

## Department of Social Work

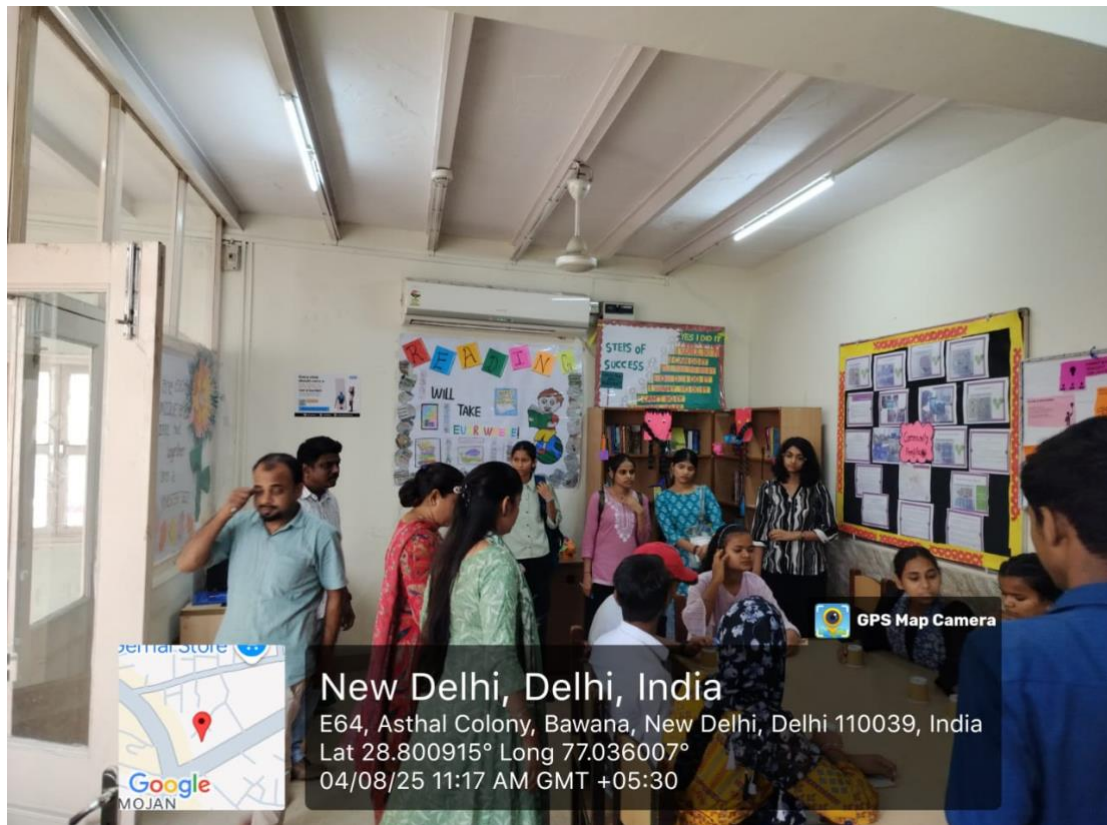
The Social Work Department conducted various academic and community-related activities for the students' professional and overall personality development during the first half of the 2025-2026 (August to November) academic session.

### Three-day Orientation Programme (2025–2026)

The Department of Social Work organised a three-day Orientation Programme (2025–2026) to welcome and guide BSW students regarding the academic framework and fieldwork components of the course. The programme was held under the leadership of Teacher-in-Charge Prof. Beena Antony Reji and Field Work Co-ordinator Prof. Sunita Bahmani, and the overall orientation programme was coordinated by Ms. Manisha Pal. On Day I (01.08.2026), coordinated by Ms. Manisha Pal and Dr. Gyanvati, the sessions began with “Introduction to Social Work” by Ms. Manisha Pal. 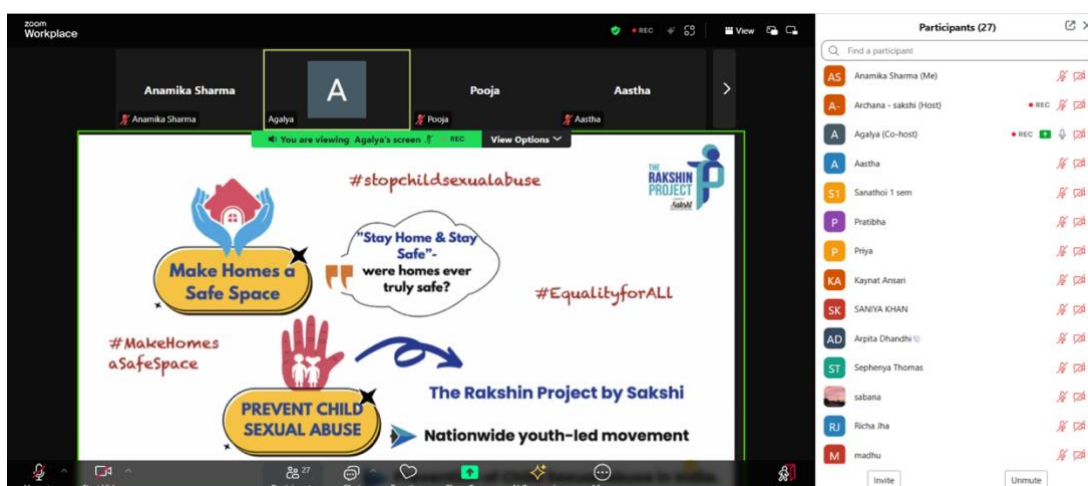

## Online webinar on the Prevention of Sexual Harassment (POSH) Act and the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act

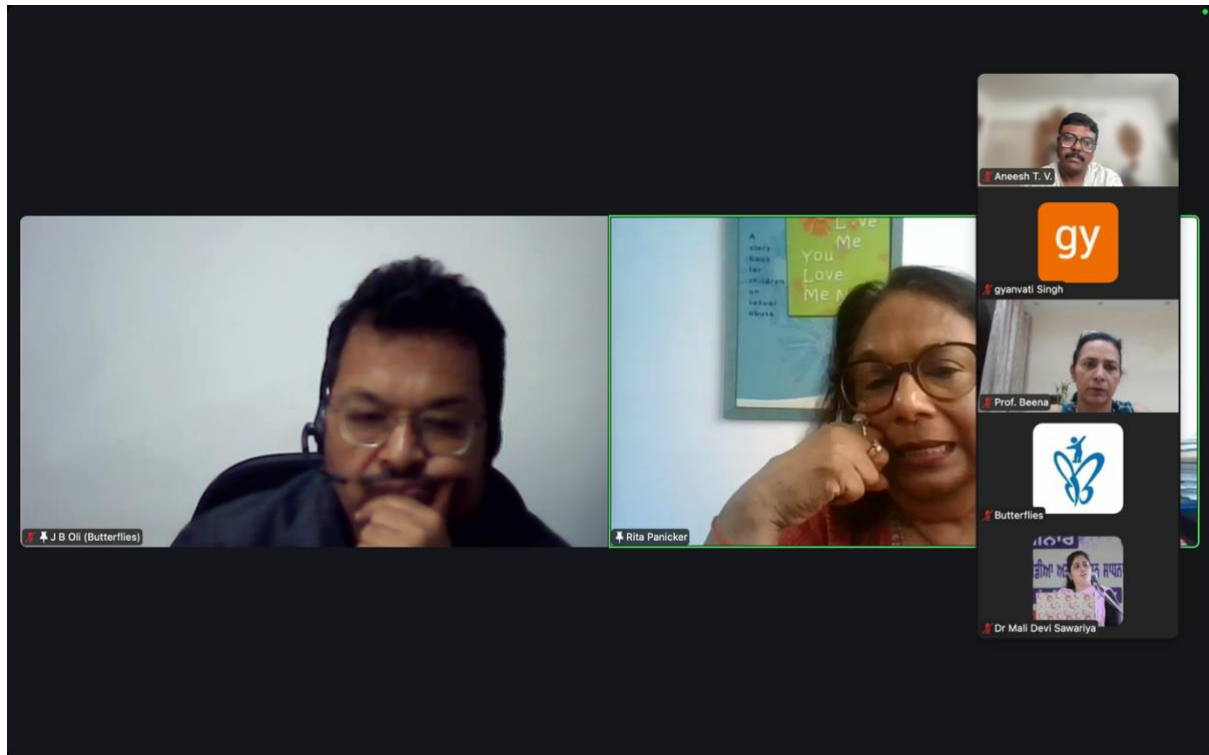
## Lecture series

## Online awareness campaign on 'caring for boys'


