


Graphical Representation of Students Feedback 2022-23








Communication skills of the teachers.










How do you find the sequence of the subjects that you have studied in your curriculum. 480 responses




Coverage of modern/advanced topics in your curriculum.


























What do you think about the course in terms of its relevance to your ward's career opportunities? 481 responses




Transparency of evaluation system in the college.
















Rate the applicability of the tools/activities/case studies presented in the curriculum facilitating more employability skills among graduates




How effective is the curriculum in developing analytical and problem solving skills 11 responses




Rate the scope of syllabus in enhancing entrepreneurship skills/lifelong learning/human values and ethics






Does the curriculum effectively cover topics on fundamentals and latest technology? 11 responses






