

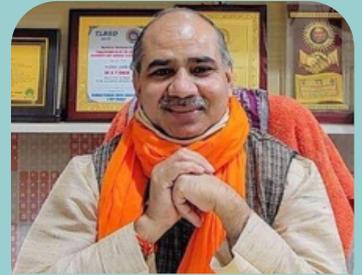

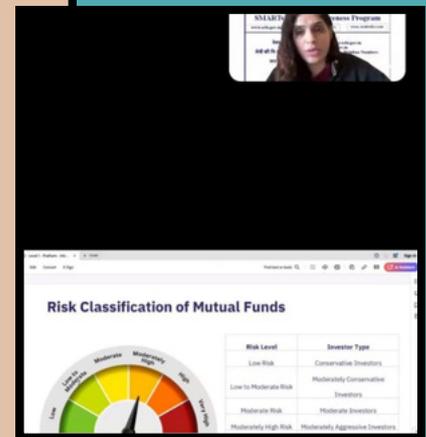
AI in Digital Marketing

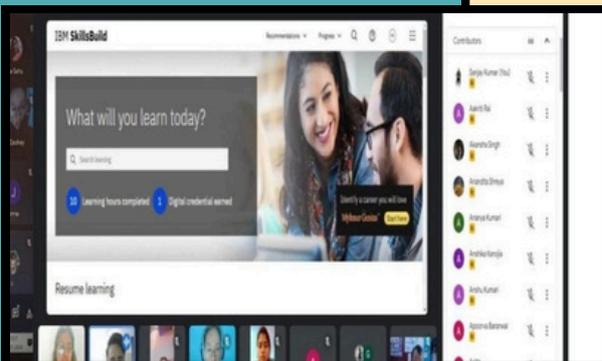
Financial Wellness through Green Finance

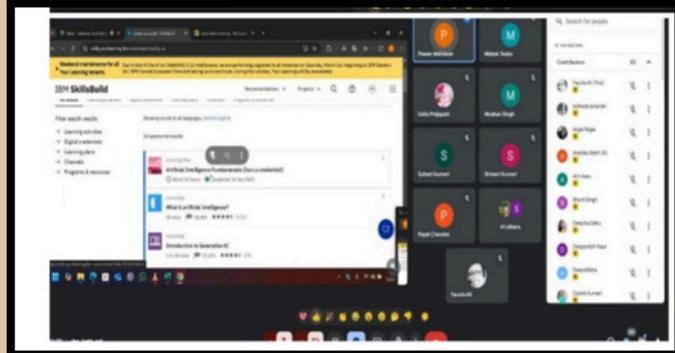
Tally Prime Workshop
