












The content in the event is as follows:


To raise awareness about existence and cause of corruption.

- ✤ To report any incident of corruption to the appropriate agency.



The following points were discussed in detail:

- A week before the election, the duty of teachers will be posted at different locations of the college to maintain and enforce strict discipline within the college campus.
- The details of the duty list will be displayed on the noticeboard of the staff room and students notice board.
- The committee will provide full cooperation to Student union advisory committee and will ensure discipline in all manner on the day of election. All

the teachers will be allotted duties according to the requirement of smooth functioning of DUSU Election.

- All the students should wear their ID cards while they are in the campus and their respective classroom.
- Smoking, chewing tobacco, consumption of intoxicating liquors or any prohibited substances in the college premises are strictly prohibited.


