1. Sustainability in Action: Building a Green and Responsible Future

Aditi Mahavidyalaya champions environmental sustainability through innovative and impactful initiatives that extend beyond the classroom. The college's Earth Day celebrations, themed "Plastic vs. Planet," emphasize the critical need to reduce plastic usage and adopt eco-friendly practices. The annual Food Fest showcases traditional Indian cuisine and millet-based recipes, promoting sustainable agricultural practices and raising awareness about the nutritional and environmental benefits of indigenous grains. Collaborations with the Eco Club further bolster the institution's green agenda through activities such as tree planting, waste recycling, and workshops on air quality and renewable energy. These efforts not only educate students about sustainability but also inspire them to become active participants in global environmental movements. By integrating environmental consciousness into academic and extracurricular activities, Aditi Mahavidyalaya nurtures a generation of environmentally responsible citizens.

2. Empowering Women: Bridging Justice, Health, and Leadership

Aditi Mahavidyalaya stands as a beacon of women empowerment, fostering inclusivity and self-reliance through targeted initiatives. Legal literacy workshops and the establishment of a legal aid clinic provide students and community members with critical knowledge and access to justice. Collaborations with the TISS SAKSHAM Project have led to impactful campaigns, such as TB awareness drives, addressing healthcare disparities among women. In the financial year 2023-24, the college evaluated 71 Targeted Intervention (TI) projects and six Link Worker Scheme (LWS) projects, reflecting its commitment to comprehensive outreach. Saksham Pramaan's participation in capacity-building workshops in Delhi (November 2021) and Training Need Assessment (TNA) sessions in Bhubaneswar (January 2023) further underscores this commitment. Skill-building workshops on self-defense, digital literacy, and women's rights equip students with tools for personal and professional growth. By addressing systemic barriers and promoting gender equity, Aditi Mahavidyalaya exemplifies a holistic approach to women's empowerment, ensuring their active participation in shaping a more equitable society.

 - Engage the academic community in celebrating key environmental milestones to build a sense of responsibility and collaboration.
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
3. The Context

The college is located in an area with high groundwater levels, which presented an opportunity to implement effective rainwater harvesting systems. With growing concerns about environmental degradation and climate change, the institution sought to lead by example by integrating sustainability into its educational framework and operations. This practice aligned with the vision to not only create a green campus but also to empower students to become environmentally conscious citizens.

4. The Practice

Infrastructure Initiatives:

Educational and Awareness Programs:


1. **Workshops and Competitions:** Events such as "Best Out of Waste" and craft-making workshops were organized to encourage creative reuse of materials.



23. **Retirement Day Saplings: Employees retiring during this session planted saplings on their retirement day.**


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
24. **Herb Garden:** The Green Audit Committee established a small herb garden with medicinal plants and organized plantation drives.

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3. The Context




Initiatives:

- Workshops on women's health issues, mental well-being, and preventive measures against diseases were organized.



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
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- A dedicated medical room with a full-time nurse was established to address the health needs of students.
