






2. SUSTAINABILITY AND INCLUSION

and exchange of ideas with renowned experts in e-waste management and recycling research and development.

- **Jal Shakti Abhiyan** an initiative by the Modi government was given impetus by Aditi Mahavidyalaya on 19th August 2019 wherein a rally on “Water Conservation and Revival of Johars in Villages” was organized in association with the NSS wing of the college.
- The college organized a **cleanliness drive in the nearby Shahbad Dairy** area on 29th August 2019 to generate awareness about proper waste disposal and its impact in keeping the environment clean.





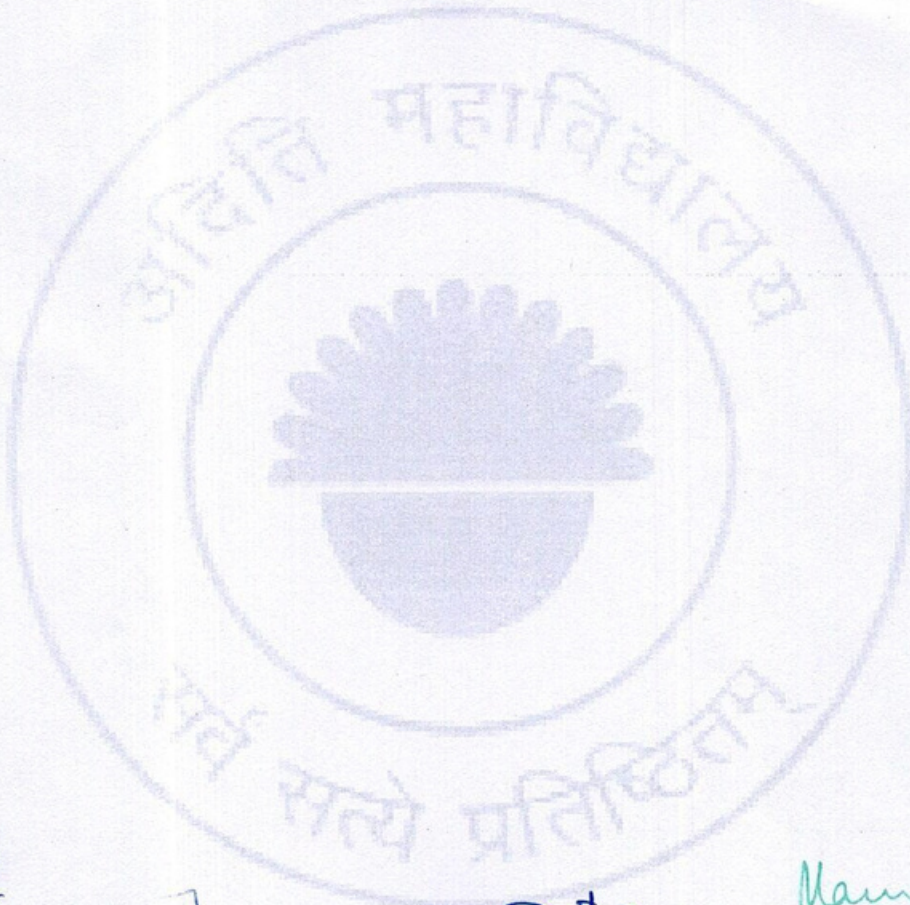
