WHAT IS YOUR SUPERPOWER?

The conducted study attempted to understand street harassment experienced by young women in many states across the country and worldwide. The interactive session was conducted with more than 70 girls between the ages of 18 to 22 years to understand the nature of harassment they faced, its perceived consequences, their ways of coping with it, and the changes they felt were needed for them to feel safer. Findings revealed that harassment occurred most often in crowded spots and in broad daylight. High levels of harassment were attributed to factors like prevalent attitudes toward women and weak implementation of laws.

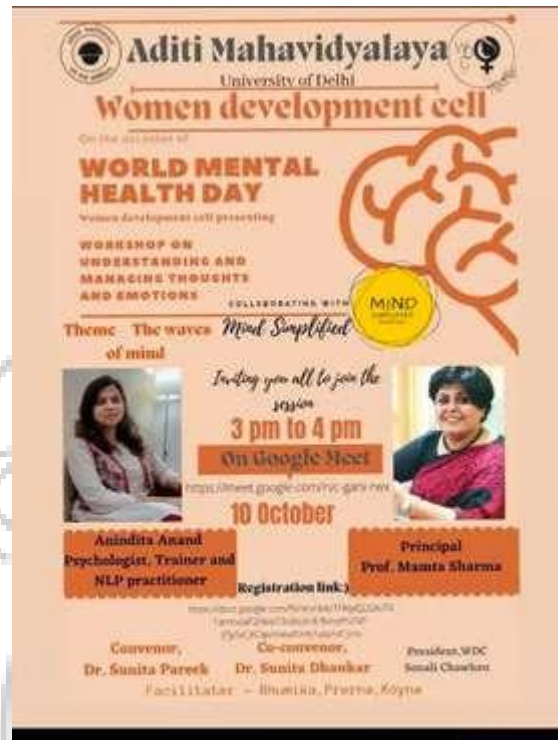


World MENTAL HEALTH DAY EVENT In collaboration with Mind Simplyfied by ANINDITA ANAND.

the thorough understanding of mental health and its impact in our lifestyle and different ways how we can navigate, understand and introspect into better lifestyles.



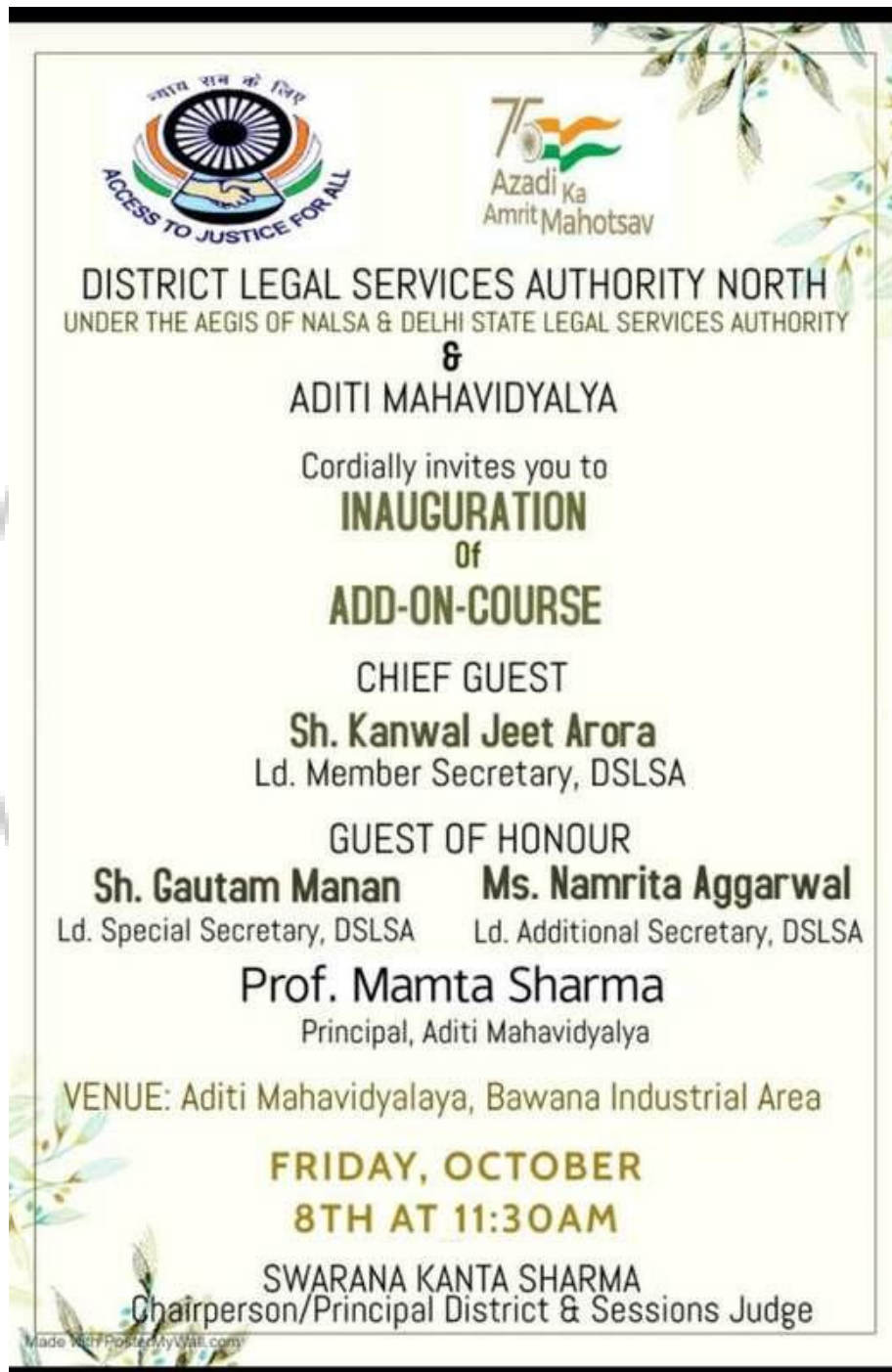

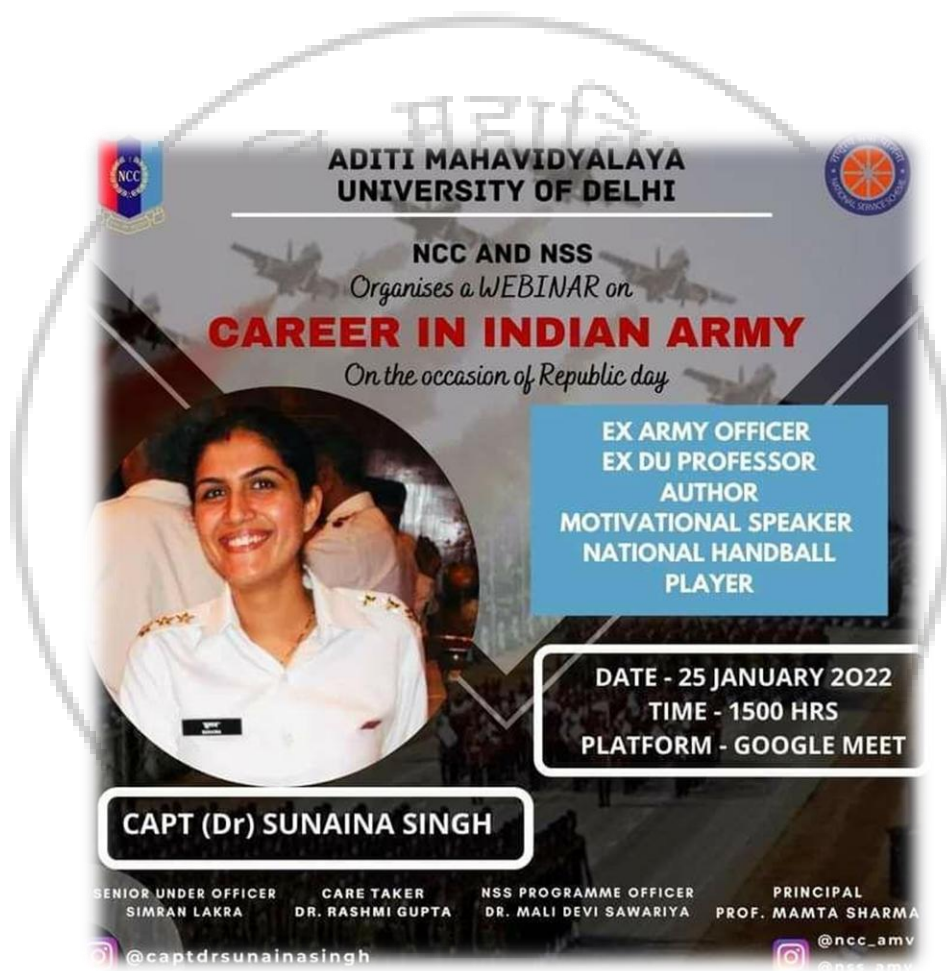

1. Physical facilities: The institution has wheel chair facility.
2. Provision for lift: At present there is no multi-storey building in the college.

5. Rest Rooms: there is a one separate rest room in the library block.
6. Scribes for examination: yes but never used.

- Signage including tactile path, lights, display boards and signposts

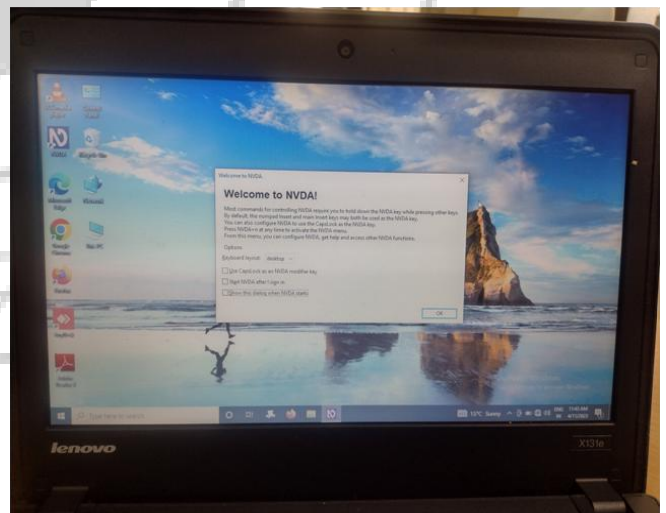
- Assistive technology and facilities for persons with disabilities (Divyangjan) accessible website, screen-reading software, mechanized equipment
