The resource person Dr.Vichitra Dargan Anand - an eminent psychologist talked at length about nurturing the art of building healthy relations not only with others but also with one’s own self. The session was made lively with role play and handouts that kept the audience engaged and interested. The session offered a platform to the students to share their anxieties and concerns faced in young adulthood and how to resolve conflicts situations generated by peer and parental pressure. The Principal Dr. Mamta Sharma shared valuable observations and engaged with the students at a personal level.



## **. GOODS AND SERVICES TAX**

This workshop was organized in association with commerce department on 13<sup>th</sup> February, 2019. GST, an indirect tax has been implemented in India since 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2017. It is levied on the supply of goods and services and replaced existing multiple flowing taxes such as central excise duty, services tax, additional customs duty, surcharges, octroi etc. levied by the central and state governments. It is imposed at variable rates on variable items.



The resource person- Mr. Ankur Jain, faculty of times education started session with the comparisons on pre and post GST era. He talked about the major advantage of implementing GST i.e., the positive impact it has on the nation and how it helped in abolishing corruption and black money problem. Also he told students about how to make first mover advantage and how GST can become an opportunity for future success.

The impact of GST professionally and personally was also discussed during the session. The lecture was interactive and students were highly satisfied. The Principal, Dr.Mamta Sharma, TIC of commerce department-Dr. Nitu Dabas and Convener of Extensive Lecture series committee-Dr. Rajeev Kaur graced the event with their presence and motivated the students.



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### ***“LAWS FOR PROTECTION OF CHILDREN’S INTEREST” and HANDLING INTERVIEWS” organized on 04/09/2019***

The department of Human Development and Family Empowerment in collaboration with department of English and Commerce participated in an Extensive Inter Disciplinary Lecture Series held on 4<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

A special lecture on “Laws for Protection of Children’s Interest” was conducted by Dr Anubha Rajesh, Chair Professor, Centre for Early Childhood development and Research (CECDR), JamiaMilliaIslamia.

The major thrust was analysis of situation of children in India. Developing a cognizance that children are not a homogenous group and their different needs need different responses, especially the multi-dimensional vulnerabilities experienced by children in different circumstances. Against this backdrop, the various policies and laws for children were understood as to whether they have been able to bring about a change? What are the challenges in creating an integrated, inclusive and sustainable approach for the overall and harmonious development and protection of children was dwelled upon.

The extensive lecture series committee in collaboration with Department of English and Department of Commerce organized an interactive session on “*HANDLING INTERVIEWS*”. The session offered valuable insight to the students about the challenges faced by them with regard to interviews. The resource person Dr. Tasneem Shahnaaz, Associate Professor, Department of English, Sri Auribindo College, University of Delhi talked at length about different types of interviews that students can come across in future. She also discussed about what preparations one should do while preparing for Interviews and shared some tips on it that can help students to be more confident while facing them. The session was made lively with role play and handouts that kept the audience engaged and interested. The session offered a platform to the students to share their anxieties and concerns about interviews. The Principal Dr. Mamta Sharma also shared her valuable inputs with the students.





**SPECIAL LECTURE SERIES organized on 17/09/2019**

The extensive lecture series committee in association with Department of Commerce and Department of English organized three interactive sessions on 17<sup>th</sup> September, 2019.



The first session on the topic “Out of Office: Too stressed to work” offered valuable insight to the students about the problems and stress they may face at work level. The resource person Dr. Vandana Gambhir Chopra, Assistant professor in Psychology in Keshav Mahavidyalya, University of Delhi and soft skill behavioral trainer, made session lively and interactive with a lot of group activities conducted during the session. It gave the students an opportunity to study latent stress in their life and ways of handling it. She also talks of effective techniques to manage work life balance.





The second session was about “Cyber crime and Social Media “. The resource person Dr. Rajanikant Verma, Associate Professor in department of Commerce, Zakhir Husain College, University of Delhi, talked at length about different types of cyber crimes-how individuals are affected by it. He talked about issues like cyber stalking, spoofing, phishing, bank frauds, email related crimes, hacking, viruses, Trojan attacks and many more. As social media platforms become more intrinsic to our daily lives, he also discussed how it has become crucial attack vector that individuals and even organizations can no longer ignore. He ended the session by sharing numerous tips on online safety against cyber crime by using strong passwords, keeping software updated, managing social media settings, strengthening private networks and a lot more.

The third session was about “Enhancing Communication skills” and speaker Dr. Archana Kaushik, Associate Professor, Department of Social work, University of Delhi discussed about assertive and unassertive aspects of communication. She also briefed students on the importance of communication skills not just in outside world but also in family, friends and relatives. Real life examples were given to discuss different styles of communication such as direct-indirect communication and mask communication and how they all are interrelated. To make communication effective, it must be clear and direct. She concluded the session by focusing on importance of listening skills which acts as meditation to a greater extent.

## ***“OPENING HORIZONS TO THE THIRD GENDER” organized on 24/09/2019***

An interactive session was organised, with a team of experts from SPACE on the topic **Opening Horizons to the Third Gender**. The Principal Inaugurated and welcomed the guests.

The session was attended by 42 B.A. (Hons) Social work students. Anjan Joshi led the team of four members from SPACE. The session began with understanding the concepts of Gender, Gender-identity, Gender Expression, Transgender, Sexual Orientation, LGBTIQA. The session further focused on the labeling, stigma and discrimination of the sexual minority persons. How because they are not understood and accepted, they are rejected by families, friends and the society. This sensitization session is a way forward so that the majority population is able to be aware of the existences and rights of the sexual minorities. We need to build a society friendly to the LGBTIQA, so that we are able to have an inclusive society.

The students questioned the many myths and misconceptions on gender identity and diversities. Students clarified their doubts and showed interest to work for a gender-neutral society.



## Alzheimers and Its Response

On 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2020

Speaker: **Mr. R. Narendhar, Executive Director from an NGO- Alzheimer's and Related Disorders Society of India**

An interactive session was organised, with an expert from Alzheimer's and Related Disorders Society of India. The Principal Inaugurated and welcomed the guest.

The session was attended by 43 B.A. (Hons) Social work students. The session was conducted in three sections. Firstly, the session began with understanding the concepts and nature of NGO, Civil society, Corporate Social Responsibility, Trust and so on. Secondly, the session further highlighted on concept, needs, problems, care and support for Alzheimer patients. Lastly, the session focused on personal experiences after the screening of a short documentary.

Students clarified their doubts and showed interest to work in this area.

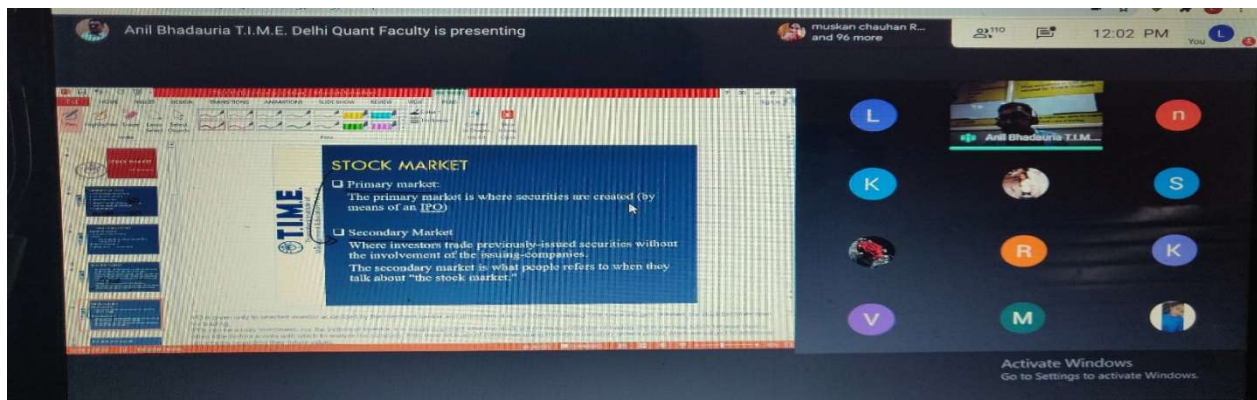
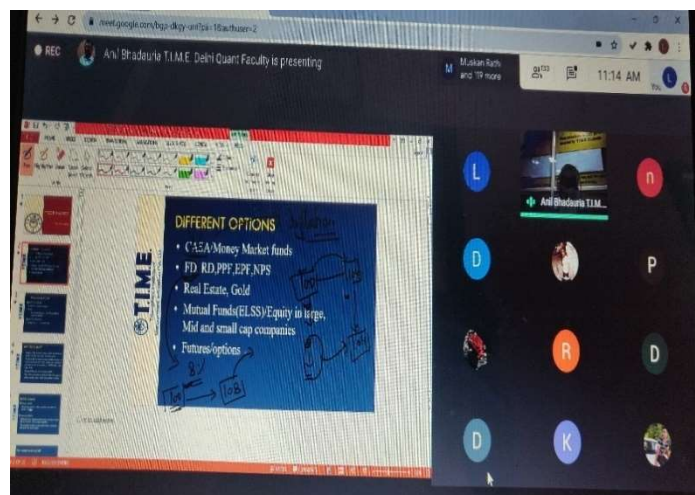
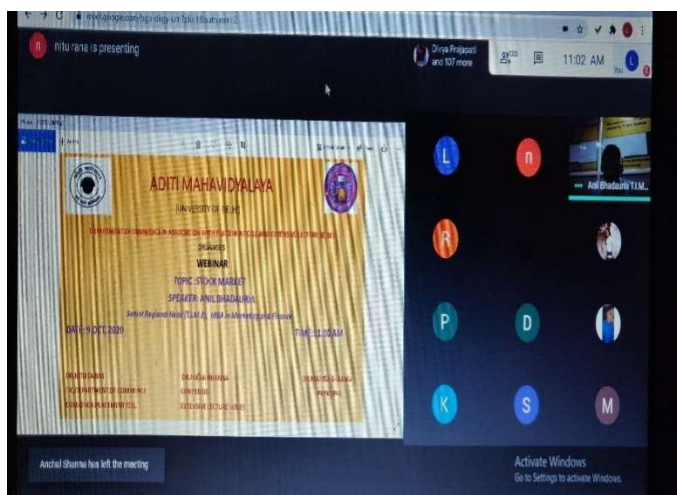




## EXTENSIVE LECTURE SERIES 2020-2021

### Webinar on “Stock Market “



## ANNUAL REPORT

### EXTENSIVE LECTURE SERIES COMMITTEE

The Extensive lecture series committee of the college has organized two workshops in 2018-19. Students were highly satisfied with both workshops and were also asked about their experiences, inputs and suggestions through feedback forms in each workshop.

#### 1. ***YOUNG ADULTHOOD: HANDLING RELATIONSHIPS IN SOCIETY***

The workshop was organized on 09<sup>th</sup> August, 2018. The session offered valuable insight to the students about the day to day challenges faced by them with regard to their handling of relationships in society.



The resource person Dr. Vichitra Dargan Anand - an eminent psychologist talked at length about nurturing the art of building healthy relations not only with others but also with one's own self. The session was made lively with role play and handouts that kept the audience engaged and interested. The session offered a platform to the students to share their anxieties and concerns faced in young adulthood and how to resolve conflicts situations generated by peer and parental pressure. The Principal Dr. Mamta Sharma shared valuable observations and engaged with the students at a personal level.



## 2. GOODS AND SERVICES TAX

This workshop was organized in association with commerce department on 13<sup>th</sup> February, 2019. GST, an indirect tax has been implemented in India since 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2017. It is levied on the supply of goods and services and replaced existing multiple flowing taxes such as central excise duty, services tax, additional customs duty, surcharges, octroi etc. levied by the central and state governments. It is imposed at variable rates on variable items.



The resource person- Mr. Ankur Jain, faculty of times education started session with the comparisons on pre and post GST era. He talked about the major advantage of implementing GST i.e., the positive impact it has on the nation and how it helped in abolishing corruption and black money problem. Also he told students about how to make first mover advantage and how GST can become an opportunity for future success.

The impact of GST professionally and personally was also discussed during the session. The lecture was interactive and students were highly satisfied. The Principal, Dr. Mamta Sharma, TIC of commerce



department-Dr. Nitu Dabas and Convener of Extensive Lecture series committee-Dr. Rajeev Kaur graced the event with their presence and motivated the students.
