A talk on "GENDER FLUIDITY".

Date: 26th September 2022

Gender fluidity refers to changes over time in a person's gender expression or gender identity, or both. Gender fluidity is a non-fixed gender identity that shifts over time or depending on the situation. These fluctuations can occur at the level of gender identity or gender expression. A gender-fluid person may fluctuate among different gender expressions over their lifetime, or express multiple aspects of various gender markers simultaneously. Gender-fluid individuals may identify as non-binary or transgender, or also identify with their assigned gender.

LGBT is an initialism that stands for "lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender." In use since the 1990s, the initialism, as well as some of its common variants, functions as an umbrella term for certain sexualities and gender identities.

This session was very informative and interactive. He shared his experience, his family struggle, and how he convinces his jaat family.



Webinar on "Navigating A child with Disability"



On 3rd Dec 2022, World Disability Day, an interactive webinar entitled "Navigating a Child with Disability" was organized. The key speakers Ms. Pratibha Dhanesh Sherwani and Ms. Neeta were two parents of children with disability who shared their personal experiences of bringing up a child with a disability. It was a very touché' webinar that highlighted the hardships, the



struggles, the family support, and the celebrations they had in this journey.

Mrs. Pratibha Dhanesh Sherwani, a working mother, was 36 years old. She was a mother of two champs, a 15 years old girl and 11 yrs old boy. Her son was born with cerebral palsy. She faced many problems such as negative comments, social isolation, and marital problems, as well as negative attitudes from family, friends, community members, and healthcare professionals. The physical environment created access challenges because of a lack of sidewalks, ramps, functioning lifts, and small indoor spaces. But as time passed, she realized that her child is her treasure and as a parent, it was her responsibility to support and nurture him for his treatment. As they started the therapies (physiotherapy, occupational therapy) after being socially involved her son learned many things (introducing Himself, starting demanding, emotional expressions, and many other things). She is one example of a super mom herself who believes "Once you learn to appreciate small victories, there is no need for a finish line."

The second speaker, Ms. Neeta, was a housewife. She had done BSc(chemistry). She had a son who had visual impairment. She devoted herself to her son. And left




her working lifestyle. She shifted house just for her son's school so that he could adapt well with children of his age and would be able to interact with children with the same disability. She doesn't want her son to be neglected and wants to support him. Her son is an intelligent and cheerful child. It was wonderful to know that she didn't have to face many difficulties as her family and friends were very supportive.

"Accept what is, let go of what was, and believe in what will be."

It was a wonderful experience for all that were present in the webinar. They were able to find answers to the queries they had in their mind related to children with disabilities and their upbringing.

Upasana is the venture of Mrs. Shilpa Arora, a special educator, working first at the post of a special educator. Upasana Special School Opp. Bank of Baroda, Main Kanjhawala Road - Delhi

They have 98 students with varied special needs in Upasana

Here at Upasana besides providing a child with special education, speech therapy, physiotherapy, behavioral therapy, music therapy, dance & yoga we also have provision for vocational training. There is a sheltered workshop where children make handicrafts and decorative items like Pen stands, Vases, Piggy Banks, Shagun envelopes, Wrapping papers & Greeting cards. The older children also make snacks like Mathi, Namak Para, Mixture & Ladoos. Here everybody is given an opportunity to do some work to make them feel wanted. Appreciation is very important and with that to be rewarded, both act as positive reinforces & mood elevators. So this school is doing a lot for children with disability and we should join them in their venture to make the world a better place for children with disability, where they are accepted for what they are.

Art and Craft Workshop on Save Environment: Convert Trash into Treasure

Department of Human Development and Family Empowerment under the guidance of Prof Sadhna Jain organized two days of ART and CRAFT Workshop on the theme **'Save Environment – Covert Trash into Treasure'** on 11th and 12th April 2023. Ms Harpreet Kaur conducted the workshop. This workshop has been organized in the context of the



Presidency of India for G-20 Summit with the motto "One Earth, One Family, One Future" (Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam).

The students of 2nd year (4th Semester) of the Human Development and Family Empowerment (HDFE) department are studying a paper on 'Principles and Perspectives on Early Childhood Care Education (ECCE)' in which they learn to develop learning aids for all-round development of the children who are in the age group of 0-6 years. The workshop was organized with the aim of instilling values of saving the environment among preschoolers from the very beginning as these are the formative years of one's life. The student teachers were sensitized about the kind of activities they can conduct to achieve the above goals.

From the workshop, the students learnt how to make preschoolers aware of getting beautiful things made from trash with environment-friendly techniques.

• The students converted the 'trash' into 'treasure' by making the following items:



a) Pencil holders, small pots for indoor plants from waste plastic bottles, and then covered with jute.

- b) Hut from broom fur and sticks.
- c) Wall hangings like birds, butterflies, etc. from colored sheets.
- d) Masks out of paper plates to be used for storytelling sessions.
- e) Animals and birds like rats, elephants, butterflies, etc from fallen leaves/ dry leaves
- f) Make various items from jute also.

The workshop ended with a vote of thanks to Smt. Harpreet Kaur by Prof. Sadhna Jain.

















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
