

2. Webinar Report on e-Waste Management



The webinar on e-waste management was inaugurated by Prof. Mamta Sharma, Principal of Aditi Mahavidyalaya on 14th September 2021 at 11 am in the presence of our Guest speaker – Sh. R.B. Srivastava, Principal Environmental Consultant, PrimaFocus Technologies. It was organised by joint efforts and opening remarks by Prof. Bhawna Raiput (Professor, Department of Commerce, Aditi Mahavidyalaya), Convenor, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan and Dr Mali Devi Sawariya (Assistant Professor, Department of Social Work, Aditi Mahavidyalaya), Programme Officer, National Service Scheme. This webinar was organised as a series of initiatives taken by our college to create awareness about the relative importance of maintaining cleanliness in our surroundings. Maintaining cleanliness is not only important for our physical wellbeing but is associated with our spiritual and emotional wellness as well. As Gandhi ji said 'clean mind lives in a clean body', true liberation can be achieved only if we are liberated from bondages of all kinds -slavery, impure thoughts and ill health. For a nation to prosper, there must reside people who thrive in a healthy social, political and ecological environment. This webinar was a significant endeavour on our part to create sensitization about imminent need to maintain a clean, healthy and e waste free environment, where each of us is able to contribute to our greatest potential. With this spirit, on behalf of Aditi Mahavidyalaya, Prof Mamta Sharma announced the winners of Multi-Talent Competition on 'Green Aditi, My Efforts' and welcomed our guest speaker for this webinar - Sh R. B Srivastava, who has been Senior Principal Environment Consultant in PRIMA Focus Technologies. He carried immense experience in the field of e waste management and has been eminent part of many international and national training programmes in e-waste management.

Then Sh R.B. Srivastava shared in detail about technological ways to reuse, reduce and recycle e-waste:

• Be a good consumer. Do some research when you're ready to buy a new product. Make sure it's one that won't break easily or become damaged shortly after you purchase it. In

other words, look for products likely to have a much longer lifespan so you won't need to replace it within a few years, or even months.

- Reuse as often as possible. If you have parts and equipment that are still working, try repairing the electronic device before getting a new one. And if the device is beyond the point of being repaired, then recycle it.
- Educate yourself on what gets put into your electronics. Knowledge is power. Doing some research about the raw materials being used to manufacture your mobile phone or laptop helps you understand how harmful those materials and toxins can be if they're tossed into a landfill. The more you educate yourself the more you can purchase items that won't be harmful to the environment.
- Look for an environmentally friendly label. For example, see if the products you buy are labeled Energy Star, or have been certified by the Electronic Product Environmental Assessment Tool.
- Consider limiting the number of electronics you own. If you don't really need an extra gadget, look for devices that have multiple functions.
 Teach kids about e-waste. Children are our future, and it helps if we can instill within them at a young age a commit to e-waste recycling.
- Recycle, recycle, recycle. No matter what you have, it's important to always dispose of your e-waste properly. That means recycling all of your used electronics, with the understanding that improperly disposing of e-waste is becoming more and more hazardous, particularly since the volume of e-waste has skyrocketed.

Webinar on the topic "Menstrual Hygiene Awareness"

Aditi Mahavidyalaya - Medical Committee organizes a webinar on the topic "Menstrual Hygiene Awareness" on October 11, 2021 at 11:00 am. The resource person for the session was Ms. Ankita Sukhwal (CSR Executive, Unicharm India). Prof. Mamta Sharma (Principal, Aditi Mahavidvalava), Prof. Bhawna Rajput (Convener, Medical committee) and other team members organizes the event that aimed to break the silence, raise awareness and change negative social norms surrounding menstrual hygiene. Around 100 participants from Aditi Mahavidyalaya and other colleges attended the session. Participants were made aware of menstrual hygiene, associated topics and use of sanitary napkins. Ms. Ankita Sukhwal highlighted that a large number of adolescent girls from rural areas of India are still not aware about issues related to menstruation and maintaining personal hygiene during this period and dealing with associated physical problems. They usually don't get a proper platform to get information or discuss such issues. This awareness session was conducted in which all associated topics related to menstruation were explained to adolescent girls, like what is menstruation, calculation of the period, physical problems faced by girls during their periods and ways to deal with it like doing some physical exercise and yoga, maintaining personal hygiene during this period and importance of maintaining hygiene, avoiding the traditional methods of using dirty cloths and promoting use of sanitary napkins, etc. Traditional myths and misconceptions related to menstruation were discussed. At the end of the session FAQs by the girls related to the topic were answered by the facilitator.



MEDICAL COMMITTEE & SWACHHA BHARAT COMMITTEE


