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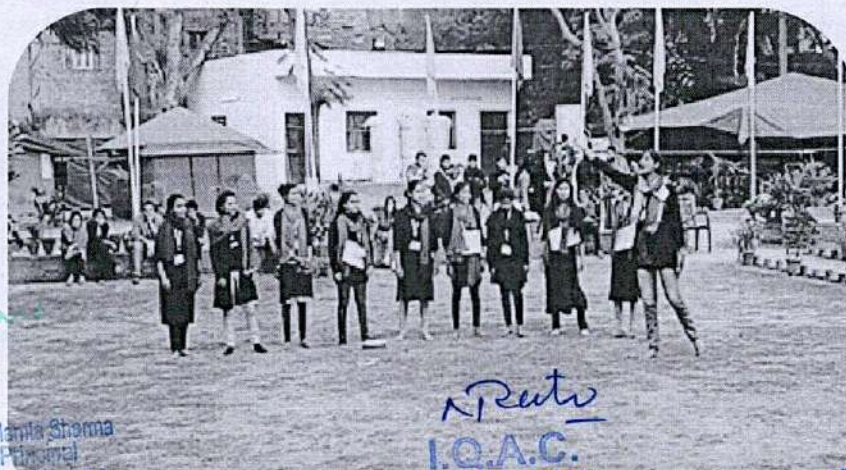
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Department of Social Work

Activities 2017-18

The academic session 2017-18 began with the three days **Orientation Programme** from 20th July to 22nd July 2017 with an objective of creating an orientation and conceptual clarity regarding the goals of professional social work for all the students of B.A (H) Social Work. There was participation and guidance by distinguished resource persons from various sites of social work practice with marginalized groups in order to enhance the knowledge base as well as insight of students about the course. The major themes undertaken during programme were – “Social Work with Tribal Communities” by Dr. Budhaditya Das (Assistant Professor, Ambedkar University), “Social work with Persons with Disabilities” by Mr.Pawan, Assistant Professor, Disability Studies at GTB College, “Issues and Interventions to protect children” by Mr.Shubham, Social Work Practitioner, Child Welfare Committee), “Social Work in Corporate Sector” by Dr.Seema Sharma (Assistant Professor, Department of Social Work, University of Delhi), “Marginalization and Social Justice” by Dr.ShashiDev (Assistant Professor, Department of Social Work, University of Delhi), “Psychological grounding in Social Work” by Dr.MeenaSawaria (Educational Psychologist and Research Fellow at Ambedkar University), “Social Work in Legal Sector” by Dr. Vijay Pandey (Social Work Partitioner), “Child Welfare and Social Work practice” by Dr.AbhishwetaJha (Associate Fellow, Ambedkar University) and “Social Work with Minorities” by Dr.PreetiJha (Associate Fellow, Ambedkar University). Duties of every volunteer are well defined so as to remove any confusion and form a well planned, simple, systematic way of doing activities and align those activities to other activities taking place in the college.

"One for all and all for one" is the phrase that comes to mind when it comes to Aditi Mahavidyalya's Placement Cell team. Volunteering for the 'Placement Cell' we had to face some difficulties in work initially because it was not easy to manage a big team in beginning phase but gradually we all learnt how to do our assigned works. 

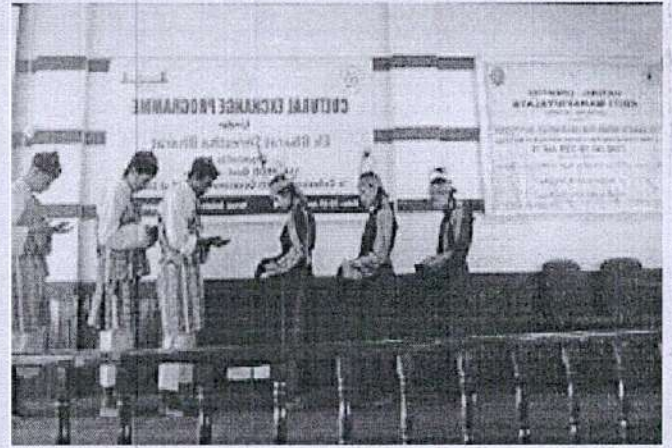

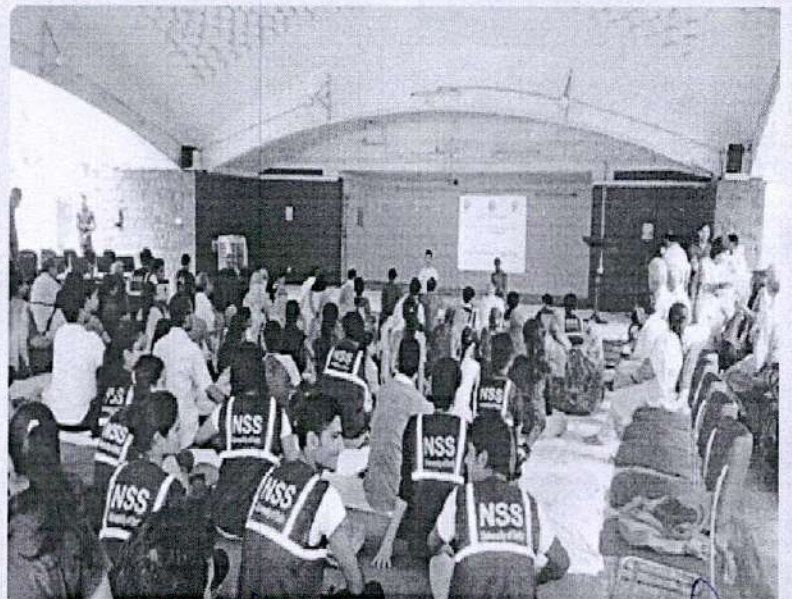
NSS WING

NATIONAL HEALTHCARE

India, a country of more than one billion spends only 5.2 percent on healthcare. While 4.3 percent is spent by private sector the government continues to spend 0.9 percent on public health with unorganized insurance sector. India has to depend on private sector, huge dent in their personal resources. While India ranks among the top ten countries for communicable diseases, it is world leader in diseases like diabetes hypertension and cardiac ailment. Malnutrition of children is a matter of major concern, 15 percent death among children is caused by malnutrition. The latest UNICEF report says that 5,000 children is caused under the age of five daily die due to preventable diseases. 900 people die daily of tuberculosis.

National Health Policy in India was not framed until 1983. The objectives of the Revised National Health Policy 2002 are:

- Increase in public expenditure from 0.9 to 2 percent by 2010.
- Encouraging private insurance instrument to bring secondary and tertiary sector into its purview.
- Proposing to set up two-tier urban health care system. Primary health centre for those who can afford to pay: compulsory 2 year service for doctors in Rural areas.

The National Health Policy proposes to bring gradually all health program under a single field administration.

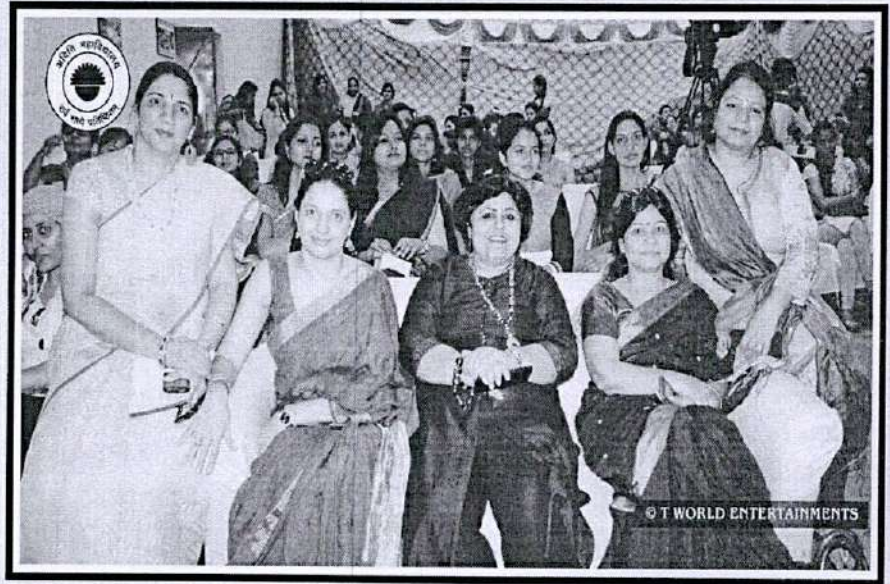
