Understanding Transgender: Inclusion and Integration

Department of Social Work, Aditi Mahavidyalaya organized Panel Discussion on Understanding Transgender:

Inclusion & Integration under the Viksit Bharat at the Aditi Mahavidyalaya on 29th September, 2025. The panel discussion grace by prestigious speakers Sonu ji and Sanjana Ji from Sarawasti Educational Society). Prof. Beena Antony Reji(Teacher-in-charge, Department of Social Work) welcomed our speakers and highlighted theme for the same. Transgender inclusion and integration mean building a society that respects, values, and ensures equal opportunities for people of all gender identities. Both the speakers highlighted the concept of transgender and LGBTQ+, challenges by transgender community, livelihood issues, positive space and programmes and governments laws and initiatives for transgender community. The speakers also mentioned some strategies for inclusion and integration such as awareness campaigns to reduce stigma, counseling and supports for families, inclusive school and workplace policies, effective implementation of laws and welfare schemes and opportunities for skill-building, entrepreneurship, and dignified employment. The session was very interactive and students had lots of clarifications addressed by the speakers. The panel discussion end with vote of thanks. Fifty seven students and nine faculty were participated in the event.










REPORT

WarliPainting Workshop

29 September'2025

9:00 to 12:00 Noon Room no. 06 Under the campaign Viksit Bharat Abhiyan, Warli Painting Workshop was organized by Department of Education, Aditi Mahavidyalaya with more than 44 participants. The workshop was conducted by the guest Ms. Harpreet Kaur. The guest initiated the workshop with a brief introduction and history about the warli art. It was originated in the tribal communities of Maharashtra, India, known for its simple geometric patterns depicting nature, daily life, rituals. First she demonstrated some examples of Warli paintings to help the students understand the Warli Art better and then explained the use of simple shapes – circles, triangles, and lines in Warli painting. She drew some basic Warli figures on board like humans dancing, animals, huts, trees, and sun and explained steps to create human figures using circles and triangles only. After getting the idea participants start making their own art patterns on wall. She moved around, helping students, correcting their designs, proportions, and neatness. Many participants worked individually, some worked in pairs or groups. The outline of the paintings that participant did on the wall, was the most crucial and challenging part of it all. Then the colouring took place and the participants came forward to help each other and showed the importance of teamwork. All the students completed their artworks that was assigned to them with interest. The workshop not only preserved a dying art form but also initiated creativity among students, aligning with holistic education goals. It reinforced the importance of integrating indigenous art into modern classrooms to celebrate India's diversity.


Vibrant sporting events






