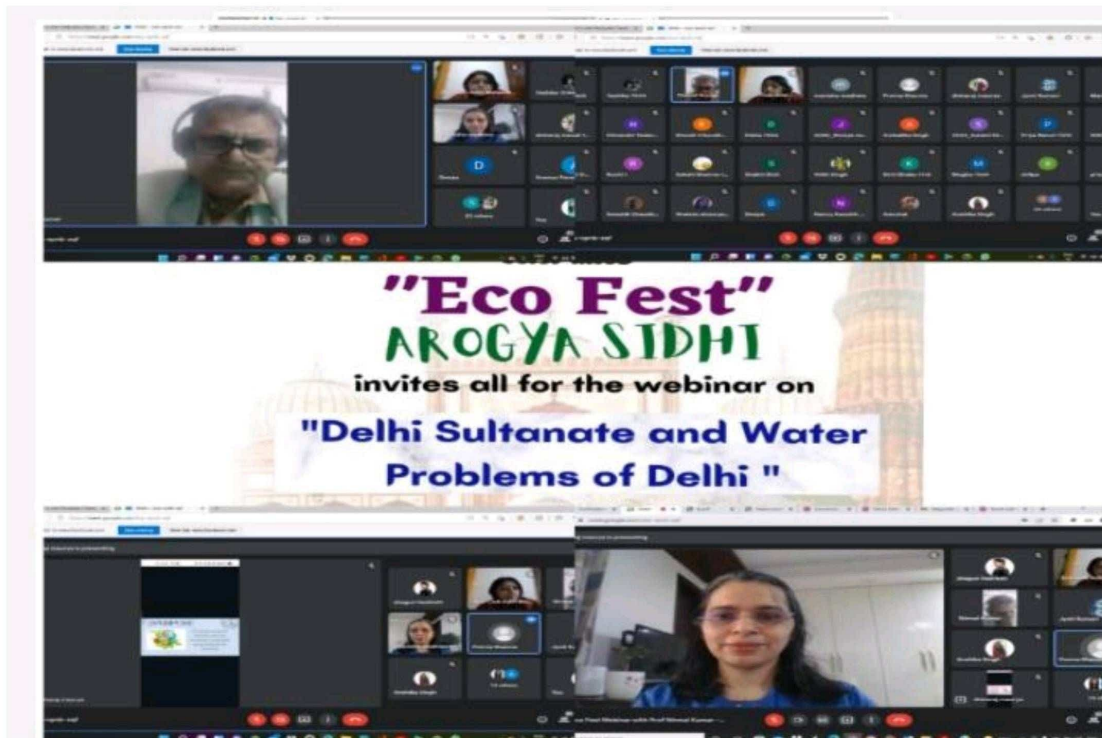

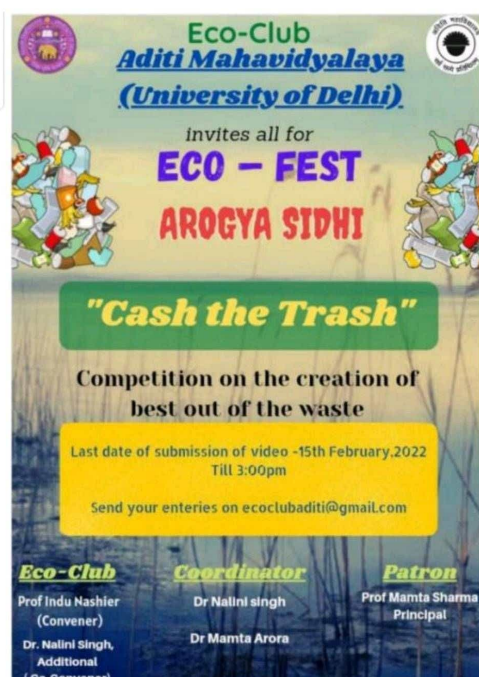
