


Library Committee (2024–25)

The Library Committee of Aditi Mahavidyalaya remained proactive throughout the academic session 2024–25, undertaking various initiatives to support students' academic needs, promote reading culture, and expand access to both physical and digital resources.

In commemoration of National Librarian's Day (12th August 2024), the Library Committee organized an Online Reading and Interaction Session as part of its ongoing "One Nation Reading Together" initiative. The chosen book, *Three Thousand Stitches* by Sudha Murthy, served as a catalyst for an engaging conversation around themes of women education, social change, and empowerment. Students from 2nd year and 3rd year participated actively, reading selected excerpts and reflecting on personal experiences, thus fostering a deeper appreciation for Indian literature.


