An online training programme on Role of ROLE OF DISASTER MANAGEMENT PLANS TO ENHANCE THE RESILIENCE OF EDUCATIONAL INSTITUIONAL BUILDINGS was organised by Disaster Management Cell in collaboration with Skill Development Cell of the college.
