Activity report for FY 2022-23

Planning for TI/LWS evaluation with SACS 2022-23:

The evaluation of TI/LWS for the year 2022-23 the team has continued with planning and execution in Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Delhi, Chandigarh and Uttar Pradesh. Total 76 TI/LWS project has been evaluated in this timeframe.

Training cum Workshop of Saksham Pramaan Staff:

A workshop was conducted by TISS Saksham Pramaan for two days on 13th and 14th June 2022 for the regional coordinators of all 5 of RICE teams. The two Regional Coordinator of Aditi Mahavidyalaya Saksham Pramaan project-Dr Kumud Teresa and Ms Kritiak Singh Bawaniwal represented the north zone team. The workshop started with a brief introduction by Dr Sucheta Deshpande, Senior Program Manager of Saksham Pramaan. The following topics were covered: reflection on TI and LWS data and data compilation and entry of each TI including doubt solving sessions.



Data Entry Workshop in Saksham, TISS [Date- 13th June 2022, Mumbai]

Two day offline regional training was organized by Saksham Pramaan project of Aditi Mahavidyalaya (University of Delhi) at the International Guest House, University of Delhi on 29th and 30th August 2022. The Training was intended to re-skilling of evaluators who had participated for the first time in the TI/LWS evaluations between January to March 2022 in northern states of India. A total of 14 evaluators from Delhi, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh participated in this training program. The resource persons were the staff of Pramaan project at Aditi Mahavidyalaya including Dr Akash Mishra (Independent researcher and consultant). Dr Mishra, Joint Director of DSACS and Md Rehan, National Coordinator of TISS-NACO provided their valuable guidance to the participants in this training.



Regional Training (Offline) at International Guest House [University of Delhi]

TISS- RICE Meeting was conducted on the dates of 17th and 18th November 2022 at the TISS Campus, Mumbai. The main agenda of the meeting was to propose a framework for preparing the TI evaluation manual by the Saksham Pramaan team of all regions. Dr Bhavani, NACO had given the keynote address and asked for empanelment of new evaluators. Prof. Shalini Bharat, TISS discussed the contributions of TISS through many field action projects, such as the Muskaan project (1937) in child and adolescent health and Saksham projects in the Tuberculosis and HIV sector.

The Training Needs Assessment workshop (TNA) and preparation of training manual for the evaluators on TI and LWS Evaluation under NACP, conducted in the period 30th January to 1st February 2023. This workshop held to review the existing training manual, tool based survey and panel discussions during three days. In order to prioritize the contents, skills and competencies and for further capacity building of evaluators on effective evaluation process, experienced and novice evaluators, SACS officials of Punjab, Chandigarh, Odisha and West Bengal, programme staffs from TI/ LWS NGOs, representatives from RICE and subject experts were included into the process of training needs assessment. The planning of the training actions, the drafting of content for the training sessions, mapping tools and criteria for the mapping and prioritizing are developed by XIM University, Bhubaneswar.

Saksham Pramaan Annual Meet up of all RICE Partner:

He briefed the participants on how the Saksham evolved since NACP III and how TISS was engaged with NACO and took up the responsibilities of training the counsellors and for the same TISS had onboarded 39 universities across India. The journey of engaging with NACO continued with Saksham Pramaan. Saksham Pramaan has two important components i.e., TI & LWS evaluations at the national level and Programme Evaluation. For TI / LWS evaluations, five regional partners (academic institutions) have been selected and they are coordinating the evaluations across India.
