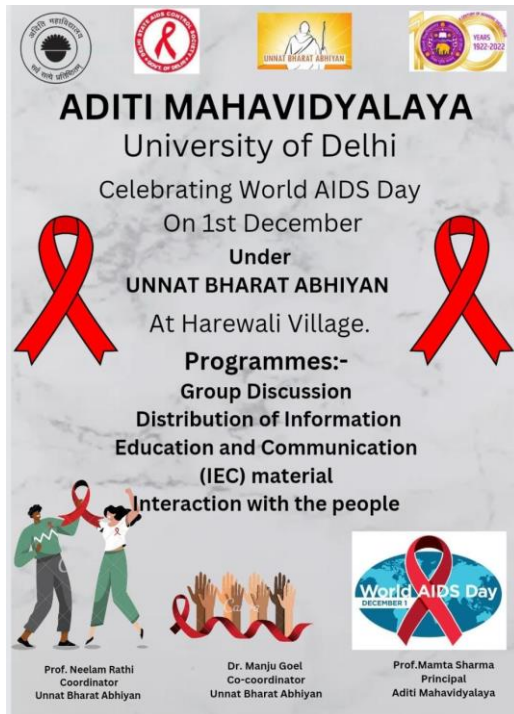
**Children's Day Celebration at Government co-ed school, Harewali on 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2022-**

### Anandshala on Bhartiya Gyan Parampara Aur Gurukul Shiksha on 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2023

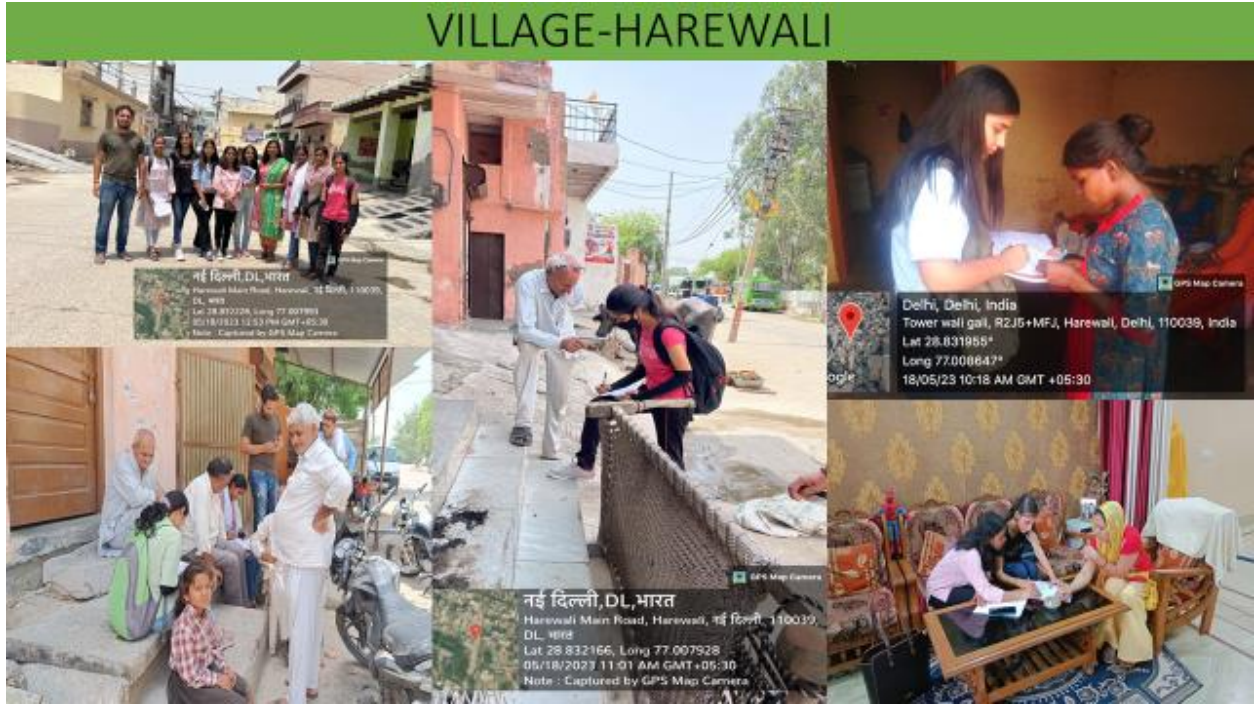

The Yamuna River is one of the largest and most important rivers in northern India, but it has been heavily polluted and degraded over the years due to industrialization, urbanization, and discharge of untreated sewage.

A large number of people gathered along the Yamuna river banks to form a human chain on early Sunday morning under a citizens' initiative to save the river from heavy pollution.

Under the "Yamuna Sansad" initiative, people formed the human chain at many places, including FTL, Mansarovar, Badli, Gurgaon Colony and Old Unnao, stating the demand to revive the river and contribute to saving the river from heavy pollution.

A large number of organisations of social, cultural and religious organisations too participated in the campaign. Many politicians, including former BJP minister and former AAP entrepreneur and environmental activist Gaurav, Delhi's Minister of Environment and Urban Affairs, and Union Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, also participated in the campaign.



Dr. Sachdeva, who attended the campaign, said, "Yamuna Sansad" is a citizens' initiative to save the river from heavy pollution. The rejuvenation of Yamuna will happen only with the joint efforts of the government and the society, he said.

The New Delhi government is committed towards cleaning of Yamuna. He said and added that the "Yamuna Sansad" initiative will encourage active participation of Delhiites in cleaning the river.
