
### **EVENT 1: WEBINAR ON INVESTMENT & DEPOSITORY**


#### **EVENT 4: WEBINAR ON “ENTREPRENEURSHIP MINDSET & ACTION”**

He also told us that corporate governance was defined in the Cadbury Report as “the system by which companies are directed and controlled”. The role of the shareholder is to appoint the directors and the external auditors, and to satisfy themselves that an appropriate governance structure is in place. Prof. Anil Kumar also answered multiple doubts of the students. He advised to look at the official websites for real and true content. Eventually the session was ended by a formal vote of thanks.
