

**Graduate Research Seminar (GRADS)**  
**"A Road to Rome: Bilateral ties between Bharat and Italy"**

The Graduate Research Seminar GRADS is an initiative of the college library committee to encourage and foster the research writing and presentation at undergraduate level. The college library committee created the Graduate Research Seminar GRADS as a way to promote and support undergraduate research writing and presentation. The University of Delhi's many colleges responded enthusiastically to the Committee's invitation to submit research papers for reading and essay submission for the second edition of GRADS, which was held on October 12, 2023. "A Road to Rome: Bilateral ties between Bharat and Italy" was the seminar's overarching theme, and the subthemes for the presentations were drawn from the G20 Agenda's goals for trade, tourism, digital literacy, agriculture, and culture. There were 15 related sub themes. The number of registrants is really encouraging. The two categories got a combined 36 submissions from 10 colleges and departments, and 16 participants attended the seminar and read their papers. In both categories, the first, second, and third spots were chosen. Students were awarded certificates, souvenirs, and position holders also received certificates of excellence as rewards. The potential of a relationship between India and Italy were discussed by the presenters. The presenters' main points of emphasis were spiritualism, yoga, food tourism linkages, renewable energy, and sustainable development goals. How might traditional Indian commodities and practices merge with the Italian way of life? Presenters also highlighted the involvement of women in breakthroughs, interventions, and inventions. The Graduate Research Seminar not only showcased their presentation skills but also provided a platform to hone research skills. Huge response was given in both categories. Nine colleges took part in the activities overall. 33 complete papers and essays were sent. The events included 13 presentations. In both categories, the first, second, and third spots were chosen.
